this book provides a new theory for how democracy can materialize in the middle east and the broader muslim world it shows that one pathway to democratization lays not in resolving important but often irreconcilable debates about the role of religion in politics rather it requires that islamists and their secular opponents focus on the concerns of pragmatic survival that is compromise through pacting rather than battling through difficult philosophical issues about faith this is the only book length treatment of this topic and one that aims to redefine the boundaries of an urgent problem that continues to haunt struggles for democracy in the aftermath of the arab spring

islamist movements drawing on extensive fieldwork with grassroots activists of tunisia s all nahda rory mccarthy focuses on the lived experience of activism to offer a challenging new perspective on one of the middle east s most successful islamist projects original evidence explains how all nahda survived two decades of brutal repression in prison and in social exclusion and reveals what price the movement paid for a new strategy of pragmatism and reform during the tunisian transition away from authoritarianism

an innovative analysis that traces the continuity of the state s custodianship of islam as the preferred religion in the middle east and north africa in the making of the modern muslim state malika zeghal reframes the role of islam in modern middle east governance challenging other accounts that claim that middle eastern states turned secular in modern times zeghal shows instead the continuity of the state s custodianship of islam as the preferred religion drawing on intellectual political and economic history she traces this custodianship from early forms of constitutional governance in the nineteenth century through post arab

spring experiments in democracy zeghal argues that the intense debates around the implementation and meaning of state support for islam led to a political cleavage between conservatives and their opponents that long predated the polarization of the twentieth century that accompanied the emergence of mass politics and islamist movements examining constitutional projects public spending school enrollments and curricula zeghal shows that although modern muslim majority polities have imported western techniques of governance the state has continued to protect and support the religion community and institutions of islam she finds that even as middle eastern states have expanded their nonreligious undertakings they have dramatically increased their per capita supply of public religious provisions especially islamic education further feeding the political schism between islamists and their adversaries zeghal illuminates the tensions inherent in the partnerships between states and the body of muslim scholars known as the ulama whose normative power has endured through a variety of political regimes her detailed and groundbreaking analysis which spans tunisia morocco egypt turkey syria and lebanon makes clear the deep historical

roots of current political divisions over islam in governance

from late 2010 to the present day the arab world has been shot through with insurrection and revolt as a result tunisia is now seen as the unlikely birth place and exemplar of the process of democratisation long overdue in the arab world mixing political historical economic social and cultural analyses and approaches these essays reflect on the local regional and transnational dynamics together with the long and short term factors that when combined set in motion the tunisian revolution and the arab uprisings above all the book maps the intertwined genealogies of cultural dissent that have contributed to the mobilisation of protesters and to the sustenance of protests between 17 december 2010 and 14 january 2011 and beyond

the arab uprisings that swept the middle east and north africa in the period from 2011 2012 left an indelible mark on the socio political landscape of the region but that mark was not consistent across the region while some countries underwent dramatic popular social and political changes others teetered on the brink or were left with the status quo intact street revolutions toppled despotic regimes in tunisia libya and momentarily in egypt while mounting serious challenges to authoritarian regimes in syria and yemen algeria s entrenched bureaucratic cum military authoritarian system proved resilient until the recent events of early 2019 which forced the resignation of president abdelaziz bouteflika before the end of his term on 28 april 2019 as in algeria protestors in sudan succeeded after months of demonstrations in overthrowing the government of omar al bashir several arab monarchies still appear stable and have managed to weather the tempest of the arab revolutions albeit not without fissures showing in the edifice of their states accompanied by some minor constitutional changes where tunisians egyptians yemenis syrians and libyans demanded regime changes in their political systems protesters in the arab monarchies have called on the kings and emirs to reform their political system from the top down indicating the sizeable monarchical advantage historical dictionary of the arab uprisings contains a chronology an introduction and an

extensive bibliography the dictionary section has over 500 cross referenced entries on the terms persons and events that shaped the arab spring uprisings this book is an excellent resource for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about the arab uprisings

drawing on the history of post independence tunisia the book studies the evolution of all nahdah as a political party in tunisia and its role in a protracted struggle to shape the post authoritarian order along democratic lines it explores al nahdah s relationship with the tunisian state society and beyond that resulted in shaping its fluctuating expressions of ideology and practices state repression political participation or internal differentiation among other factors place an islamic movement in this case al nahdah in such a situation that demands a perpetual self re evaluation as well as implementation of ideology objectives and political programmes the study explains how the socio political setting in tunisia demanded various ideologically opposite currents islamic liberal or leftist to endure cross ideological cooperation either to contest authoritarian regimes or to engage in the political process it more importantly analyzes the trajectory

of a gradual democratization process in the country and provides evidence explaining the impact and importance of a vibrant civil society building alliances and sharing of power the book provides comparative analytical attention to the primary sources on these issues to create a critical historiography it thus adds to the body of literature on the state society and politics in the mena region and particularly targets students scholars and social scientists interested in understanding the nature of power and politics in tunisia and beyond

s history of reform in the realms of education religion and women s rights arguing that the seeds for today s relatively liberal and democratic society were planted as far back as the middle of the nineteenth century masri argues that tunisia stands out not as a model that can be replicated in other arab countries but rather as an anomaly as its history of reformism set it on a separate trajectory from the rest of the region the narrative explores notions of identity the relationship between islam and society and the hegemonic role of religion in shaping educational social and political agendas across the arab region based on interviews with dozens of experts leaders activists and ordinary citizens and a synthesis of a rich body of knowledge masri provides a sensitive often personal account that is critical for understanding not only tunisia but also the broader arab world

today the world system is in a transition and experiencing a deep international crisis the u s has begun to oppose the basic international institutions such as the united nations and its subsidiary organs and specialized agencies even though most of these were established with american motivation the hegemon state the u s has been alienating most of its partners and even allies the u s governments have begun to focus on national setting and underestimate the international one to favor unilateral policies over multilateral ones the presidency of donald trump has expedited this process american rejection of providing global public goods such as international security and free trade has led to a systemic crisis the relative decline of american power coincides with the persistent rise of china those who claim that the days of pax americana are numbered assert that the rise of china will determine the future of the world system china has begun to expand its influence worldwide for this purpose it has established alternative political and economic international institutions such as the shanghai cooperation organization sco and the asian infrastructure investment bank aiib furthermore china leads the establishment of some other international organizations as well brics is only one of these formations challenging the political hegemony of the west led by the u s one of the most promising chinese projects is the one belt one road obor project aspiring to connect the east china to the west the world markets it is expected that on its completion the obor project will take china to the center of the world economy and politics china has been the fastest growing economy in the world for the last thirty years its share of the world trade has increased dramatically recording the highest share in world exports for several years china has been enjoying economic transactions with all major international actors with more than 200 partners in exports and imports however in terms of per capita income china still lags behind the

advanced western countries furthermore according to the calculations made by the world bank and imf chinese per capita income is still lower than the world average china recently began to invest in the political and military sphere in the non western world it has military bases in its near abroad and in the african continent that is chinese economic influence and technological leadership is supported by its political and military power in spite of the increase in chinese military and political might it is careful not to challenge the u s and the west there are several reasons for this policy first of all china is aware of its vulnerabilities it suffers some economic and political inconsistencies and weaknesses for instance it has to fortify its regional dominance first in the south china sea and achieve its longtime one china policy as a precondition for a possible global hegemony second china wants to win the global rivalry without resorting to war with the current hegemon therefore chinese leaders refrain from opposing the american hegemony politically even though it has introduced some international institutions the chinese leadership does not propose a political and diplomatic alternative to the west it will take time for china to offer a full scale global leadership

alternative to the world since the global hegemony requires not only economic and military power but also values and norms for cultural hegemony lastly china is not ready to take the global responsibility since it brings high costs as long as the current american hegemony works in favor of china there is no need for china to change the course of its development in the light of these developments this issue of insight turkey focuses on some of the most important topics related to china s persistent rise in the international system more specifically this issue postulates on how to read and understand china s policies towards global powers i e the u s and russia and regional powers i e india and turkey africa has once again returned to the attention of the global powers after being left for many years in the shadow of western politics in recent years africa has become the center of china s public
