in recent years attitudes in the united states toward the palestinian cause have shifted dramatically although palestinians have long been demonized in u s media and politics their struggle portrayed as illegitimate emergent progressive voices increasingly challenge the status quo on israel and palestine and express solidarity with palestinian resistance what accounts for this change and its evolution this book provides a new lens on activism around palestinian issues demonstrating how the global palestinian diaspora has driven transnational political movements karam dana explores the ways that exile has shaped palestinian identity and allowed for new forms of global activism he examines the social political economic and technological forces that have created space for palestinian voices to be heard by wider audiences worldwide drawing on interviews with scholars and advocates including members of the palestinian diaspora and jewish american activists as well as public opinion data and media analysis dana traces how global palestinian communities have influenced american views he addresses the backlash against pro palestinian advocacy but argues that solidarity with palestinians both in the united states and globally will continue to strengthen timely and insightful to stand with palestine offers an inside look at how palestinians have shared their story with the world and why sympathy for their plight is growing with significant implications for the global political landscape

analysis explains how hamas implemented a process of soft islamisation in gaza this was intended to build the institutional capacity of the authority based on the bureaucratisation and professionalisation of key institutions while selectively increasing the role of islam in society the book provides a detailed explanation of key shifts in hamas's political behaviour as it adapts to the vagaries and vicissitudes of governing gaza despite the imposition of israel's political and economic siege employing the inclusion moderation theoretical framework the book traces hamas's transformation from a non state armed group into a legitimate actor in palestinian politics the book's analysis also highlights the key role that hamas's national liberation agenda has on shifting its behaviour towards adopting more moderate and inclusive policy stances specifically the analysis demonstrates how hamas has made measurable shifts in its political behaviour towards accepting the primacy of the two state solution and its dealings with israel and the peace process the book provides a comprehensive assessment of hamas's time in government and its capacity to deal with the vicissitudes of governing it is a valuable resource for students and researchers interested in the israeli palestinian conflict and middle east politics

recent years have seen the israeli state become ever more extreme in its treatment of palestinians manifested both in legislation stripping palestinians of their rights and in the escalating scale and violence of the israeli occupation but this hard line stance has in turn provoked a new spirit of dissent among a growing number of israeli scholars and civil society activists as well as recognising palestinian claims to justice and self determination this new dissent is characterised by calls for genuine decolonisation and an end to partition as opposed to the now discredited two state solution through the analytical lens of settler colonial studies this book examines the impact of this new decolonial solidarity through case studies of three activist groups zochrot anarchists against the wall and the israeli committee against house demolitions icahd in doing so todorova extends the framework of settler colonial studies beyond scholarly analysis and into the realm of activist practice she also looks at how decolonial solidarity has shaped and been influenced by the writings of both palestinian and israeli theorists the book shows that new forms of civil society activism bringing together palestinian and israeli activists can rejuvenate the resistance to occupation and the israeli state's growing authoritarianism

this book is a comprehensive overview and analysis of the palestinians travail as they move from revolutionary movement to state barry rubin outlines the difficulties in the transition now under way arising from palestinian history society and diplomatic agreements he writes about the search for a national identity the choice of an economic system and the structure of government rubin finds the

political system interestingly distinctive it appears to be a pluralist dictatorship there are free elections multiple parties and some latitude in civil liberties yet there is a relatively unrestrained chief executive and arbitrariness in applying the law because of restraints on freedom the new ruling elite is a complex mixture of veteran revolutionaries heirs to large and wealthy families professional soldiers technocrats and islamic clerics beyond explaining how the executive and legislative branches work rubin factors in the role of public opinion in the peace process the place of nongovernmental institutions opposition movements and the palestinian authority's foreign relations including palestinian views and interactions with the arab world israel and the united states this book is drawn from documents in arabic hebrew and english as well as interviews and direct observations rubin finds that overall the positive aspects of the palestinian authority outweigh the negative and he foresees the establishment of a palestinian state his charting of the triumphs and difficulties of this state in the making helps predict and explain future dramatic developments in the middle east

the authors present the lives of biblical jewish leaders like queen esther and the prophetess deborah as well as modern unique personalities like supreme court justice ruth bader ginsburg and prime minister golda meier at the end of each biography is a section describing what young readers can do to understand the contribution made by these famous people as well as a detailed bibliography of where to find additional information about each woman

this book explores the nature of the severe conflict over immigration in Palestine during the British Mandate 1922-1948 it considers the perspectives of the British authorities the Palestinian Jewish community and the Palestinian Arabs in their permanent opposition to Jewish immigration expressed through strikes demonstrations and revolt towards the Jewish community in Palestine as well as the British authorities it serves to contribute to a debate in the history of Palestine whilst seeping into other disciplines such as economics sociology law and maritime history

prose award media and cultural studies finalist how diversity initiatives end up marginalizing arab americans and us muslims one of donald trump s first actions as president was to sign an executive order to limit muslim immigration to the united states a step toward the complete shutdown of muslims entering the united states he had campaigned on this extraordinary act of islamophobia provoked unprecedented opposition hollywood movies and mainstream television shows began to feature more muslim characters in contexts other than terrorism universities and private businesses included muslims in their diversity initiatives and the criminal justice system took hate crimes against muslims more seriously yet broken argues that even amid this challenge to institutionalized islamophobia diversity initiatives fail on their promise by only focusing on crisis moments evelyn alsultany argues that muslims get included through crisis diversity where high profile islamophobic incidents are urgently responded to and then ignored until the next crisis in the popular cultural arena of television this means interrogating even those representations of muslims that others have celebrated as refreshingly positive what kind of message does it send for example when a growing number of good muslims on tv seem to have arrived there ironically only after leaving the faith in the realm of corporations she critically examines the firing of high profile individuals for anti muslim speech a remedy that rebrands corporations as anti racist while institutional racism remains intact at universities muslim students get included in diversity equity and inclusion plans but that gets disrupted if they are involved in palestinian rights activism finally she turns to hate crime laws revealing how they fail to address root causes in each of these arenas alsultany finds an institutional pattern that defangs the promise of muslim inclusion deferring systemic change until and through the next crisis

a critique of the discourse of language revival in modern Hebrew literature on revival is a critique of one of the most important tenets of Zionist thinking Hebrew revival or the idea that Hebrew a largely unspoken language before the twentieth century was revitalized as part of a broader national revival which ultimately led to the establishment of the Israeli nation state this story of language revival has been commemorated in Israeli popular memory and in Jewish historiography as a triumphant transformation narrative that marks the success of the Zionist revolution but a closer look at the work of early twentieth century Hebrew writers reveals different sentiments Roni Henig explores the loaded

figurative discourse of revival in the work of hebrew authors and thinkers working roughly between 1890 and 1920 for these authors the language once known as the holy tongue became a vernacular in the making rather than embracing revival as a neutral descriptive term henig takes a critical approach employing close readings of canonical texts to analyze the primary tropes used to articulate this aesthetic and political project of reviving hebrew she shows that for many writers the national mission of language revival was entwined with a sense of mourning and loss these writers perceived and simultaneously produced the language as neither dead nor fully alive henig argues that it is this figure of the living dead that lies at the heart of the revival discourse and which is constitutive of jewish nationalism on revival contributes to current debates in comparative literary studies by addressing the limitations of the national language paradigm and thinking beyond concepts of origin nativity and possession in language informed by critical literary theory including feminist and postcolonial critiques the book challenges zionism's monolingual lens and the auto orientalism involved in the project of revival questioning charged ideological concepts such as native speaker and mother tongue
