helping to counter acts of terror and violence evidence based research is used to identify how women can be empowered to enhance the fight against terrorism and to identify opportunities for substantive meaningful roles across a wide spectrum of counter terrorism activities given current and emerging threats the book focuses in particular on nato countries partners in the middle east and north africa and will be of particular interest to all those involved with security and gender issues

face veiling is relatively new in indonesia it is often stereotyped as a sign of extremism and the growing arabisation of indonesian muslims it is also perceived as a symbol that demonstrates a lack of female agency however increasing numbers of women are choosing to wear the cadar the full face veil this book provides an ethnographic study of these women why they choose to wear the cadar embody strict religious disciplinary practices and the consequences of that choice the women in this book belong to two islamic revivalist movements various salafi groups and the tablighi jamā'at indonesia has constantly witnessed transformations in the meanings and practices of islam and this demonstrates that women are key actors in this process nisa demonstrates that contrary to stereotypes the women in this study have an agency which is expressed through their chosen docility and obedience

women in islam investigates the ongoing debate across the muslim world and the west on the position of women in islam anne sofie roald focuses on how islamic perceptions of women and gender change in western muslim communities she shows how islamic attitudes towards social concerns such as gender relations female circumcision and female dress emerge as responsive to culture and context rather than rigid and inflexible

in the security archipelago
