yemen has experienced wrenching changes that have transformed the country in yet unknown ways the country exploded in a popular revolution against the long time rule of ali abdallah saleh while the country appeared to

slip toward civil war yemeni political elite rallied with international backers to put together a transitional government with a plan to revise the country s constitution the transitional government began with a cautious sense of optimism and the prospect of substantial change for the better but ended in collapse because of a failure to govern the politics of the street overran an ineffective transitional government that could not address the urgent concerns of yemeni citizens for security and jobs instead populist leaders exploited people s dissatisfactions and threw the country into civil war the houthi organization covertly allied with its former enemy ali abdallah saleh to overthrow the transitional government and declare war on the rest of the country saleh seems unable to conceive of life outside of the presidential palace and his houthi allies appear to believe they are destined to rule unfortunately those opposed to saleh and the houthi also seem unable to provide effective rule in spite of massive backing from the gulf states the incompetence infighting and incoherence of the hadi government bode equally ill for the future of the country the one hope may be that a new generation of yemeni

leaders emerges to displace the dismal failures of this one this third edition of historical dictionary of yemen contains a chronology an introduction appendixes and an extensive bibliography the dictionary section has over 1000 cross referenced entries on important personalities politics economy foreign relations religion and culture this book is an excellent resource for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about yemen

in recent years al qaeda in the arabian peninsula aqap has been widely recognized as a more dangerous regional and international terrorist organization than the original al qaeda led by osama bin laden until his death in 2011 in 2010 11 aqap was able to present a strong challenge to yemen s government by capturing and retaining large areas in the southern part of the country yemen s new reform president defeated aqap and recaptured areas under their control in 2012 but the terrorists remain an extremely dangerous force seeking to reassert themselves at this time of transition in yemen

we devote this volume to an examination of the apparent shift in the use of force in defending us interests and in furthering us national

security policy the nation s use of unmanned aerial vehicles in lieu of more conventional military capabilities has been increasing significantly since the beginning of the century commonly referred to as drones these surveillance and weapons systems appear to offer many advantages they allow the united states to apply force in areas otherwise inaccessible to military units drones are beginning to be used domestically for law enforcement purposes this volume on drones focuses on international use of the systems the following volume will address domestic use of drones

the unintended deaths of civilians in war are too often dismissed as unavoidable inevitable and accidental and despite the best efforts of the u s to avoid them civilian casualties in afghanistan iraq and pakistan have been a regular feature of the united states wars after 9 11 in accountability for killing neta c crawford focuses on the causes of these many episodes of foreseeable collateral damage and the moral responsibility for them the dominant paradigm of legal and moral responsibility in war today stresses both intention and individual

accountability deliberate killing of civilians is outlawed and international law blames individual soldiers and commanders for such killing an individual soldier may be sentenced life in prison or death for deliberately killing even a small number of civilians but the large scale killing of dozens or even hundreds of civilians may be forgiven if it was unintentional incidental to a military operation the very law that protects noncombatants from deliberate killing may allow many episodes of unintended killing under international law civilian killing may be forgiven if it was unintended and incidental to a militarily necessary operation given the nature of contemporary war where military organizations training and the choice of weapons doctrine and tactics create the conditions for systemic collateral damage crawford contends that placing moral responsibility for systemic collateral damage on individuals is misplaced she develops a new theory of organizational moral agency and responsibility and shows how the us military exercised moral agency and moral responsibility to reduce the incidence of collateral damage in america s most recent wars indeed when the u s military and its allies

saw that the perception of collateral damage killing was causing it to lose support in the war zones it moved to a population centric doctrine putting civilian protection at the heart of its strategy trenchant original and ranging across security studies international law ethics and international relations accountability for killing will reshape our understanding of the ethics of contemporary war

this book analyzes the civil war in yemen and how intervening external actors have shaped the trajectory of the conflict the work examines the conflict in yemen as a testing ground for expectations about the autonomy and control of proxies by external patrons and the direct consequences for civilian victimization and duration of war like other proxy wars the international dimensions of the war made the conflict in yemen subject to the geopolitical interests of intervening powers the longstanding power rivalry between saudi arabia and iran over middle east supremacy resulted in a competitive intervention in yemen where the initial belligerents of the civil war the houthi and the hadi regime were used as proxies by tehran and the gulf coalition led by

rivadh respectively their intervention ultimately translated into a prolonged and destructive conflict the often contradictory and self interested patronage strategies by the coalition s two central patrons saudi arabia and the united arab emirates undermined their broader goal of containing iran however iran s support for the houthis enabled them to bait and bleed the gulf coalition lastly in an effort to balance against iran the united states underwrote the military campaign of the gulf states with military hardware and personnel thereby further prolonging the conflict and humanitarian disaster this book concludes that intervention by external patrons both protracted the civil war and made it far more destructive for the civilian population this book will be of much interest to students of proxy wars middle eastern conflict and security studies in general

this book analyses the primary relevant rules of international law applicable to extra territorial use of force by states against non state actors force in this context takes many forms ranging from targeted killings and abductions of individuals to large scale military operations

amounting to armed conflict actions of this type have occurred in what has become known as the war on terror but are not limited to this context three frameworks of international law are examined in detail these are the united nations charter and framework of international law regulating the resort to force in the territory of other states the law of armed conflict often referred to as international humanitarian law and the law enforcement framework found in international human rights law the book examines the applicability of these frameworks to extra territorial forcible measures against non state actors and analyses the difficulties and challenges presented by application of the rules to these measures the issues covered include among others the possibility of self defence against non state actors including anticipatory self defence the lawfulness of measures which do not conform to the parameters of self defence the classification of extra territorial force against non state actors as armed conflict the war on terror as an armed conflict the laws of armed conflict regulating force against groups and individuals the extra territorial applicability of international human rights law and the regulation of forcible
