this book considers the time span between 1981 and 2013 which is shaped by the rule of hosni mubarak until the ousting of the islamist president mohamed morsi on 3 july 2013 although the two movements are egyptian movements their ideologies reach far beyond egyptian borders this book will enrich one s understanding of the difference between the muslim brotherhood and the salafist call and the ideological transformations of each of them by focusing on the impact of the egyptian regime s power network ideological economic military and political on these transformations and studying the ideological attitudes of both movements to many issues such as political participation democracy women s issues minorities freedoms and systems of governance this first requires an exploration of the regime s power networks and the relationship between these sources of power which are both featured in this book

this book is about the emergence of a stream of ideas in the 1930s and 1940s within imamiyya shi'ite context focusing primarily on the thought of shari'at sangelaji 1891 1944 who harshly criticized a number of basic theological beliefs within imamiyya shi'a accusing them of polytheism and superstition on account of their ideas about shifa'a intercession and their pilgrimage to the graves of the shi'ite imams he also criticized the belief that the twelfth imam al mahdi has been living in covertness since the 9th century and that a number of historical figures will be resurrected upon his return to assist him in the final battle against the evil taking at once a theological and historical approach mohammad fazlhashemi investigates whether salafist mainstreaming thoughts despite its hostile attitude towards shi'a islam had any influence over shi'ite theology he explores whether and what components of the salafist tradition of ideas have been adopted by theologians within imamiyya shi'a or whether in fact whether these changes were the result of an internal theological tug of war within the imamiyya shi'a that was influenced by the interwar modernization efforts fazlhashemi examines the characteristic features of this flow of ideas its sources of inspiration the reception of its thought and the imprints it made on theological currents within imamiyya shi'a in

iran during its time and time thereafter

salafism is a fundamentalist sunni vision of islam that is growing in popularity in many countries in this book mohamed ali adraoui focuses on quietist salafism which he calls a study in contradictions strongly opposed to political action terrorism and the overthrow of established regimes quietist salafism insists on restructuring islamic norms with the fervor of a revivalist and fundamentalist ethic quietist salafis seek the purification of culture and religious renewal through a demilitantization of the islamic corpus adraoui explores the salafis individual trajectories their relationship with politics and their vision of the world and of modernity in order to understand how quietist salafis negotiate their social identities and religious obligations in the western context what does the increasing presence of islamic movements in the global space mean adraoui draws parallels between the french case and that of muslim countries and argues that the spread of quietist salafism is partially a result of the foreign policy of saudi arabia quietist salafism he argues is resonant of saudi arabia s efforts to promote a legitimist anti anarchist and counter revolutionary conception of islam after having long legitimized and reinforced the islamist forces and jihadist movements when it was in its geopolitical interests to do so salafism goes global sheds light on a

dynamic of globalization that is taking place in the margins

for nearly six years the government of yemen has conducted military operations north of the capital against groups of its citizens known as huthis in spite of using all means at its disposal the government has been unable to subdue the huthi movement this book presents an in depth look at the conflict in all its aspects the authors detail the various stages of the conflict and map out its possible future trajectories

for several years now islamism has been associated with jihadism and violent extremism both in academia and in contemporary political debates however this association can be misleading islamism has much deeper roots than jihadi terrorism and it stands as a powerful and complex ideology inspiring thoughts actions and groups all over the world emerging as a protest for justice ideology claiming freedom against western colonisation of the muslim world islamism has triggered both individuals and groups worldwide since the early 1900s almost as a sacred ideology based on the need to revive islam as the only saving grace for muslims around the world islamism started to be widely associated with jihadism after 9 11 before then islamism was not automatically related to terrorism but to resistance given

that terrorists are only a small and definite portion of islamists this volume aims to re focus research on islamism beyond jihadism by collecting relevant contributions on islamist but non violent organisations more precisely this volume innovatively contributes to current academic debates by exploring the origins of islamism and the differences between jihadism the evolution of islamism over time and places and the role played by the most influential non jihadist islamist organisations active today as powerful non state actors
