following the horrific attack on october 7 support for a devastating military retaliation and resolution has taken center stage nevertheless within israel numerous critical voices cast doubt on the sustainability of such approaches they champion

operation protective edge launched in early july 2014 was the third major israeli assault on the gaza strip in six years it was also the most deadly by the conclusion of hostilities some seven weeks later 2 200 of gaza s population had been killed and more than 10 000 injured in these pages journalist mohammed omer a resident of gaza who lived through the terror of those days with his wife and then three month old son provides a first hand account of life on the ground during israel s assault the images he records in this extraordinary chronicle are a literary equivalent of goya s disasters of war children s corpses stuffed into vegetable refrigerators pointlessly because the electricity is off a family rushing out of their home after a phone call from the israeli military informs them that the building will be obliterated by an f 16 missile in three minutes donkeys machine gunned by israeli soldiers under instructions to shoot anything that moves graveyards targeted with shells so that mourners can no longer tell where their relatives are buried fishing boats ablaze in the harbor throughout this carnage omer

maintains the cool detachment of the professional journalist determined to create a precise record of what is occurring in front of him but between his lines the outrage boils and we are left to wonder how a society such as israel widely praised in the west as democratic and civilized can visit such monstrosities on a trapped and helpless population

this report examines russia's military and diplomatic campaign in syria the largest and most significant russian out of area operation since the end of the cold war russia's experience in syria will shape its military thinking influence promotion and personnel decisions impact research and development for its arms industry and expand its influence in the middle east and beyond for the foreseeable future yet despite the importance of russia's involvement in syria especially as the united states competes with countries such as russia and china there has been little systematic analysis of russia's campaign in syria this research aims to help fill the gap and provides some new analysis and data it conducts a broad assessment of the russian campaign including political objectives diplomatic initiatives and civilian targeting which

places the military campaign in a wider context in addition it compiles a data set of russia's civilian targeting and analyzes satellite imagery of russian activity overall this report concludes that russia was relatively successful in achieving its main near term political and military objectives in syria including preventing the collapse of the assad regime an important regional partner and thwarting a possible u s attempt to overthrow assad still russia used a systematic punishment campaign that involved attacks against civilian and humanitarian infrastructure in an attempt to deny resources including food fuel and medical aid to the opposition while simultaneously eroding the will of civilians to support opposition groups

the new israel peacemaking and liberalization argues that the ongoing israeli palestinian peace process will be expedited by increased economic liberalization israel has undergone dramatic economic change in the 1990s shifting from a strongly protectionist state centered economy to a more international neoliberal one the book maintains that these fundamental changes have in turn transformed israeli society as a whole resulting in a significant moderation of attitudes

toward the palestinian people and palestinian nationalism the new israel contains contributions from both established israeli sociologists and promising young scholars the new israel peacemaking and liberalization is an insightful commentary on one of the most crucial international issues of our time

an illustrated combat history of the a 4 skyhawk which flew numerous attack missions in israeli service and initiated the israeli air force s transition from french to us aircraft the light and agile a 4 skyhawk was the first modern american jet to be offered to the israeli air force marking the point where the us took over from france as israel s chief military supplier deliveries began too late for the a 4 to fight in the six day war but it soon formed the backbone of the iaf s ground attack force from 1969 to 1970 it flew endless sorties against egyptian forces in the war of attrition then during the yom kippur war five squadrons of a 4s saw combat and 50 planes were lost as they battled against the arab armored onslaught using previously unpublished first hand accounts and rare photography from the iaf archives and pilots private collections shlomo aloni tells the definitive history of the iaf s a 4 squadrons including the story of ezra baban dotan who became an ace with an unique double kill of mig17s

book an engrossing memoir in which a photojournalist records both the precursors to today s conflicts in the middle east and her own deeply felt conviction that news coverage of the region actually increases the conflicts there you re going where carol spencer mitchell s father demanded as she set off in 1984 to cover the middle east as a photojournalist for newsweek and other publications in this intensely thoughtful memoir spencer mitchell probes the motivations that impelled her a single jewish woman to document the turmoil roiling the arab world in the 1980s and 1990s as well as how her experiences as a photojournalist compelled her to set aside her cameras and reexamine the way images are created scenes are framed and real life is packaged for specific news stories in danger pay spencer mitchell takes us on a harrowing journey to plo military training camps for palestinian children and to refugee camps in the gaza strip before during and after the first intifada through her eyes we experience the media frenzy surrounding the 1985 hijackings of twa flight 847 and the italian cruise liner achille lauro we meet middle eastern leaders in particular yasser arafat

and king hussein of jordan with whom spencer mitchell developed close working relationships and we witness spencer mitchell s growing conviction that the western media s portrayal of conflicts in the middle east actually helps to fuel those conflicts a conviction that eventually as she says shattered her career although the events that spencer mitchell records took place decades ago their repercussions reverberate in the middle eastern conflicts of today likewise her concern about the triumph of image over reality takes on greater urgency as our knowledge of the world becomes ever more filtered by virtual media

the war on terror did not start after 9 11 rather its origins must be traced back much further this book will blend the history of the american involvement in the middle east with the history of the fight against terrorism it will focus on the reagan administration while analyzing developments and policies carried out by local elites considering the general overview of american policy in the region with specific reference to events in lebanon and libya

the foreign policy making of the two states economic concerns were less important in both egyptian and syrian responses to the 2008 2009 gaza war
