there is no region more central to the ancient greek romance novel than the thousand or so miles stretching from alexandria to ancient ethiopia that comprise the nile river valley yet for all its importance egypt ethiopia and the greek novel between representation and resistance is the first book length study of how this region is depicted in a literary genre whose fictional tales of love travel separation and reunion flourished during the roman imperial period employing approaches from literary studies classics and egyptology robert cioffi explores the nile river valley in the ancient greek romance novel through two fundamentally related concepts representation and resistance on the one hand these novels develop an image of egypt and ethiopia that is in close dialogue with the greco roman ethnographic tradition characterized by extraordinary marvels such as grand cities ancient religious rites and a dizzying array of animals some real some imaginary and some so incredible as to seem make believe on the other hand this depiction often figures egypt and ethiopia as sites of resistance revolt and rebellion against or political cultural and religious alternatives to an array of dominant imperial powers in the region from the persians to the romans this dual reading enriches our understanding of these texts relationship with the real and imagined frontiers of roman political military and intellectual power it also raises a broader set of questions some literary some cultural historical about the interrelation of humans their environment and the topographies of cultural identity in the roman empire

this volume deals with the development and the characteristics of the literature of ancient egypt over a period of more than two millennia from the monumental origins of autobiography at the end of the old kingdom ca 2150 bce down to the latest literary compositions in demotic during the graeco roman period 300 bce 200 ce this book the result of an international co operation among more than twenty scholars is divided into sections devoted to the definition of literary discourse in ancient egypt the history and genres of these texts their linguistic and stylistic features and the image of ancient egypt as displayed in later literary traditions of the mediterranean world greek coptic arabic with over thirty chapters this volume provides an interdisciplinary account of current research in one of the methodologically most advanced fields of egyptology

this book brings together a vast amount of information pertaining to the society economy and culture of a province important to understanding the entire eastern part of the later roman empire focusing on egypt from the accession of diocletian in 284 to the middle of the fifth century roger bagnall draws his evidence mainly from documentary and archaeological sources including the papyri that have been published over the last thirty years the authors examine the emergence of nationalism among the egyptian middle class during the 1930s and 1940s and its growing awareness of an arab and muslim identity previously egypt did not define itself in these terms but adopted a territorial and isolationist outlook it is the revolutionary transformation in egyptian self understanding which took place during this period that provides the focus of this study the authors demonstrate how the growth of an urban middle class combined with economic and political failures in the 1930s eroded the foundations of the earlier order alongside domestic events the momentum of arabism abroad and the impact of events in palestine necessitated egyptian regional involvement egypt s present position as a major player in arab muslim and third world affairs has its roots in the fundamental transition of egyptian national identity at this time

the sage scientist and sorcerer hermes trismegistus was the culture hero of hellenistic and roman egypt a human according to some who had lived about the time of moses but now indisputably a god he was credited with the authorship of a whole library of books on magic and the supernatural alchemy astrology theology and philosophy starting from the complex fusions and tensions that moulded graeco egyptian culture and in particular hermetism in the centuries after alexander dr fowden goes on to argue that the technical and philosophical hermetica apparently so different might be seen as aspects of a single way of hermes that led the initiate from knowledge of the world through knowledge of the self to knowledge of god the focus and conclusion of the book is an assault on the problem of the social milieu of hermetism by looking at the mythological facade of the texts themselves and deploying the numerous allusions to be found in other sources of the period

appealing to monster theory and the ancient near eastern motif of chaoskampf safwat marzouk argues that the paradoxical character of the category of the monster is what prompts the portrayal of egypt as a monster in the book of ezekiel while on the surface the monster seems to embody utter difference underlying its otherness there is a disturbing sameness though the monster may be defeated and its body dismembered it is never completely annihilated egypt is portrayed as a monster in the book of ezekiel because egypt represents the threat of religious assimilation although initially the monstrosity of egypt is constructed because of the shared elements of identity between egypt and israel the prophet flips this imagery of monster in order to embody egypt as a monstrous other in a combat myth yhwh defeats the monster and dismembers its body despite its near annihilation egypt in ezekiel s rhetoric is not entirely obliterated rather it is kept at bay hovering at the periphery questioning israel s identity

this book suggests a regional paradigm for understanding the development of the traditions about egypt and the exodus in the hebrew bible it offers fresh readings of the golden calf stories in 1 kgs 12 25 33 and exod 32 the balaam oracles in num 22 24 and the song of the sea in exod 15 1b 18 and from these paints a picture of the differing traditions about egypt that circulated in cisjordan israel transjordan israel and judah in the 8th century b c e and earlier in the north an exodus from egypt was celebrated in the bethel calf cult as a journey of israelites from egypt to cisjordan without a detour eastward to sinai this exodus was envisioned in military terms as suggested by the nature of the polemic in exod 32 and the attribution of the exodus to the warrior yahweh israel s own deity in the east a tradition of deliverance from egypt was celebrated rather than the idea of a journey and it was credited to el in the south egypt was recognized as a major enemy whom yahweh had defeated but the traditions there were not formulated in terms of an exodus while acknowledging the reshaping of these traditions in response to the exile images of egypt argues that they originated in the pre exilic period and relate to syro palestinian history as it is otherwise known
