in the long shadow of dictatorship young spanish rebels fight for a truly free society the franco dictatorship in spain was famously

beset by armed revolutionary groups inheritors of the legacy of spanish anarchism that franco had crushed less well known are the grupos aut nomos autonomous groups active during spain s transition to democracy a transition set in motion and overseen by the powerful elites of the franco regime and intended to maintain existing social and economic relations as the country reorganized under a veneer of a parliamentary monarchy resistance spread in the form of small autonomous bands of armed rebels who sought a more free and egalitarian future for spain agitated is the tale of those groups it brings alive the young people who comprised them detailing their struggle against the faux democracy of authoritarian capitalism and the vibrant lives they lived the counterculture they formed their relations with workers life underground of course the repression they suffered
