fault lines is written by a non academic former businessman and consultant widely traveled in the middle east for those interested in understanding the often convoluted history of american middle east policy the book explains the fault lines that have often plagued u s efforts to protect its national interests in the region and how these ongoing faults have led to a precipitous decline in american influence the author makes some recommendations as to how this decline can be reversed

this book explores the rise of hizbullah as a direct consequence of both the

iranian revolution and the entanglement of lebanon in the arab israeli conflict protracted civil war and overwhelming foreign intervention by lebanon s neighbors enabled hizbullah to emerge as the country s dominant politico military force hizbullah disabled the lebanese political system and in its capacity as iran s premier foreign proxy allowed the islamic republic to take the lead in the regional tug of war with israel in its quest for achieving a distinguished regional status commensurate with its ambitions iran used hizbullah to abort the syrian uprising actively contribute to its burgeoning influence in iraq and participate in its propaganda war against saudi arabia on a range of issues the renewed u s sanctions on iran coincided with a worldwide campaign to dry up hizbullah s sources of funding and compromised its integrity as a critical provider of patronage to its lebanese shi ite base of support the emergence of russia as the real power player in syria made it extremely difficult for hizbullah to justify the high human cost it incurred to salvage the regime of bashar asad this book examines the rise of hizbullah and the marginalization and repression of shi ites that made them susceptible to exploitation by their sectarian leaders

drawing on original research and firsthand interviews conversations with terrorists offers critical portraits of six middle eastern leaders often labeled as terrorists syrian president bashar al assad hamas top leader khaled meshal israeli politician geula cohen iranian revolutionary guard founder mohsen sazargara hezbollah spiritual advisor grand ayatollah mohammed fadlallah and former afghan radio and television ministry head malamo nazamy veteran journalist reese erlich offers them a chance to explain key issues and to respond to charges leveled by the united states critiquing these responses and synthesizing a broad range of material erlich shows that yesterday s terrorist is today s national leader and that today s freedom fighter may become tomorrow s terrorist he concludes that the global war on terror has diverted public attention from the war s real goal expanding u s influence and interests in the middle east and offers policy remedies

this book deals with the causes nature and impact of the divisions within the jihadi movement and the splits between jihadis and other islamic groups fault lines in global jihad offers a systematic and comprehensive examination of the broad range of divisions that contribute to the weakening of the jihadi movement it separates these divisions into two broad categories namely fissures dividing jihadis themselves and divisions separating jihadis from other muslim and islamist groups the first part of the book covers intra jihadi divisions highlighting tensions and divisions over strategic tactical and organizational issues the second part of the book addresses several important case studies of jihadi altercations with other muslim and islamist groups of non jihadi persuasion such as the muslim brotherhood hamas and the shii community more than simply an enumeration of problems and cracks within al qa ida and its cohorts this book addresses critical policy issues of relevance to the broader struggle against the global jihadi movement the editors conclude that these divisions have and continue to weaken al qa ida

but neither in an automatic nor in an exclusive fashion for these divisions render the global jihadi movement simultaneously vulnerable and more resilient this book will be of much interest to students of jihadism terrorism and political violence islamism security studies and ir in general

absorb and challenge the world for generations to come dreams and shadows is the book to read to understand the sweeping political and cultural changes that have occurred in recent decades drawing on thirty five years of reporting in two dozen countries including israel palestine iran egypt and syria through wars revolutions and uprisings as well as the birth of new democracy movements and a new generation of activists award winning journalist and middle east expert robin wright has created a masterpiece of the reporter s art and a work of profound and enduring insight into one of the most confounding areas of the world

the following volume is devoted to the issues of european models of civil societies the aim of the authors is not to exhaust the whole topic but to bring forward some studies related to the civil society both in the historical but also present perspective civil society is an important factor in a well functioning state and crucial for developing a real active and conscious community which is able to control the state and its servants even more importantly when the state fails to react to negative developments or leaders misuse their power to enforce it in fulfilling its duties and in the most radical or dramatic cases to replace it or change the governors democratic order gives the society enough tools to do this and the internet social media and other new means of communication improve the level of self organisation and shorten the time for potential reactions

this book provides an account of how the european union has responded to the emergence of a new middle east in the wake of the arab spring and how far the eu has changed its foreign policies towards the middle east and africa it explores the impact european policies and whether it has succeeded in meeting the challenge of the arab spring

within recent years a new body of literature has emerged within international relations on transnationalism and foreign policy this literature has thus far focused on the strategic relationship between home states and their ethnic lobbies abroad often with regard to remittances to and politics in the home country this book breaks new ground in that it develops a theory about when how and for what reasons host states use diasporas and the ethnic lobbies they generate to advance foreign policy goals ask what you can do for your new country focuses on a previously unexamined phenomenon how host governments utilize diasporas to advance their foreign policy agendas in mutually beneficial ways as was demonstrated in the run up to the 2003 invasion of iraq when iraqi exiles testified that saddam hussein possessed weapons of mass destruction ethnic lobbies have been utilized strategically by the united states and other countries for the promotion of political objectives host states have even promoted the creation of such ethnic lobbies for this purpose as nadejda k marinova shows those who participate in such lobbies are of a particular subset of émigrés who are politically active express a sustained vision for homeland politics and who often have existing ties to political institutions within the host state these groups then act as a link between the public and officials in their home state and other generally less politically active members of the diaspora via a coordinated effort by the host state she develops a theoretical model for determining the conditions under which a host state will decide to promote and utilize an ethnic lobby and she tests it against eight cases including the bush administration's use of the american lebanese cultural union and the world council for the cedars revolution in developing policy towards lebanon and syria the iraqi national congress in endorsing the us invasion of iraq the cuban american committee's cooperation with the carter administration in attempting to normalize relations with cuba and the international diaspora engagement alliance idea launched by secretary of state hillary clinton in 2011 to promote economic

development in a number of countries

the world trade center bombing suicide attacks in israel the slaughter of tourists in egypt and innocents in algeria one of the world's great religions islam has become identified today with senseless bloodshed its followers branded as irrational fanatics with a penchant for violence ours is the era of the islamic threat but another story remains to be told beyond the headlines a transformation is under way in both the style and message of islamic politics at the end of the twentieth century a startling shift from militancy to democracy with vast implications for the west drawing on his years of reporting in more than a dozen countries of the muslim world anthony shadid charts the striking way in which the adolescence of yesterday's islamic militants is yielding to the maturity of today's activists through interview and travelogue he chronicles a new generation in lebanon egypt turkey and elsewhere that is finding a more realistic and potentially more successful future through democratic politics a crucial element of this change and of legacy of the prophet is his exploration of the failure of militant islam in countries like sudan and iran defeats that ironically may help make way for an alternative democratic future the transformation promises a better future for a region long ruled by soldiers and despots for the west it offers a compelling opportunity to find common ground with the muslim world but to do so the book argues that we must make the difficult choice of supporting the emergence of democratic islamic movements possibly even allowing to come to power governments that as it stands have no love for the west legacy of the prophet promises to redefine the debate over the future of political islam
