this book analyzes the way israel has coped with nine wars of attrition from the 1950s to the recent second lebanon war 2006 questioning the belief that western democracy cannot sustain prolonged wars of attrition challenging israel with attrition has been compatible with the arab way of war which emphasizes staying power and with the belief that democracies cannot tolerate wars of attrition either economically or psychologically israel for its part developed a self image of incapacity to sustain prolonged wars committing itself to a traditional offensive approach to blitzkrieg whenever possible the book offers an account of nine wars of attrition that israel was involved in over almost 60 years from palestinian infiltration and fedayeen activities against israel in the early 1950s through to the second lebanon war in 2006 the author uses these cases to challenge the myth that israel cannot afford to become involved in a draining war of attrition focusing on central aspects typical of western democracies engaged in wars of attrition operational effectiveness the societal staying power the economic burden of the war moral dilemmas and conflict management problems the book challenges the myth that israel cannot afford to become involved in a draining war of attrition while at the same time highlighting the fact that in its wars of attrition israel has not always succeeded in avoiding undesired escalation this book will be of much interest to students of strategic studies israeli history middle eastern politics and security studies in general avi kober is a member of the department of political studies at bar ilan university israel and is a senior research associate with the besa center for strategic studies

this book offers a reconceptualisation of conventional deterrence theory and applies it to enduring rivalries in the middle east the work argues that many of the problems encountered in the development of deterrence theory lay in the fact that it was developed during the cold war when the immediate problem it had to address was how to prevent catastrophic nuclear wars the logic of nuclear deterrence compelled a preoccupation with the problem of stability over credibility however because the logic of conventional deterrence is different the solution of the tension between credibility and stability is achieved by deference to credibility due to the requirements of reputation and costly signaling this book aims to narrow the gap between theory and evidence it explores how a reconceptualization of the theory as a process that culminates in the internalization of deterrence within enduring rivalries is better suited to account for its final success a finding that has eluded deterrence theorists for long this interdisciplinary book will be of much interest to students of deterrence theory strategic studies international security middle eastern studies and ir in general

originally published in 1994 yair evron opens the book with an account of the development of israel s nuclear doctrine and the internal disagreements within the israeli political and strategic elite over how nuclear policy should be conducted there follows an analysis of the reactions from arab states and of how with the exception of iraq they have so far refrained from developing their own nuclear weapons

argues that states attachment to the strategy of deterrence can increase the chances of violence rather than avoid it

the development of israel s nuclear capacity controversy within the military elite implications for arab israeli relations and arms control in the region

nearly all empirical work in political science is fundamentally historical yet very little attention has been given to the problem of grounding claims to historical knowledge in writing the arab israeli conflict jonathan b isacoff constructs the nature of historical knowledge by deftly examining the multiple histories of the arab israeli conflict written by generations of israeli scholars he also undertakes briefer analysis of literature drawn from both historians and political scientists of the vietnam war demonstrating that historical revisionism is not unique to the study of the middle east focusing on different schools of historical interpretation writing the arab israeli conflict argues for a pragmatist approach in the tradition of john dewey most importantly this exceptional work suggests a number of practical methodological measures that can be taken to produce more sophisticated and nuanced political science scholarship

following israel s war of independence in 1948 and 1949 the anticipated peace did not materialize and the new nation soon found itself embroiled in protracted military conflict

with neighbouring arab states demobilization of its armed forces led to the formation of special elite unit under the command of ariel sharon to cope with cross border infiltration pillage and murder a policy of deterrence was governed by the tactic of retaliation which contained the seeds of escalation at the same time a military dynamic unfolded in which the logic of field unit response dictated both military and political policy and caught the imagination of a demoralized and war weary israeli society the myth of the israeli paratroopers at the beginning of the 1950s and their heroic deeds in the reprisal raids embodied the new zionist ethos for which the current prime minister of israel ariel sharon claims much of the credit the book thus provides historical insight into some of the most intractable developments of the current arab israeli conflict

deterrence as a strategic concept evolved during the cold war during that period deterrence strategy was aimed mainly at preventing aggression against the united states and its close allies by the hostile communist power centers the union of soviet socialist republics ussr and its allies communist china and north korea in particular the strategy was devised to prevent aggression involving nuclear attack by the ussr or china since the end of the cold war the risk of war among the major powers has subsided to the lowest point in modern history still the changing nature of the threats to american and allied security interests has stimulated a considerable broadening of the deterrence concept post cold war conflict deterrence examines the meaning of deterrence in this new environment and identifies key elements of a post cold war deterrence strategy and the critical issues in devising such a strategy it further examines the significance of these findings for the u s navy and marine corps quantitative and qualitative measures to support judgments about the potential success or failure of deterrence are identified such measures will bear on the suitability of the naval forces to meet the deterrence objectives the capabilities of u s naval forces that especially bear on the deterrence objectives also are examined finally the book examines the utility of models games and simulations as decision aids in improving the naval forces understanding of situations in which deterrence must be used and in improving the potential success of deterrence actions

this volumes discusses three principal issues the israeli army and the revolution of military affairs rma israel s present and future answers to the threays of weapons of mass destruction wmd and the impact of societal political and technological changes on israel s future war objectives

israel s military doctrine was aimed at defeating powerful arab militaries mostly those of egypt syria and jordan in the years 1948 1982 israel and arab states had a series of wars i

e high intensity wars israel since 1948 also dealt with guerrilla and terror attacks since 1982 and mostly in the last 15 years israel faced hybrid forces hamas and hezbollah those groups are a mix between a conventional military and a guerrilla group israel fought against hezbollah in lebanon in 2006 and against hamas in the gaza strip mostly in two wars in 2008 2009 and in 2014 this book begins with explaining israel s national security policy then it focuses on how the idf israel defense forces had to adjust its doctrine and build up to confront hybrid forces by examining israel s air and the ground corps and major issues such as offense and defense infrastructure and manpower the idf can inflict heavy casualties and damages to a hybrid foe yet destroying the latter is a tall order because hezbollah and hamas are too elusive they hide inside populated areas etc however compared with past wars against arab states there is much less danger to israel let alone to its survival since even a coalition between hezbollah hamas and other groups can t defeat the idf furthermore since fighting a hybrid force is less demanding than running a high intensity war against an arab state then israel does not rely that much on the united states in receiving weapon systems ammunition and spare parts

a set of propositions and an accompanying theoretical framework that explains the cause effect linkages between intrastate and interstate power realization that are characterized by militarization are developed this model establishes the foundation for an explanation of how such power is used to deal with the state s janus faced security dilemma to this end the model provides the tools needed for such an inquiry from a conceptual and typological standpoint the goal is to explain how the internal aspect of state power shapes the external one it was determined that israel and the primary arab confrontation states provide important test cases based on the intense interplay prevalent between militarization processes and state power

this book discusses the existing literature on military doctrines in general and offensive doctrines in particular as well as on causes of their stagnation and sources of innovation it provides the backdrop for an analytical historical review of israel s offensive military doctrine

the middle east conflict be it between the state of israel and arab states or between jews and palestinians is a staple of international news utilizing both theoretical approaches and empirical evidence hemda ben yehuda and shmuel sandler argue that despite the recent upswing in violence particularly over the palestinian issue conflict has gradually been giving way since the 1970s to a more orderly regime of conflict management by integrating ethnonational theoretical literature into their analysis the authors move beyond the current international relations debate over the relative merits of realist neo realist approaches versus neo liberal institutional approaches ethnic state disputes are the primary source for failing to terminate the arab israeli conflict

this book is the product of a multinational project sponsored by the middle east institute of columbia university in cooperation with the world peace foundation boston the atlantic institute for international affairs paris and the asia pacific association of japan tokyo it focuses on the principal unresolved issues of the energy crisis t

the book offers a novel conceptualization of israeli national intelligence culture describing the way in which israelis perceive and practice intelligence different nations have different national intelligence cultures relying on different ideas of intelligence perceiving and practicing intelligence in different ways written by a former senior intelligence officer this book is the first study dedicated to israeli intelligence culture and the way it reflects israeli strategic culture relying on more than 30 elite interviews with acting and former israeli practitioners the book highlights the israeli aversion to intelligence theory and scientific methods as well as to the structured management of the intelligence system at the national level it describes the intelligence system s emphasis on contrarian thinking and moral courage as the foundations of intelligence professionalism and the growing inclination of israeli intelligence toward action and influence intelligence is perceived and practiced by israelis as a tool for problem solving addressing unique israeli challenges while some traits of the israeli national intelligence culture have contributed to its high reputation and its success story others might have also contributed to its failure in anticipating the hamas terrorist attack on october 2023 or have remained aspirational norms rather than realized practice the october 2023 failure as that of the yom kippur war in 1973 will undoubtfully influence israeli national intelligence culture for many years to come this book will be of much interest to students of intelligence studies israeli politics strategic studies and international relations

now facing a genuinely unprecedented configuration of existential threats israel s leaders must decide whether to continue their deliberate nuclear ambiguity policy the bomb in the basement as they consider such urgent and overlapping survival issues as regional nuclear proliferation jihadist terror group intersections with enemy states rationality or irrationality of state and sub state adversaries assassination or targeted killing preemption and the probable effects of a cold war ii between russia and the united states israel must develop a strategic posture that will involve a suitably coherent and refined nuclear strategy this book critically examines israel s rapidly evolving nuclear strategy in light of these issues and explains how it underscores the overarching complexity of strategic interactions in the middle east

iraq s invasion of kuwait and the gulf war had a traumatic effect on the middle east and its implications were particularly serious for israel which felt obliged to reassess its strategic and military perspectives this is an examination of the lessons that the gulf war holds for israel
