relations between Egypt and Turkey have always progressed on a sustainable trajectory since the establishment of ties in 1925 despite ups and downs during specific periods the deterioration in bilateral relations that began with the military coup in Egypt in 2013 and the years long diplomatic stalemate show signs of softening in 2020 there were several occasions where Turkish and Egyptian officials announced that formal closed door meetings were being held between the diplomatic and intelligence officials of the two countries that is still the case in 2021 as well as it became official with the departure of a diplomatic delegation from Turkey to Egypt on May 5-6 after negotiations were held to end the crisis the questions as to which country initiated the normalization process between the two countries or which country needs it more are less important than the normalization process itself at this point the normalization of relations between Turkey and Egypt has the potential to affect many regional developments in addition to that specific dynamics of the two countries the impact of regional developments and the roles of external actors should be taken into consideration in the analysis for instance the competition in the eastern Mediterranean is becoming a wearing and unsustainable process for both countries this aspect of the conflict can be shown as an important dynamic of the normalization process between the two while Turkey does not prefer the strengthening of the alliance against itself in the region Egypt accepted that there could be no equation in the eastern Mediterranean that does not include Turkey a similar situation is also the case for Libya the gradual strengthening of Turkey's position in Libya and the insistence of Haftar's forces supported by Egypt on an endless unsuccessful campaign forced Cairo to change its policies in addition the Gulf's dubious approach to Egypt the potential of the dam crisis with Ethiopia to deepen and the insufficiency of the Egyptian army in the fight against terrorism in the Sinai region threaten the future of the Sisi administration and force the Egyptian administration to seek more urgent solutions therefore Egypt

s initiatives in the normalization process with Turkey can also be considered as Cairo's search for a way to tackle its problems regarding domestic politics security foreign policy and the economy in this context it is necessary to look at contemporary Egypt to understand the shift in Egypt's approach to Turkey therefore this study will focus on Egypt's domestic challenges foreign policy uncertainties economic and social problems and civil military relations with an approach that goes beyond the normalization discussions with Turkey

David P. Forsythe presents a compelling introduction to international human rights in a political context he stresses the difficulties of interjecting human rights into foreign policy and international politics while recognising the considerable progress that has been made over time focusing on international organizations states corporations and private advocacy groups Forsythe addresses key themes including war migration climate change and slavery

since the Egypt-Israel peace treaty was signed in 1979 Washington has given Cairo more than 50 billion in military grant aid but a strong military relationship has raised as many questions as it has answered about the ethics of working with an increasingly harsh authoritarian government about the partnership's success in achieving American interests in the region about the Egyptian military's willingness to reform and about whether conditioned aid can spur political change correspondingly the post-Arab Spring years have seen rough patches caused by U.S. limitations on military aid following the 2013 overthrow of Mohamed Morsi America's chafing at Egyptian human rights abuses and Cairo's eventual turn toward less restrictive partners such as Moscow and Paris for military supplies

Egypt has reappeared again as a leading actor in the Middle East after the fall of

mubarak the rise to power of the muslim brotherhood and its ouster the country has chosen its new strongman following the elections of al sisi egypt is back to pursuing a pro active policy not only internally but also in the neighbourhood the restoration of the strategic axis with saudi arabia and the struggle against radical islam are the two pillars of this new political phase however there are critical elements too from further deterioration of the political and civil liberties indexes to the emergence of jihadist groups in the sinai to the enduring economic and financial difficulties as a result of these changes europe and italy should calibrate a new policy aimed at safeguarding their interests especially from the points of view of security stability and the fight against terrorism also promoting more inclusive practices by the cairo government vis à vis the opposition including the muslim brotherhood and developing policies which can help egypt to respond to future challenges in terms of economic growth poverty alleviation demographic pressure and the creation of employment opportunities
