a young man struggles to guard and sustain his love for god his fiance and his family when faced with the brutality of sharia law escape the hezbollah is a glorious story of how love can endure through the most cruel hostile and depraved environment imaginable friends begin to go missing and rumors surface some of joseph s friends are never heard

from again joseph becomes entrapped in the mystery of his friends disappearances when one day after work he and his friend fareed are forcibly thrown into the backseat of a black nissan and abducted the two young men are forced to join a ruthless militia this military formed by the irg to protect lebanon from invasion by the israelis contradicts its credence joseph witnesses the most horrific sins that man can inflict upon another human being and he wants out he thinks his maker has abandoned him and he questions god s very existence ultimately doubting his own faith after grueling years of enduring this military life escape and concealment a way opens up for him to safely flee the country and eventually return to the u s

hezbollah lebanon s party of god is a multifaceted organisation it is a powerful political party in lebanon a shia religious and social movement lebanon s largest militia a close ally of iran and a terrorist organisation drawing on a wide range of sources including recently declassified government documents court records and personal interviews with intelligence officials matthew levitt examines hezbollah s beginnings its first violent forays in lebanon and then its terrorist activities and criminal enterprises abroad in europe the middle east south america southeast asia africa and finally in north america he also discusses hezbollah s unit dedicated to supporting palestinian militant groups and the group s involvement in training and supporting

insurgents who fought us troops in post saddam iraq the book concludes with a look at hezbollah s integral and ongoing role in iran s shadow war with israel and the west including plots targeting civilians around the world levitt shows convincingly that hezbollah s willingness to deploy violence at home and abroad its global reach and its proxy patron relationship with the iranian regime are all matters worthy of the utmost concern

the conflict between israel and hezbollah in july 2006 had a devastating effect on civilians in lebanon israeli attacks killed at least at 1 109 lebanese the vast majority of them civilians the strikes also injured 4 399 people and displaced an estimated one million this report presents the most extensive investigation to date that anyone has conducted into the circumstances surrounding these civilian deaths human rights watch visited more than 50 lebanese villages interviewed over 355 witnesses and investigated 94 separate incidents of israeli attacks these attacks claimed the lives of 510 civilians as well as 51 hezbollah combatants almost half of the lebanese death in the conflict

the road to fatima gate is a first person narrative account of revolution terrorism and war during history s violent return to lebanon after fifteen years

of quiet michael j totten s version of events in one of the most volatile countries in the world s most volatile region is one part war correspondence one part memoir and one part road movie he sets up camp in a tent city built in downtown beirut by anti syrian dissidents is bullied and menaced by hezbollah s supposedly friendly media relations department crouches under fire on the lebanese israeli border during the six week war in 2006 witnesses an israeli ground invasion from behind a line of merkava tanks sneaks into hezbollah s postwar rubblescape without authorization and is attacked in beirut by militiamen who enforce obedience to the resistance at the point of a gun from the cedar revolution that ousted the occupying syrian military regime in 2005 to the devastating war between israel and hezbollah in 2006 to hezbollah s slow motion but violent assault on lebanon s elected government and capital totten s account is both personal and comprehensive he simplifies the bewildering complexity of the middle east gains access to major regional players as well as to the man on the street and personally witnesses most of the events he describes the road to fatima gate should be indispensable reading for anyone interested in the middle east iran s expansionist foreign policy the arab israeli conflict asymmetric warfare and terrorism in the aftermath of september 11

addressing one of the most pressing issues of the lebanese civil war 1975 1990 that is still unresolved

almost 30 years later this book adopts a political sociological and anthropological approach to look at periods of transition from conflict to peace in lebanon inducing a set of questions about the social and political system the post conflict state has been pushing for a politics of amnesty and amnesia the case study delves into the notion of transition from conflict to peace in lebanon by looking in the case of the estimated 17 000 people who disappeared during the civil war using the concept of liminality to understand the evolution of the issue over the years the book follows the trajectory of the relatives of the missing who have formed a *communitas* a group sharing strong feelings of comradeship and brother sisterhood by virtue of finding themselves in the same situation offering a novel way of looking at transitions the book is a significant contribution to peace studies and it will be an interest of students and academics working in human rights political science and the middle east disciplines

hostage by a terrorist group and you have no idea whether your loved one is dead or alive or how to even make contact with the insurgents holding him it's a nightmare scenario that has sadly taken place dozens of times in the past twenty years in the middle east here in the u s the government does not always get involved instead it will engage the services of a neutral country to negotiate with the terrorists unfortunately many times the terrorists insist on never ending demands in order to torment the family of the hostage unlike israel we've never had a central address for these types of scenarios but maybe after reading this book it's an idea we could and should consider ory slonim the international door knocker was an invention of necessity by the israeli government there were many good and brave human beings involved in this matter here for the first time is the story of the one man in israel who for more than two decades was known as the door knocker he had been a private israeli lawyer when he was asked to undertake on behalf of the israeli government secret negotiations to find out the whereabouts of israeli soldiers who were taken hostage by terrorist groups his ultimate mission was to bring them home dead or alive in his capacity as negotiator his story will take you into the worlds of the furtive mossad the twisted minds of terrorists the forever traumatized lives of the parents whose children never came home from battle and into ory's own resilient compassionate and amazingly resolute negotiations
