an accessible and important look at what is truly behind our digital outrage on any given day at any given hour across the various platforms constituting what we call social media someone is angry facebook instagram twitter reddit 4chan in the rhetoric of outrage why social media is making us angry jeff rice addresses the critical question of why anger has become the dominant digital response on social media he examines the theoretical and rhetorical explanations for the intense rage that prevails across social media platforms and sheds new light on how our anger isn't merely a reaction against singular events but generated out of aggregated beliefs and ideas captivating accessible and exceedingly important the rhetoric of outrage encourages readers to have the difficult conversations about what is truly behind their anger

the gaza strip is among the most densely populated places in the world more than two thirds of its inhabitants are refugees and more than half are under eighteen years of age since 2004 israel has launched eight devastating operations against gaza a largely defenseless population thousands have perished and tens of thousands have been left homeless in the meantime

israel has subjected gaza to a merciless illegal blockade norman g finkelstein presents a meticulously researched inquest into gaza s martyrdom he shows that although israel justified its assaults in the name of self defense in fact these actions constituted flagrant violations of international law he also documents that the guardians of international law from amnesty international and human rights watch to the un human rights council ultimately failed gaza

the end of the british mandate in palestine heralded the birth of the new state of israel it also marked the end of one of the most tumultuous and momentous chapters in israeli history but the new state born into a hostile environment and struggling with the manifold demands of sovereignty would have to face many post independence challenges to its existence not least in the form of armed conflict and confrontation with its arab neighbours this volume examines the conflicts that from the 1948 until the 1967 six day war came to define the israeli struggle for existence

for more than fifty years dr cahill has been helping to heal the world as a leading specialist in tropical medicine and as a

in 1948 the state of israel was founded while the philosophy of zionism that advocated for a jewish homeland in what was then known as palestine dates back to 1897 the creation of israel in 1948 was justified by the terrible crime of the

holocaust committed by nazi germany during wwii many defenders of israel would like us to believe that the creation of israel was a peaceful process on a barely populated land however this is far from true rather the creation of israel was accompanied by what is known by the palestinians as the nakba catastrophe an operation in which 700 000 palestinians were violently expelled from their land and their homes since that time israel has continued to usurp more and more land from the palestinians who they falsely portray as a people without a history and without a culture israel has been particularly cruel to the people of gaza 70 percent of whom are refugees from the 1948 nakba gaza has been converted by israel into what some call a giant open air prison surrounded by barbed wire it is in this context that we are currently witnessing the tragic violence between israel and the people of gaza violence on a scale not seen in this land since the nakba of 1948 indeed many palestinians are calling this a second nakba with around 1.5 million palestinians already displaced and thousands killed all of this is being accomplished by israel with critical military and diplomatic support from the united states this second nakba is also being facilitated by the

mainstream press that both downplays and justifies what many believe to be genocidal violence against the palestinian people the case for palestine is written as a counternarrative with the hope that if the truth is told this violence and displacement can be stopped before it is too late before gaza is no more

the israel palestine conflict rooted in competing historical claims to the land of historic palestine has endured for over a century marked by wars uprisings and numerous attempts at peace at its core are disputes over territory the rights of palestinian refugees security concerns and the status of jerusalem this deeply entrenched and multifaceted conflict has profound humanitarian consequences and remains a significant issue in international diplomacy with lasting implications for the people in the region

a landmark history of one hundred years of war waged against the palestinians from the foremost us historian of the middle east told through pivotal events and family history in 1899 yusuf diya al khalidi mayor of jerusalem alarmed by the Zionist call to create a Jewish national home in palestine wrote a letter aimed at theodore herzl the country had an indigenous people

who would not easily accept their own displacement he warned of the perils ahead ending his note in the name of god let palestine be left alone thus rashid khalidi al khalidi s great great nephew begins this sweeping history the first general account of the conflict told from an explicitly palestinian perspective drawing on a wealth of untapped archival materials and the reports of generations of family members mayors judges scholars diplomats and journalists the hundred years war on palestine upends accepted interpretations of the conflict which tend at best to describe a tragic clash between two peoples with claims to the same territory instead khalidi traces a hundred years of colonial war on the palestinians waged first by the zionist movement and then israel but backed by britain and the united states the great powers of the age he highlights the key episodes in this colonial campaign from the 1917 balfour declaration to the destruction of palestine in 1948 from israel s 1982 invasion of lebanon to the endless and futile peace process original authoritative and important the hundred years war on palestine is not a chronicle of victimization nor does it whitewash the mistakes of palestinian leaders or deny the emergence of national movements on both sides in

reevaluating the forces arrayed against the palestinians it offers an illuminating new view of a conflict that continues to this day meticulously researched this is the definitive chronicle of the middle east crisis during the clinton years and in the post 9 11 era publishers weekly providing a fly on the wall vantage of the rising diplomatic panic that sent shudders through world capitals kill khalid unfolds as a masterpiece of investigative journalism toronto star in 1997 the israeli intelligence agency mossad poisoned hamas leader khalid mishal in broad daylight on the streets of amman jordan as the little known palestinian leader slipped into a coma the mossad agents escape was bungled and the episode quickly spiraled into a diplomatic crisis a series of high stakes negotiations followed which ultimately saved mishal and set the stage for his phenomenal political ascendancy in kill khalid acclaimed reporter paul mcgeough reconstructs the history of hamas through exclusive interviews with key players across the middle east and in washington including unprecedented access to mishal himself who remains to this day one of the most powerful and enigmatic figures in the region a sobering reminder of how
