s pugnacious president is now the country's longest serving leader on his way to the top he has fought many wars this book tells the story of those battles against domestic enemies through the lens of the syrian conflict which has become part and parcel of erdoğan's fight to remain in power turkey expert gönül tol traces erdoğan's ideological evolution from a conservative democrat to an islamist and a turkish nationalist and explores how this progression has come to shape his syria policy changing the course of the war she paints a vivid picture of the president's constantly shifting strategy to consolidate his rule showing that these shifts have transformed turkey's role in post uprising syria from an advocate of democracy to a power fanning the flames of civil war to an occupier from the first days of erdoğan's rule through the failed coup against him via the kurdis peace process the arab uprisings and the refugee crisis this compelling authoritative book tells the

story of one man's quest to remain in power tying together the fates of two countries and changing them both forever

this book is an introduction to right wing populist movements outside the west looking at four key case studies their commonalities and differences populism has been on the rise worldwide since the global financial crisis of 2008 with few countries left entirely untouched by the phenomenon at the same time the specific circumstances of different countries vary considerably and it is important that in seeking to understand these movements we do not assume they are all the same albeit that they have some characteristics in common this book takes the case studies of india turkey russia and brazil in turn examining how they have each taken quite distinct journeys to similar destinations it offers both a better understanding of each country's slide towards strongman authoritarianism and an analysis of the

common elements shared between them this book is an essential introduction to the rise of populism outside the west for students of international political economy and comparative politics

the odd couple details the ups and downs in the tortuous relations between modern turkey and israel the central actor in the book is tayyip erdogan who came to power in turkey in 2002 2003 determined to turn the clock back and return his country to its pre ataturk glory when the ottoman dynasty reigned supreme and islam was the dominant ideology holding the empire together to understand the aberrant relationship between the jewish state of israel and the islamic state of turkey and the preponderant role of tayyip erdogan in its deterioration one must dig into the ottoman past the historical attitudes of turks to jews and the shift in turkish policies that was effected by the transition from the modern turkish civil governments up to 2002 to the vast changes that the

islamic parties of erbakan and erdogan have triggered thereafter this is the story of how one man can alter relations between two countries

proxy warfare will shape the conflicts of the twenty first century for the foreseeable future yet the popular understanding of proxy wars remains largely shaped by the experience of the cold war in reality in the greater middle east and its periphery today the growing power of regional states and non state actors combined with the proliferation of new technology has reshaped proxy conflicts in an increasingly multipolar and interconnected environment in this collected volume a range of researchers examine what constitutes proxy warfare and provide new insight into how these wars are waged in contexts stretching from ukraine to north africa and syria to afghanistan the volume draws upon research surveys and interviews conducted in syria iraq libya and ukraine as well as examining the propaganda output of those involved in

these countries wars in doing so understanding the new proxy wars helps reveal both the continuities and the differences between recent conflicts and those of times past

an incisive account of erdoğan s turkey showing how its troubling transformation may be short lived since coming to power in 2002 recep tayyip erdoğan has overseen a radical transformation of turkey once a pillar of the western alliance the country has embarked on a militaristic foreign policy intervening in regional flashpoints from nagorno karabakh to libya and its democracy sustained by the aspiration to join the european union has given way to one man rule dimitar bechev traces the political trajectory of erdoğan s populist regime from the era of reform and prosperity in the 2000s to the effects of the war in neighboring syria in a tale of missed opportunities bechev explores how turkey parted ways with the united states and europe embraced putin s russia and other

revisionist powers and replaced a frail democratic regime with an authoritarian one despite this he argues that turkey s democratic instincts are resilient its economic ties to europe are as strong as ever and erdoğan will fail to achieve a fully autocratic regime

can cause human rights abuses political repression and even ethnic cleansing enemies within is the first book to systematically investigate the roots and implications of the politics of fifth columns in this volume a multidisciplinary group of leading scholars address several related questions when are actors likely to employ fifth column claims and against whom what accounts for changes in fifth column framing over time how do the claims and rhetoric of governments differ from those of societal groups how do accusations against ethnically or ideologically defined groups differ finally how do actors labeled as fifth columns respond to answer these questions the contributors apply a common theoretical framework and work within the tradition of qualitative social science to analyze cases from three continents oftentimes challenging conventional wisdom enemies within offers a unique perspective to better understand contemporary challenges including the rise of populism and

authoritarianism the return of chauvinistic nationalism the weakening of democratic norms and the persecution of ethnic or religious minorities and political dissidents

how do ideologies shape international relations in general and middle eastern countries relations with the united states in particular the clash of ideologies by mark I haas explores this critical question haas s central claim is that leaders ideological beliefs are likely to have profound effects on these individuals perceptions of international threats these threat perceptions in turn shape leaders core security policies including choices of allies and enemies and efforts to spread their ideological principles abroad as a key means of advancing their interests two variables are particularly important in this process the degree of ideological differences dividing different groups of decision makers ideological distance and the number of prominent ideologies that are present in a particular

system ideological polarity the argument is tested in four case studies of states foreign policies primarily since the end of the cold war iran saudi arabia syria and turkey as the argument predicts ideological differences in these cases were a key cause of international conflict and ideological similarities a source of cooperation moreover different ideological groups in the same country at the same time often possessed very different understandings of their threat environments and thus very different foreign policy preferences these are findings that other prominent international relations theories particularly realism cannot explain the purposes of the book go beyond advancing theoretical debates in the international relations literature it also aims to provide policy guidance on key international security issues these prescriptions are designed to advance america s interests in the middle east in particular namely how u s leaders should best respond to the

ideological dynamics that exist in the region

this work presents an exhaustive list of flagrant human rights violations to the degree of social genocide perpetrated after the coup attempt of 15 July 2016 the political islamist and ultra nationalist power bloc led by president recep tayyip erdog an has built an iron fisted regime with the state of emergency ohal launched on July 21 2016 and the consecutive unsupervised statutory decrees khk in this process nearly 8 million people from all walks of life including their families were fired from their jobs investigated deprived of their freedom ostracized from society and almost driven to annihilation even though they had nothing to do with the coup years before the coup attempt dissidents were identified through unlawfully carried out filings via the denunciations and unfettered and uncontrolled attainments of civil authorities intelligence and even ordinary people with the aforementioned profiling 152 000 civil servants were

dismissed from their duties without even taking their statements for their critical views about the government or for their affiliations with the hizmet movement institutions and workplaces known to be close to hizmet were closed and nearly 200 000 employees were dismissed deprived of all their inalienable rights although there is an attempt to create a perception in the public opinion of turkey and the world that the decree laws were issued solely for the purpose of dismissals the actual situation was far more different than that turkey s political islamist and ultra nationalist government bloc has in effect purportedly abused the khks for a number of various social genocide methods against the hizmet members and critical figures such as abduction enforced disappearance torture long detention years of solitary confinement social isolation marginalization dehumanization and demonization the violations of rights and social genocide practices to which the ohal and khk victims are

subjected differ according to the arbitrariness and discrimination of the officials in the places the victims live or in the public and social areas they apply to within this framework the report identified 143 rights violations and social genocide practices since some of these practices are executed publicly it is known to everyone we have noted some of them during research and interviews the fact that many violations of rights were noticed in this way shows the possibility that there may be many more violations of rights that have not yet been identified in this regard the study of rights violations will be updated in future editions with new applications and new findings

this book offers an in depth overview of turkish history and politics essential for understanding contemporary turkey it presents an analysis on a number of key issues from gender inequality to islamism to urban regeneration based on interviews with leading intellectuals and academics

from turkey the book s theme follows the dramatic transformations that have occurred from the 1980 military coup to the coup attempt of 2016 and its aftermath it further draws attention to the global flows of capital goods ideas and technologies that continue to influence both mainstream and dissident politics by doing so the book tries to unsettle the assumption that erdoğan and his islamic ideology are the sole actors in contemporary turkey this book provides unusual insight into the turkish society bringing various topics together and increases the dialogue for people interested in democratic struggles in 21st century under neoliberal authoritarian regimes in general

a fieldwork based account of the role of populism personalism and organisation in the rise of erdoğan s jdp to authoritarian predominance

turkey has gone through significant transformations over the last century from

the ottoman empire and young turk era to the republic of today but throughout it has demonstrated troubling continuities in its encouragement and deployment of mass violence in particular the construction of a muslim turkish identity has been achieved in part by designating internal enemies at whom public hatred can be directed this volume provides a wide range of case studies and historiographical reflections on the alarming recurrence of such violence in turkish history as atrocities against varied ethnic religious groups from the nineteenth century to today have propelled the nation s very sense of itself

announcing that hagia sophia would now be modified into a mosque this decision provoked fierce criticism from unesco because hagia sophia was enjoying world heritage site benefits the united states the european union russia and greece all chimed in however erdoğan s action was wildly popular in turkey with its 99 muslim population why is hagia sophia so important to modern turkey why this provocative decision and why now how could all the international critics be ignored why does the world care so much about this old building why should it continue to care this book explains president erdoğan s controversial decision in terms of turkey s national independent and islamic politics and as a response to the mosque massacre in christchurch in march 2019 when his life was threatened by the gunman any consideration of hagia sophia s present and future also requires appreciation of the almost 1 500 year old story of this architectural marvel from its inception as

a church in 537 to its configuration as a mosque in 2020 and beyond because all world heritage sites depend on national management hagia sophia will remain turkey s responsibility but the international community is watching to ensure turkey honours hagia sophia s entire heritage from the 6th century to the 21st century

is the armenian genocide a strictly historical matter if that is the case why is it still a topical issue capable of causing diplomatic rows and heated debates the short answer would be that the century old armenian genocide is much more than a historical question it emerged as a political dilemma on the international arena at the san stefano peace conference in 1878 and has remained as such into our days the disparity between knowledge and acknowledgement mainly ascribable to turkey s official denial of the genocide has only heightened the politicization of the armenian question thus the memories of the wwi era refuse to be

relegated to the pages of history but are rather perceived as a vivid presence this is the result of the perpetual process of politics of memory the politics of memory is an intricate and interdisciplinary negotiation engaging many different actors in the society who have access to a wide range of resources and measures in order to achieve their goals by following the armenian question during the past century up to its centennial commemoration in 2015 this study aims to explain why and how the politics of memory of the armenian genocide has kept it as a topical issue in our days

the context behind the murder and attempted cover up he shows how a power struggle between erdogan and saudi arabia s crown prince mohammed bin salman known as mbs had such fatal results the prince had seemed to promise a new and more open era for his country while also investing vast sums in arms deals with the west inevitably other nations including president trump and the usa were drawn into the affair which created the biggest crisis in us saudi relations since 9 11 skilfully rugman draws together all the strands to tell a gripping story of one man s tragedy that had global consequences
