hafez al assad became president of syria in 1971 following a long line of military leaders at first his goals included achieving pan arabism more evenly distributing the nation s oil wealth and extending the party s power by reaching into every aspect of syrians lives however through a series of poorly planned economic programs censorship and old fashioned greed and corruption assad and his government brought intimidation and the loss of freedom to the nation s people after his death in 2000 the nation s ruling party elected his son bashar as president bashar has continued many of his father s policies enforcing his own will on the nation and stripping people of their freedoms and economic prosperity in the assads syria learn more about the internal workings of one of the world s

most devastating dictatorships

the syrian refugee crisis which began in 2011 is one of the most pressing disasters in the world today with its effects reverberating around the globe by the end of 2015 more than 7 6 million of the country s people had been internally displaced and 4 3 million were registered refugees the number of internally displaced persons and refugees amounts to about half of syria s precrisis

population thousands have died while trying to reach safety due to the large humanitarian response there is now a wealth of available information on refugees income and expenses food and nutrition health education employment vulnerability housing and other measures of well being these data have been little explored as humanitarian organizations face daily challenges that make the full use of existing data very difficult the welfare of syrian refugees evidence from jordan and lebanon aims to assess the poverty and vulnerability of these refugees and evaluate existing and alternative policies designed to help them the authors find that current policies including cash transfers and food vouchers are effective in reducing poverty but fail to lead to nor are they designed to yield economic inclusion and self reliance those goals would require a different humanitarian and development paradigm one that focuses on growth policies for areas affected by refugees where the target population has a mix of refugees and hosting populations this volume is the result of the first comprehensive collaboration between the world bank group and the united nations high commissioner for refugees unher and aims to better understand and ultimately improve the well being of syrian refugees living in jordan and lebanon

in this book the distinguished scholar hanna batatu presents a comprehensive analysis of the recent social economic and political evolution of syria s peasantry the segment of society from which the current holders of political power stem batatu focuses mainly on the twentieth century and in particular on the bath movement the structures of power after the military coup détat of 1963 and the era of îvfiz al asad syria s first ruler of peasant extraction without seeking to prove any single theory about syrian life he offers a uniquely rich and detailed account of how power was transferred from one demographic group to another and how that power is maintained today batatu begins by examining social differences among syria s peasants and the evolution of their mode of life and economic circumstances he then scrutinizes the peasants forms of consciousness organization and behavior in ottoman and mandate times and prior to the bathists rise to power he explores the rural aspects of bathism and shows that it was not a single force but a plurality of interrelated groups prominent among them the descendants of the lesser rural notables with different social goals

this book examines syrian displacement since the start of the 2011 conflict it considers how neighboring refugee hosting states namely jordan turkey and lebanon have responded to syrian refugees as well as how the international humanitarian community has assisted and protected refugees and internally displaced persons idps miller examines syrian displacement as it relates to eu and us policies and relates syrian displacement to broader themes and debates on the international refugee regime and humanitarian intervention the book argues that displacement is not a mere symptom or

byproduct of the conflict in syria but a key variable that must be addressed with any peace plan or strategy for ending the conflict and rebuilding syria responses to displacement should therefore not just be thought of in a humanitarian context but also as a political security and economic issue drawing on media reports research briefs scholarly books and articles ngo reports and un research to contextualize and critically analyze the blur of headlines and rhetoric on syria the book seeks to shed light on the political and humanitarian responses to displacement it seeks to inform policymakers practitioners and scholars about the current syrian displacement situation helping to make sense of the complex web of literature on syrian refugees and idps

preventing the spread of weapons of mass destruction has been an important policy priority in the past decades this dissertation questions the prevailing view that chemical and biological weapons cbws are a poor man s atomic bomb that are particularly attractive to developing countries that cannot acquire nuclear weapons the study shows that vague unverifiable and inflated threat assessments from us government sources have played an important role in sustaining this myth a unique dataset of cbw development programs in the period 1946 2010 demonstrates that significantly fewer countries have had cbw programs than often thought and that especially third world countries have been incorrectly accused of pursuing or possessing cbws
