the holy places of jerusalem s old city are among the most contested sites in the world and the ground zero of the israeli palestinian conflict tensions regarding control are rooted in misperceptions over the status of the sites the role of external bodies such as religious organizations and civil society and misunderstanding regarding the political roles of the many actors associated with the sites in this volume marshall j breger and leonard m hammer clarify a complex and fraught situation by providing insight into the laws and rules pertaining to jerusalem s holy sites providing a compendium of important legal sources and broad form policy analysis they show how laws pertaining to holy places have been implemented and engaged the book weaves aspects of history politics and religion that have played a role in creation and identification of the law it also offers solutions for solving some of the central challenges related to the creation control and use of holy places in ierusalem

the situation of christians in the middle east has become an important topic of international discussion as well as an important theme covered in the media as several cbs sixty minutes programs have highlighted the plight of christians in palestine syria jordan lebanon and egypt in the eye of the storm tells the story of the plight of twenty first century middle eastern christians in five countries palestine israel jordan lebanon and egypt in the context of the so called arab spring and within a destabilized region that is a geopolitical triangle shaped by israeli hegemony and arab iranian tensions the book places the situation of the christians within the wider sociopolitical context of the middle east in the twenty first century a unique feature of this book is that it is written mainly by native christians who have spent their entire lives in the region and continue to live there in the eye of the storm therefore provides an insider perspective rather than a hegemonic and colonial outsider perspective this book hopes to offer a sociopolitical framework for the christians of the middle east thus allowing them to tell their own story as they see it and not one that has been projected onto them by outside forces

the biblical city of jerusalem played a

significant role in the origination of christianity according to the scriptures jesus visited the jewish temple there as a youth many years later it was in jerusalem where he ate the last supper with his disciples before being arrested and tried by roman procurator pontius pilate who sentenced him to crucifixion jesus died and was buried just outside the city walls rose there from the dead and forty days later ascended to heaven from nearby mount of olives jerusalem is also where some of the disciples received inspiration from the holy spirit in a gathering that is considered to be the founding of the christian church and where it is said that jesus christ will return in the second coming churches and monasteries in jerusalem is devoted to twenty ancient houses of worship that were built over the ages to commemorate the decisive milestones of jesus s time in jerusalem and that underscore christianity s ongoing relationship with the sacred city this volume is based in part on chapters from the authors book churches and
