this volume arose from a desire to advance academic discourse and reflection on the broader subject of prolonged occupation in light of the permanent character and resulting implications of the 55 year israeli administration of the palestinian territories the roots of the volume lie in a 2018 academic conference on the threshold from occupation to annexation the present volume moves that discussion forward updating and widening the range of topics addressed the result is a collection of thought provoking contributions by a wide range of scholars on the challenging and critical issue of prolonged occupation and international law ranging from colonialism apartheid the illegality of occupation and potential international criminal liability this volume reminds us forcefully that international law is alive and vibrant and can with imagination and in concert with social movements move us forward in the struggle for justice in palestine and elsewhere it is a signal achievement george bisharat the honorable raymond l sullivan professor of law university of california hastings college of the law into today s deepening environment of political inertia co editor nada kiswanson comes this searing collection of essays examining international legal frameworks and legal responsibilities closely and tangibly informed by the painful realities of palestinian life under prolonged israeli occupation the editors authors convenors and everyone else

this book is the first comprehensive examination of un efforts to protect palestinian human rights in the territories occupied by israel more than 50 years ago in the 1967 war working through the un human rights council in geneva three top international legal experts served for six consecutive years as unpaid special rapporteurs with a un mandate to report on israeli violations of international humanitarian law and human rights standards being outside the discipline that controls un bureaucrats they enjoyed a high measure of political independence in carrying out their factfinding and reporting missions strikingly despite their differences in background and political outlook they came to a unanimous consensus confirming the routine and various israeli violations of palestinian basic rights this book recounts their frustrations their trials their experiences and their conclusions this joint effort breaks new ground in studies by the un in several respects it demonstrates both the positive role played by the un in a politically controversial area and its blockage by geopolitical forces preventing it from securing the implementation of international law however the intense reactions of israel and pro israeli ngos to this un work most notably by un watch attest to the significance of a reliable accounting of israeli violations of palestinian human rights their consistent evasion of the substantive charges made by careful reporting and recourse by israeli supporters to discrediting defamatory attacks on the persons of these special rapporteurs with charges of anti semitism the core of which is subtly shifted from its proper usage as hatred of jews to justifiable criticism of the state of israel while some might argue that the un inability to

enforce international law as futile or worse view the un as merely a vehicle of power politics this book proves that international public opinion and international solidarity politics are influenced by persuasive expert findings as to international law such well evidenced conclusions encourage transnational activism as is evident from increased worldwide support for the bds campaign and other nonviolent external pressures this brilliant and authoritative account of the manner in which israel has administered the occupied palestinian territory during the past 20 years should be regarded as the definitive assessment of that situation

the state of israel and the palestinian nation are at a monumental juncture in their histories both have a chance to claim a new future but more than a quarter of a century of occupation has had significant social political economic cultural psychological and moral ramifications for israeli and palestinian men and women women and the israeli occupation analyses the impact of the occupier occupied dichotomy on the lives of palestinian israeli palestinian and israeli jewish women the book argues that the occupation has exposed internal conflicts challenging social structures within all three societies but has also reinforced existing loyalties as palestinian and jewish women have moved into public political action and worked together to end the occupation it suggests that although military occupation is not colonialism there are many similarities in the israeli palestinian case

the book examines how exercises of power and processes of security exercised in the occupied palestinian territories have formed palestinian women as subjects to understand how women experience occupation this book examines the various ways in which the occupation is directed at making palestinian women into subjects of power the work argues that the exercises of power are focused on controlling and disciplining women s bodies the objectives are to expose how the

exclusions of women's daily lived experiences of conflict in the occupied palestinian territories obscures how power operates to demonstrate how the elements of israeli security practices make women insecure and to highlight how resistance to the occupation can be found embedded within daily life in the occupied territories ultimately all of these themes can be related more broadly to how women might experience conflict and resist subjectification by exposing different ways that subjectifications result in insecurities and resistance to those insecurities while the book is specific to women in the occupied palestinian territories the exercises of power and enactments of resistance it exposes demonstrate how important it is to take seriously the feminist argument that the personal is international and the international is personal this book will be of much interest to students of gender politics critical security studies middle eastern politics sociology and ir in general

public opinion and the palestine question 1987 analyses public opinion on the palestinian israeli conflict it studies attitudes in various western democratic countries and israel and examines whether the governments of those countries reflect the general positions on the issue of their people it shows important changes taking place in the orientations of western public opinion on the palestinian question

overcoming evil describes the origins of genocide violent conflict and terrorism principles and practices of prevention and avenues to reconciliation it considers societal conditions culture and insitutions and the psychology of individuals and groups

focusing on key countries and topics this book looks at europe s involvement in the occupation of palestinian territories what has been europe s role in the occupation of palestinian territories since 1967 how have european actors responded countered and or supported the occupation the international context of this exceptionally long occupation shows a complex web of denunciations but also and especially complicit engagements and indifference the book looks at the perspective of international law before analysing the european union and key european countries france germany norway sweden united kingdom it also embraces different perspectives from the debate on campus to the role of european multinational companies to the conceptual approach of the world bank while much of the literature focuses on israel palestine and the united states this volume by leading experts adds a very important piece to the puzzle the european dimension the chapters in this book were originally published as a special issue of the journal global affairs

expression of frustration to resentment as a collective no inspired by kant and nietzsche s philosophy zalloua identifies two modes of deploying resentment private and public use by substituting resentment for reason this reinterpretation argues for a public use of resentment for the wretched to universalize their grievances to see their antagonism as cutting across societies and to turn personal trauma into a common cause a public use of resentment rails against the ideology of identity and victimhood and insists on resentment s generative negativity its own rationality prompting a shift from resentment as a personal expression of frustration to resentment as a collective no reframing resentment as a tool to oppose the evils of capitalism anti blackness and neocolonialism it both alarms the liberal gatekeepers of the status quo and promises to energize the anti racist left in its ongoing struggles for universal justice and emancipation

the war of 1948 in palestine is a conflict whose history has been written primarily from the national point of view this book asks what happens when narratives of war arise out of personal stories of those who were involved stories that are still unfolding efrat ben ze ev examines the memories of those who participated and were affected by the events of 1948 and how these events have been mythologized over time this is a three way conversation between palestinian villagers jewish israeli veterans and british policemen who were stationed in palestine on the eve of the war each has his or her story to tell these small scale truths shed new light on the palestinian israeli conflict as it was then and as it has become
