in this book experts from the fields of law and philosophy explore the works of aristotle to illuminate the much debated and fascinating relationship between emotions and justice emotions matter in connection with democracy and equity they are relevant to the judicial enforcement of rights legal argumentation and decision making processes in legislative bodies and courts the decisive role that emotions feelings and passions play in these processes cannot be ignored not even by those who believe that emotions have no legitimate place in the public sphere a growing body of literature on these topics recognizes the seminal insights contributed by aristotle this book offers a comprehensive analysis of his thinking in this context as well as proposals for inspiring dialogues between his works and those written by a selection of modern and contemporary thinkers as such the book offers a valuable resource for students of law philosophy rhetoric politics ethics and history but also for readers interested in the ongoing debate about legal positivism and the relevance of emotions for legal and political life in today s world

hinge epistemology is rapidly becoming one of the most exciting areas of epistemology and wittgenstein studies in connecting these two fields it brings a revived energy to both opening them up to fresh developments the essays in this volume extend the subject in terms of both depth and breadth they present new voices and challenges within hinge epistemology they explore new applications and directions of hinge epistemology particularly as it relates to the philosophy of mind society ethics and the history of ideas

through the re interpretation of influential thinkers such as arendt weil beauvoir and habermas mary g dietz weds the concerns of democratic thought with that of feminist political theory demonstrating how important feminist theory has become to democratic thinking more generally bringing together fifteen years of commentary on critical debates turning operations begins with problems central to feminism and ends with a series of reflections on the the politics of politics inviting the reader to think more expansively about the expressly public nature of political life

moving past the conflation of state socialism with all socialist projects this book opens up avenues for addressing socialist projects rooted in decolonial and antiracist politics to that end this anthology brings together scholarship across regions that engages postsocialism as an analytic that connects the afters of the capitalist socialist dynamic to present day politics resisting the revolutionary teleology of what was before postsocialism can function to create space to work through ongoing legacies of socialisms in the present looking at the middle east scandinavia korea romania china and the us the chapters in this book assess

the Christian structure of politics the first full length monograph on Thomas Aquinas's *De Regno* in decades offers an authoritative interpretation of *De Regno* as a contribution to our understanding of Aquinas's politics particularly on the relationship between church and state William McCormick argues that Aquinas takes up a *via media* between Augustine and Aristotle in *De Regno* invoking human nature to ground politics as rational but also Christian principles to limit politics because of both sin and the supernatural end of man beyond politics where others have seen disjointed sections on the best regime tyranny and the reward of the king McCormick identifies a dialogical structure to the text one not unlike the disputed question format whereby Aquinas both tempers expectations for the best government and offers a spiritual diagnosis of tyranny culminating in a sharp critique of civil religion and political theology McCormick draws upon historical research on Aquinas context especially that of Anthony Black Cary Nederman and Francis Oakley from which he develops three themes the medieval preponderance of kingship and royal ideology the relationship between church and state and the intersection of Latin Christianity and Greco-Roman antiquity while age old concerns recent research in these areas has allowed us to move beyond simplistic platitudes for scholars of political theory and the history of political thought *De Regno* will prove fascinating for the interplay of Aristotelian and Augustinian elements undercutting the conventional wisdom that Aquinas was simply an Aristotelian *De Regno* also includes an extended treatment of civil religion one of Aquinas's most historically oriented discussions of politics

Shakespeare's political imagination argues that to better understand Shakespeare's plays it is essential to look at the historicism of setting how the places and societies depicted in the plays were understood in the period when they were written this book offers us new readings of neglected critical moments in key plays such as Malcolm's final speech in *Macbeth* and the Duke's inaction in *The Merchant of Venice* by investigating early modern views about each setting and demonstrating how the plays navigate between those contemporary perspectives divided into three parts this book explores Shakespeare's

historicism use of medieval britain and scotland in king john and macbeth ancient rome in julius caesar and coriolanus and renaissance europe through venice and vienna in the merchant of venice othello and measure for measure philip goldfarb styrt argues that settings are a powerful component in shakespeare s worlds that not only function as physical locations but are a mechanism through which he communicates the political and social orders of the plays reading the plays in light of these social and political contexts reveals shakespeare s dramatic method how he used competing cultural narratives about other cultures to situate the action of his plays these fresh insights encourage us to move away from overly localized or universalized readings of the plays and re discover hidden moments and meanings that have long been obscured

this third out of four volumes by richard ned lebow in this book series includes texts on psychology and international relations causation counterfactual analysis the political psychology contributions draw on richer ancient greek understandings of the psyche and offer novel insights into strategies of conflict management the role of emotions in international relations and the modern fixation on identity

in a news career spanning more than sixty years joseph c harsch was a firsthand witness to many of the great events of the twentieth century as a reporter and columnist for the christian science monitor and as a correspondent for all three of the major networks he became one of the most respected figures in the profession a mentor to a generation of journalists covering international affairs at the hinge of history is harsch s career autobiography what is most striking in this deftly rendered account is harsch s uncanny knack for being at the right place at the right time he was a reporter in washington when president hoover began to grasp the magnitude of the economic crisis that became known as the great depression while traveling to the soviet union in 1941 he arrived in hawaii just before the japanese attacked pearl harbor he was with general macarthur in australia on the occasion of the i shall return speech he reported from the liberated death camps in 1945 went behind the newly forged iron curtain in 1947 and 1949 and was stationed in london when certain postwar pressures tested the anglo american alliance throughout the book harsch reveals an overarching perspective that places major events in a larger historical context this is especially evident in the later chapters when he discussed the course of the cold war the role of ideology in the american view of china and the conduct of the vietnam war and the origins of the arab israeli conflict the book is filled with fascinating sketches of his encounters with such figures as president roosevelt general macarthur dean acheson walter lippmann and adlai stevenson on occasion harsch recalls events not recounted elsewhere and he frequently casts a new light on familiar ground in one eye opening chapter for example he describes the international effort in the 1930s to resettle european jews in angola an effort that collapsed when hitler invaded poland he provides a chilling firsthand recollection of the complacency and unpreparedness that preceded the pearl harbor bombing in still other chapters he relates his role in the capture of nazi leader albert speer and in the investigation following the mysterious murder in greece of his fellow correspondent george polk at once refreshingly direct and replete with self effacing irony at the hinge of history is a memorable testament to the personal qualities of its author to the art and science of journalism and to the tumultuous twentieth century
