exit like entry has helped define citizenship over the last two centuries yet little attention has been given to the politics of emigration how have countries impeded or facilitated people leaving how have they perceived and regulated those who leave what relations do they seek to maintain with their citizens abroad and why citizenship and those who leave reverses the immigration perspective to examine how nations define themselves not just through entry but through exit as well

this book examines the nature of citizenship in israel as pertaining to particular group demands and to the dynamics of political life in the public arena focusing on a wide range of social groups from the military through ethnic minorities religious groupings and the gay and

lesbian community contributors explore different aspects of citizenship through the needs demands and struggles of minority groups to provide a comprehensive picture of the dynamics of israeli citizenship and the dilemmas that emerge at the collective group and individual levels

in the israeli radical left fiona wright traces the dramatic as well as the mundane paths taken by radical jewish israeli leftwing activists whose critique of the israeli state has left them uneasily navigating an increasingly polarized public atmosphere this activism is manifested in direct action solidarity movements the critical stances of some israeli human rights and humanitarian ngos and less well known initiatives that promote social justice within jewish israel as a means of undermining the overwhelming support for militarism and nationalism that characterizes israeli domestic politics in chronicling these attempts at solidarity with those most injured by israeli policy wright reveals dissent to be a fraught negotiation of activists own citizenship in which they feel simultaneously repulsed and responsible based on eighteen months of fieldwork the israeli radical left provides a nuanced account of various kinds of jewish israeli antioccupation and antiracist activism as both spaces of subversion and articulations of complicity wright does not level complicity as an accusation but rather recasts the concept as an analysis of the impurity

of ethical and political relations and the often uncomfortable ways in which this makes itself felt during moments of attempted solidarity she imparts how activists persistently underline their own feelings of complicity and the impossibility of reconciling their principles with the realities of their everyday lives despite the fact that the activism in which they engage specifically aims to challenge jewish israeli citizens participation in state violence the first full ethnographic account of the israeli radical left wright s book explores the ethics and politics of jewish israeli activists who challenge the violence perpetrated by their state and in their name

the 2008 financial crisis opened the door for a bold progressive social movement but despite widespread revulsion at economic inequity and political opportunism after the crash very little has changed has the left failed what agenda should progressives pursue and what alternatives do they dare to imagine left turn is aimed at the many australians disillusioned with the political process it includes passionate and challenging contributions by a diverse range of writers thinkers and politicians from larissa berendht and christos tsiolkas to guy rundle and lee rhiannon these essays offer perspectives largely excluded from the mainstream they offer possibilities for resistance and for a renewed struggle for change

it was 1942 in amsterdam when isaac and anna staal

began noticing their jewish neighbors disappearing some were taken away by dutch police some vanished in the middle of the night as the nazis embarked on a manhunt for dutch jews isaac and anna made the agonizing decision to entrust their children to strangers and seek another hiding place for themselves on may 21 1943 the time had come dazed with sleep philip and his brother were given a last hug by their parents and put in the arms of an aunt who went out the door softly got on her bicycle with the two tiny tots and disappeared in the silent night sixty years later philip was commissioned to work for the restoration of rights in the netherlands when looking through archives and records he discovered the well kept secret of the war orphans guardians organization in his compelling story that weaves between past and present staal not only shares a heartbreaking narrative of his childhood as a toddler separated from his parents during world war ii and forced to live in orphanages after years of hiding but also how he eventually made it his personal mission to reimburse assets and restore rights lost by dutch victims of persecution and search for the legacies of war orphans parents including his own settling the account shares poignant personal narrative historical facts and one man s determined pursuit to bring justice to dutch jewish war orphans and their murdered parents and resolve the mystery of his past

for many years before and after the establishment of the state of israel the belief that israel is a western state remained unchallenged this belief was founded on the predominantly western composition of the pre statehood jewish community known as the yishuv the relatively homogenous membership of israeli jewish society as it then existed was soon altered with the arrival of hundreds of thousands of jewish immigrants

chaim gans s a political theory for the jewish people examines the two dominant interpretations of zionism contrasts them with post zionist alternatives and develops a third model along with exploring the historiographic philosophical and moral foundations of each of these approaches gans considers their implications for the relationship between jews and arabs in israel palestine as well as the relationship between israeli and diasporic jews proprietary zionism gans argues is the version that is most popular among the israeli jewish public it conceives of the land of israel historic palestine as the property of the jewish people it also conceives of the entire jewish people as belonging

to israel hierarchical zionism is common among israel s educated elites and interprets the jewish right to self determination as a right to hegemony within the israeli state it remains silent on the issue of the relationship between israeli and non israeli jews post zionist approaches conversely thoroughly reject these zionist narratives regarding jewish history and critique the rationale for the continued existence of the state of israel as a jewish state gans disagrees with all of these approaches and in their stead advocates egalitarian zionism which is based on an egalitarian interpretation of the right to national self determination and derives from the justifications for zionism in its early years as such it interprets the historical link between the jews and the land of israel in terms of identity rather than property it also views the link between israel and world jewry as a matter of choice for individual jews not as a matter of necessity inextricably bound to their essence as jews he sees it as preferable to both the dominant strands of zionism but also to the major contemporary anti zionist approaches first that of the israeli post zionists offering a civic or post colonial vision of a non jewish state and secondly that of the mostly american post zionists who have a neo diasporic vision for both israeli and non israeli jews in which the connection to the land of israel is loose at best ultimately the book argues that egalitarian zionism is superior to its rivals both in the authenticity of its relationship to jewish

history and in its implications for denizens of israel and jews around the world

in 1975 at the age of twenty three farideh goldin left iran

in search of her imagined america she sought an escape from the suffocation she felt under the cultural rules of her country and the future her family had envisioned for her while she settled uneasily into american life the political unrest in iran intensified and in february of 1979 farideh s family was forced to flee iran on the last el al flights to tel aviv they arrived in israel as refugees having left everything behind including the only home farideh s father had ever known baba as farideh called her father was a well respected son of the chief rabbi and dayan of the jews of shiraz during his last visit to the united states

in 2006 he handed farideh his memoir that chronicled the years of his life after exile the confiscation of his passport while he attempted to return to iran for his belongings the resulting years of loneliness as he struggled against a hostile bureaucracy to return to his wife and family in israel and the eventual loss of the poultry farm that had supported his family farideh translated her father s memoir along with other documents she found in a briefcase after his death leaving iran knits together her father s story of dislocation and loss with her own experience as an iranian jew in a newly adopted home as an intimate

portrait of displacement and the construction of identity as a story of family loyalty and cultural memory leaving iran is an important addition to a growing body of iranian american narratives

the last exodus is recognized as the finest study yet written of the jewish dissident movement in the soviet union the author explains how and why a soviet jewish underground came into existence who has led it what techniques it has used and how it has grown and spread in a country where only a few years ago such defiance would have been viewed as impossible
