the twentieth and twenty first centuries have seen states engaged in long term conflicts with asymmetrically weaker non state actors nsa states aim to end these conflicts as quickly as possible by combining force and diplomacy to socialize these militants meaning give them the characteristics of states in order to make a credible bargain achievable the militant s characteristics determine the state s optimal strategy in times of conflict politicians and pundits often march out an oft cited phrase in support of negotiations if you want to make peace you don t talk to your friends you talk to your enemies this is only possible when the opponent is willing to make peace under acceptable terms and able to enforce abidance some opponents have an ideologically driven fundamental purpose that precludes renouncing violence under terms that a state could accept

others have reasonable demands and are structured in a way that allows productive negotiations in other cases the non state militant is not yet the type that can be bargained with but can be socialized into this type through a state s correct application of force and diplomacy i call this socialization logic i argue that optimally states tailor their strategy to socialize with their opponent to make it possible to successfully negotiate peace in practice the state s strategy is often distorted by its internal and external constraints socialization logic provides a novel typology of non state militants based on how well interstate conflict bargaining concepts can be applied to them it looks beyond tactics to systematize a framework for understanding how leaders tailor strategy towards non state opponents based on their characteristics socialization logic examines the nsa type as endogenous to the strategy that the state employs and provides a framework for leaders to design a strategy to end the conflict finally

socialization logic synthesizes critical nsa attributes ideology leadership structure and governance function and the state s strategy distorted by constraints into in an interactive model through 41 interviews primary and secondary source data i analyze the united states russia s and israel s asymmetric conflicts with militants and demonstrate that socialization logic most comprehensively explains their strategies throughout those conflicts

under the rule of recep tayyip erdogan turkey has descended into a dictatorship promotes the islamist agenda abuses human rights limits freedom of expression in the press and wages war against the kurds while turkey has historically been important geopolitically it has become an outlier in europe and an uncertain ally of the united states an uncertain ally is a straightforward indictment of erdogan drawing on inside sources in his justice and development party akp and the police the book

reveals corruption and money laundering schemes that benefitted erdogan his cronies and family members erdogan has polarized turkish society and created conditions that led to the coup attempt of july 2016 he has also deepened divisions by accusing fethullah gulen an islamic teacher in pennsylvania of establishing a parallel state and masterminding the coup attempt erdogan has seized on the failed coup to justify a witch hunt arresting thousands and ordering the wholesale dismissal of alleged coup sympathizers rather than foster reconciliation he pursued vendettas and turned turkey into a gulag an uncertain ally exposes turkey s ties to jihadists in syria and the islamic state questioning its suitability as a nato member under erdogan turkey faces a dark future that poses a danger to the region and internationally

this book here john pedler takes the broadest of views ranging from politics and science to religion and beyond and paints a picture of the world as most of us have yet to see it as a former diplomat there is almost nowhere he does not know and as a writer he puts a thousand stories together and makes elegant and convincing sense of them this book is for all those worldwide with an interest in foreign affairs who are increasingly concerned about climate change over population and the spread of religious violence fearing that the world s politicians may be taking us in the wrong direction john pedler now 86 joined the british diplomatic service in 1951 and has ever since been involved with foreign affairs this is his weltanschauung world view a new genre in which he sets out how he has come to see our world and what may lie beyond subjects include russia and the eu our wars vietnam afghan and iraq sex in politics political correctness advertising media self censorship and news international world religions and

islam moderate wahabist and jihadist it s in the form of answers to his adult children s questions so it s an easy and often gripping read as well as his diplomatic postings in europe and the far east john pedler was a war correspondent in vietnam a businessman in mao s china and the first director of the cambodia trust he worked for the bosnian government during the siege of sarajevo he was educated at the browne and nicholls school cambridge mass usa and the london school of economics where he took a subsidiary course in comparative religion

none but these assertions are enough to establish the foreign policy of western countries the author a former agent of the swiss strategic intelligence service reviews the main contemporary conflicts that western countries have managed with fake news over the last thirty years jacques baud a colonel chemical and nuclear weapons expert trained in counter terrorism and counter guerrilla warfare designed the geneva international centre for humanitarian demining gichd and its information management system for mine action imsmma in the service of the united nations he served as chief of doctrine for peacekeeping operations in new york and was engaged in africa in nato he led the fight against the proliferation of small arms he is the author of several books on intelligence asymmetric warfare and terrorism

this book documents the case that world war ii happened in such a different world that it has little relevance to today s foreign policy as

well as the case that u s participation in wwii was not justifiable specifically wwii was not fought to rescue anyone from persecution was not necessary for defense was the most damaging and destructive event yet to occur and would not have happened had any one of these factors been missing world war i the manner in which wwi was ended u s funding and arming of nazis a u s arms race with japan u s development of racial segregation u s development of eugenics u s development of genocide and ethnic cleansing or the u s and british prioritization of opposing the soviet union at all costs the author corrects numerous misconceptions about the most popular and misunderstood war in western culture in order to build a case for moving to a world beyond war

iran and a deeply unsettled broader region in which nominally pro western states began to recalibrate their relations with washington even as they welcomed deeper roles for its key rivals russia and china in wars of ambition afshon ostovar explores the evolution of the long and metastasizing conflict as it unfolded over a span of more than two decades not just a sweeping account of the dynamic interaction between america s middle east policies and ambitious regional states on the receiving end it also provides a powerful analysis of conflicting visions of the future that transcend regional politics with iran s rise and its revisionist campaign running in concert with those of russia and china the contest for the middle east has become a microcosm of a larger geopolitical battle between those aiming to preserve the american led global order and those seeking to overturn it ostovar s vivid history of this enormously complex conflict shows how the battle for the middle east reflects the politics and dividing lines of an

institutional building and policy making process he reveals that the philosophical and theoretical knowledge that underlies the interface between the mode of governance and policy design create the consensus of values norms and indicators between experts public servants donors and communities in post conflict settings the author also shares illuminating case studies by way of his considerable wealth of experience leading reconstructive efforts in afghanistan and cambodia
