beginning of the war the israeli defense force idf rejected the long proven principles of war in favor of a novel incoherent and confusing doctrine the war revealed the debilitating impact of a long counterinsurgency campaign on training and traditional combined arms capabilities finally despite the superb performance of the israeli air force iaf airpower and technology proved to be inconclusive and a poor substitute for well trained resolute maneuver forces directly engaging enemy forces

africa nations have contributed to peace operations in conflict zones across the world since the deployment of the united nations operations in the congo in 1960 this has placed africa as a major stakeholder in the maintenance of peace and security for over fifty years ghana has earned the international reputation as one of the largest and consistent troop contributing country in united nations mandated peace operations while ghana has long been an active contributor to peace operations there are few or no comparative studies that systematically analyze the actual roles played by troops in many of the different conflict context where they have served this book therefore focuses on a comparison

of two peace operations undertaken by the forces of an african nation in two different missions in lebanon and liberia

the 1979 islamic revolution triggered a cold war between iran and the united states former fast friends despite the us s relentless efforts at containment iran has risen as a formidable power in iraq syria lebanon yemen and gaza its newfound status not only frustrates the us but has swiftly become a thorn in the side of israel and saudi arabia how did iran rise so rapidly and as it faces ever increasing pressure at home and abroad can it hold onto its power mohsen milani guides us through the twists and turns of the iran us rivalry in the battlefields of the middle east going from the fall of the shah to revolutionary iran s alliances with syria hamas hezbollah iraqi militias and the houthis in the axis of resistance milani lifts the veil on iran s foreign policy strategy and its implications for the region the us and iran itself

traditionally american jews have been broadly liberal in their political outlook indeed african americans are the only ethnic group more likely to vote democratic in us elections over the past half century however attitudes on one topic have stood in sharp contrast to this group s generally progressive stance support for israel despite israel s record of militarism illegal settlements and human rights violations american jews have stretching back to the 1960s remained largely steadfast supporters of the jewish homeland but as norman finkelstein explains in an elegantly argued and richly textured new book this is now beginning to change reports by human rights watch amnesty international and the united nations and books by commentators as prominent as president jimmy carter and as well respected in the scholarly community as stephen walt john mearsheimer and peter beinart have increasingly pinpointed the fundamental illiberalism of the israeli state in the light of these exposes the support of america jews for israel has begun to fray this erosion has been particularly marked among younger members of the community a 2010 brandeis university poll found that only about one quarter of jews aged under 40 today feel very much connected to israel in successive chapters that combine finkelstein s customary meticulous research with polemical brio knowing too much sets the work of defenders of israel such as jeffrey goldberg michael oren dennis ross and benny

morris against the historical record showing their claims to be increasingly tendentious as growing numbers of american jews come to see the speciousness of the arguments behind such apologias and recognize israel s record as simply indefensible finkelstein points to the opening of new possibilities for political advancement in a region that for decades has been stuck fast in a gridlock of injustice and suffering

delegitimation has become the new battleground for israel and the critics of israeli military operations but the israeli experience reveals a more general engagement where all states act strategically to build legitimacy for their policies and all resist attempts at delegitimation to understand these processes it is necessary to see how politicized moral and legal judgments shape both the use of force by states and our judgments about the means and the outcomes this is a book about legitimacy military lawyers and security more particularly it is about how the legitimacy of israel s asymmetric military operations cannot be detached from the politics of law and ethics sometimes it is enough that states respect the laws of armed conflict but at other times they may be held to a higher

standard this does not happen in a vacuum rather it is the product of political engagement in the murky politics of international legitimacy where standards are negotiable and some states get a harder time than others there is a strong theoretical analysis underpinning a discussion that constantly returns to the practical problems of modern armed conflict where combatants hide among civilians and states complain about the unrealistic expectations of human rights ngos here the law is unclear and there are choices to be made the book presents new research into the involvement of israeli military lawyers in operational targeting decision making that has life and death consequences the case studies concern targeted killing during the second intifada israel s 2006 lebanon war the 2009 operation cast lead in gaza and finally the 2010 israeli maritime interception of the turkish flotilla to gaza the investigation identifies a struggle between the proponents of human rights in war and those who promote the rights of states to deploy military force for the security of their citizens but not all parties to a military conflict are held to the same standards in fact the analysis maps a complex political deployment of law and ethics in the strategic calculation of legitimacy

however the existing literature on territorial conflict rarely scrutinizes a pivotal related question what makes a state withdraw from an occupied territory or entrench itself within it in understanding territorial withdrawal rob geist pinfold addresses this research gap he focuses primarily on israel a unique but important milieu that offers pertinent lessons for other states facing similar policy problems as pinfold demonstrates occupiers choose to either perpetuate or abandon an occupation because of three factors their relations with the occupied interactions with third parties and the occupier s domestic politics he argues that each withdrawal is the culmination of a gradual process of policy re assessment critically it is a combination of local violence and international pressure that causes popular and elite opinion within the occupier to endorse an exit rather than perpetuate the status quo to affirm this pattern pinfold constructs a generalizable framework for understanding territorial withdrawal he then applies this framework to multiple case studies which include israel s withdrawal from the sinai peninsula between 1974 1982 its unilateral withdrawal from southern lebanon in 2000 and its unilateral disengagement from the gaza strip in 2005 as well as
