the authors do a good job using the diaries interviews and books written by group members to convey a vivid sometimes too vivid picture of war at its most elemental the journal of the air force historical foundation in february 1942 a reconnaissance party of united states army air force officers arrived in england firmly wedded to the doctrine of daylight precision bombing they believed they could help turn the tide of the war in europe in the months that followed they formed the eighth air force an organization that grew at an astonishing rate to accommodate it almost seventy airfields were hastily built across the eastern counties of england at the heart of the eighth air force was its bombardment groups each equipped with scores of heavily armed four engine bombers these boeing b 17 flying fortresses and consolidated b 24 liberators were soon punching through the enemy s defenses to bomb targets vital to its war effort they were crewed by thousands of young american airmen most of whom were volunteers this book tells the story of just one bomb group the 381st which crossed the atlantic in may 1943 arriving at raf ridgewell on the essex suffolk border its airmen quickly found themselves thrown into the hazardous and attritional air battle raging in the skies over europe the 381st s path led from its formation in the texan desert to its 297th and final bombing mission deep into the heart of hitler s third reich this is the remarkable story of one group and the part it played in the strategic bombing campaign of the mighty eighth

this book discusses the role of political narratives in shaping perceptions of instability and conceptions of order in the middle east and north africa mena the authors illustrate how in times of socio political turmoil and outbursts of discontent such as the arab spring political entrepreneurs explain and justify their political agendas by complementing hard power solutions with attractive ideas and discursive constructions that appeal to domestic constituencies and geopolitical allies the book is divided into two parts the first focuses on non state actors such as confessional communities and ideological movements who aim to develop narratives that are convincing to their respective polities it also studies regional powers that seek to determine their positions in a competitive environment via distinctive narrations of order in part two the authors investigate the narratives of global players that aim to explain and justify their role in an evolving international order

the english pharmacist turned raf aircrew member recounts his missions fighting against the third reich during world war ii les

bartlett has become one of the great characters of world war ii history he flew as bomb aimer with the then flying officer michael beetham who later became marshal of the royal air force at that time he was a sergeant but gained his commission in april 1944 and flew his tour including twenty seven raids over germany and france between november 1943 and may 1944 on his second operation his aircraft was attacked by a ju 88 leaving it with no flaps or brakes a crash landing at wittering ensued at the end of his third mission they found the whole of lincolnshire fogbound and eventually landed at raf melbourne in yorkshire just before that airfield was closed also because of the fog his aircraft was hit in the wing by a 30lb incendiary bomb dropped by another lancaster flying above them on his sixth operation but they survived on his twelfth operation to leipzig he used the nose guns to destroy a ju 88 night fighter for which he was awarded the dfm in february 1944 the port outer engine caught fire and the crew baled out les was then posted as assistant adjutant to raf thornaby

abstract this thesis examined both the rationale and objectives of states in resorting to air power in contemporary asymmetrical conflicts in the middle east focusing on the three cases of aerial operations on hezbollah in lebanon isis in syria and the houthi rebels in yemen the thesis concluded that states adopt post heroic military policies that prioritize avoiding casualties among the ranks of their armed forces which carries a series of negative consequences on achieving the objectives of the war especially amid limited or no backing by ground and naval troops

since the end of the cold war academic debate over the nature of war in the contemporary world has focused upon the asymmetric nature of conflict among a raft of failed or failing states often held together by only a fragile notion of a shared communal destiny little scholarly attention has been paid however to one such conflict that predates the ending of the cold war yet still appears as intractable as ever israel s hostile relationship with lebanon and in particular its standoff with the lebanese shi a militia group hizbollah as events surrounding the second lebanon war in the summer of 2006 demonstrate the clear potential for further cross border violence as well as the potential for a wider regional conflagration that embraces damascus and tehran remains as acute as ever this book focuses on the historical background of the conflict while also considering the role that other external actors most notably syria iran and the united nations play in influencing the conduct and outcomes of the israeli lebanese conflict in addition it also looks at hizbollah s increasing sway in lebanese domestic politics its increased military cooperation with iran and syria and the implications of such developments

with many forms of insecurity amid an often violent political and economic landscape providing a picture of what ordinary life is like for urban dwellers surviving sectarian violence the insecure city captures the day to day experiences of citizens of beirut moving through a war torn landscape while living in beirut kristin monroe conducted interviews with a diverse group of residents of the city she found that when people spoke about getting around in beirut they were also expressing larger concerns about social political and economic life it was not only violence that threatened beirut s ordinary residents but also class dynamics that made life even more precarious for instance the installation of checkpoints and the rerouting of traffic set up for the security of the elite forced the less fortunate to alter their lives in ways that made them more at risk similarly the ability to pass through security blockades often had to do with an individual s visible markers of class such as clothing hairstyle and type of car monroe examines how understandings and practices of spatial mobility in the city reflect social differences and how such experiences led residents to be bitterly critical of their government in the insecure city monroe takes urban anthropology in a new and meaningful direction discussing traffic in the middle east to show that when people move through beirut they are experiencing the intersection of citizen and state of the more and less privileged and in general the city s politically polarized geography

the ultimate history of the blitz and bombing in the second world war from wolfson prize winning historian and author richard overy the use of massive fleets of bombers to kill and terrorize civilians was an aspect of the second world war which continues to challenge the idea that allies specifically fought a moral war for britain bombing became perhaps its principal contribution to the fighting as night after night exceptionally brave men flew over occupied europe destroying its cities the bombing war radically overhauls our understanding of the war it is the first book to examine seriously not just the most well known parts of the campaign but the significance of bombing on many other fronts the german use of bombers on the eastern front for example as well as much newly discovered material on the more familiar blitz on britain or the allied campaigns against italian cities the result is the author s masterpiece a rich gripping picture of the second world war and the terrible military technological and ethical issues that relentlessly drove all its participants into an abyss reviews magnificent must now be regarded as the standard work on the bombing war it is probably the most important book published on the history of he second world war this century richard j evans guardian monumental this is a major contribution to one of the most controversial aspects of the second world war full of new detail and

perspectives hugely impressive james holland literary review this tremendous book does what the war it describes signally failed to do with a well thought out strategy and precision it delivers maximum force on its objectives the result is a masterpiece of the historian s art the times it is unlikely that a work of this scale scope and merit will be surpassed times higher education what distinguishes mr overy s account of the bombing war from lesser efforts is the wealth of narrative detail and analytical rigour that he brings to bear economist excellent overy is never less than an erudite and clear eyed guide whose research is impeccable and whose conclusions appear sensible and convincing even when they run against the established trends financial times hard to surpass if you want to know how bombing worked what it did and what it meant this is the book to read times literary supplement about the author richard overy is the author of a series of remarkable books on the second world war and the wider disasters of the twentieth century the dictators hitler s germany stalin s russia won both the wolfson prize for history and the hessell tiltman prize he is professor of history at the university of exeter penguin publishes 1939 countdown to war the morbid age russia s war interrogations the battle of britain and the dictators he lives in london

during 1942 and 1943 the striking power of raf bomber command was transformed by the arrival of heavy bombers advanced navigation and blind bombing systems and new tactics to concentrate the bombers over the target and swamp the german defences by october 1944 most of germany s cities were in ruins yet the bombing continued to intensify reaching unprecedented levels in the final seven months of the air campaign the value of further area raids was questioned during the opening months of 1945 yet the allies destroyed the remaining cities in a bid to hasten the end of the war the handful of german cities still largely unscathed in early february 1945 included dresden which was obliterated on 13 february ten days later the south german city of pforzheim was destined to suffer the same fate this book commemorates the efforts of the aircrew members who risked their lives consolidating a host of intriguing first hand accounts it also considers pforzheim as a representative community under national socialist rule the city s survivors remember the horror of the raid and its aftermath including eventual occupation by french colonial troops and subsequently american forces tony does an admirable job of presenting historical context when considering actions in times of extreme trauma and his narrative offers an intriguing engaging and poignant evocation of the closing months of bomber command s war

the arab uprisings have put lebanon under increased strain while the revolutions in tunisia and egypt caused limited reverberations the war in syria echoed in the fine tuned political and confessional balance of lebanon over one million refugees equal to one quarter of lebanon s population have moved in from syria the country s economy and its already weak public infrastructure have been impacted heavily hizbullah s engagement in syria has posed questions about lebanon s disassociation policy terrorist attacks by isil and the growing risk of radicalization across the confessional spectrum have left the country at unease however lebanon s political elites have vowed to shield the country from regional turbulences lebanon recently saw a series of demonstrations because of the inability of the government to manage the garbage crisis but it has been far from witnessing a large scale citizen uprising similar to the 2005 cedar revolution or the revolts next door this book provides a comprehensive overview of the current situation in lebanon and a detailed assessment of the difficulties which the country is currently facing
