James Hickey proceeds from the premise that throughout history humans have demonstrated a proclivity for using violence against one another as a means to achieve an end means enabled in many respects by the technologies available at the time advancing technology has often been a prime enabler of ever increasing levels of violence and attendant human suffering at a few junctures in history however certain technologies have seemingly provided the armed forces that possess them the ability to fight wars with decreasing levels of violence and suffering today precision guided munitions pgms with their high degree of discrimination and accuracy again hold such promise this book seeks to answer the question do pgms mitigate suffering in war and have these weapons changed the way decisions regarding war and peace have been made answering this question helps us understand possible shifts in emphasis in modern warfare both in terms of methods employed and of the greater concern placed on limiting human suffering during conflict this book will help students of ethics just war and military history and senior military and civilian leaders to understand the possible outcomes and wider implications of their strategic choices to use such technology

the iran iraq war which ended in the summer of 1988 a month short of its eighth anniversary is undoubtedly the third world s longest and bloodiest conflict in a half century as such its lessons and implications extend beyond the geographical confines of the middle east bringing together israeli american and european specialists from the fields of middle east history international relations strategy and economics this book offers the first comprehensive post bellum analysis of the impact and

implications of the iran iraq war the book starts with an examination of the war s impact on the domestic and foreign affairs of the two belligerents continues with a discussion of the political ramifications of the war in both the regional and the global spheres and concludes by analysing the economic military and strategic implications

the possibility that iran will acquire a nuclear weapons capability poses a significant threat to the stability of the middle east and a potential challenge to the long term viability of the nuclear non proliferation regime since 2003 diplomatic efforts by the eu 3 united kingdom france and germany have succeeded in suspending the sensitive aspects of iran s nuclear programme but prospects for reaching a permanent agreement with the iranian government are uncertain if the eu 3 effort collapses a number of policy options will be given more serious consideration including sanctions containment regime change and military action this iiss strategic dossier on iran s strategic weapons programmes provides an objective technical assessment of iran s nuclear chemical and biological weapons capabilities as well as its ballistic missile programme the dossier evaluates what is known and what is not known about these capabilities and projects potential future developments in addition the dossier provides a history of democratic efforts over the last three decades to prevent iran from acquiring a nuclear weapons capability and examines different options for current diplomatic efforts each chapter has been written and reviewed by recognised international experts in their respective fields the iiss does not advocate any particular policy option for dealing with the iranian nuclear issue the objective of iran s

strategic weapons programmes a net assessment is to assess as accurately and dispassionately as possible iran s capabilities and evaluate the pros and cons of different policy options in the order to foster a well informed policy debate

since the iranian revolution more than thirty years ago the islamic revolutionary guard corps irgc also known as the revolutionary guard has conducted covert and overt military operations built an economic empire and trained financed and guided terrorists to pursue one goal the preservation and expansion of the islamic revolution inside iran the irgc influences the country s politics economy and foreign policy and controls its nuclear program outside iran the operations of the irgc and its proxies including hezbollah in lebanon and shiite militias in iraq have left a trail of death from the 1983 truck bombings in beirut that killed 241 u s peacekeepers and 58 french paratroopers to numerous attacks on u s and allied troops in iraq and afghanistan now no longer content to strike in iraq and afghanistan or at targets in the middle east and south asia the irgc and hezbollah operate throughout north and south america developing the capability to strike the continental united states and deliver a blow to america s economy far worse than today s financial crisis in iran s revolutionary guard steven o hern reveals new information about the irgc and hezbollah operations inside america based on interviews with former and active members of the fbi cia local law enforcement military intelligence and even one former revolutionary guard officer the author details how the irgc has grown into such a dangerous foe and explains how its members activities have put the american economy and

american lives at risk his research suggests that the irgc may be planning to explode high above a midwestern city a nuclear weapon that would emit an electromagnetic pulse strong enough to render anything with a computer chip useless including the hundreds of transformers that control the country s electrical grid one thing is certain according to o hern the revolutionary guard is a serious threat to the well being of all u s citizens

this study was inspired by post world war ii efforts of u s army historians and intelligence officers to gather and preserve insights and perspectives of the german general staff this is the second volume in a series of studies sponsored by the national intelligence council designed to cast light on issues involving saddam s iraq by interviewing former iraqi officials the first volume saddam s war an iraqi military perspective of the iran iraq war contained interviews with lieutenant general ra ad hamdani a former iraqi republican guard corps commander this second volume includes an additional interview with hamdani along with four additional senior officers who discuss issues including iraqi naval operations airpower military intelligence and capability development

drawing on feminist theory as well as theory surrounding the correlation between poverty and suicide this study explores the increased rate of suicide among women in western iran based on empirical research including interviews with women from the kurdish region of the country the author considers the marginalisation of kurdish populations in iran the suppression of their rights and violence against women in its various forms with attention to family violence such as direct physical or sexual assault psychological bullying or through practices such as forced marriage or honour killings the author also considers the political nature of such violence as certain violent practices are enshrined in the iranian constitution and legitimised in jurisprudential practice a study of gendered violence and its effects women and suicide in iran will be of interest to scholars working in the fields of sociology criminology and middle eastern studies with interests in violence gender and suicide
