from torture to fake news this book lays out how the bahrain regime has used political repression and violence to fight social movements

amid the extensive coverage of the arab uprisings the gulf state of bahrain has been almost forgotten fusing historical and contemporary analysis bahrain s uprising seeks to fill this gap examining the ongoing protests and state repression that continues today drawing on powerful testimonies interviews and conversations from those involved this broad collection of writings by scholars and activists provides a rarely heard voice of the lived experience of bahrainis describing the way in which a sophisticated society defined by a historical struggle continues to hamper the efforts of the ruling elite to rebrand itself as a liberal monarchy

civil resistance especially in the form of massive peaceful demonstrations was at the heart of the arab spring the chain of events in the middle east and north africa that erupted in december 2010 it won some notable victories popular movements helped to bring about the fall of authoritarian governments in tunisia egypt libya and yemen yet these apparent triumphs of non violent action were followed by disasters wars in syria anarchy in libya and yemen reversion to authoritarian rule in egypt and counter revolution backed by external intervention in bahrain looming over these events was the enduring divide between the sunni and shi a branches of islam why did so much go wrong was the problem the methods leadership and aims of the popular movements or the conditions of their societies in this book experts on these countries

and on the techniques of civil resistance set the events in their historical social and political contexts they describe how governments and outside powers including the us and eu responded how arab monarchies in jordan and morocco undertook to introduce reforms to avert revolution and why the arab spring failed to spark a palestinian one they indicate how and why tunisia remained precariously the country that experienced the most political change for the lowest cost in bloodshed this book provides a vivid illustrated account and rigorous scholarly analysis of the course and fate the strengths and the weaknesses of the arab spring the authors draw clear and challenging conclusions from these tumultuous events above all they show how civil resistance aiming at regime change is not enough building the institutions and the trust necessary for reforms to be implemented and democracy to develop is a more difficult but equally crucial task

saudi arabia and bahrain remain key partners for the uk but relations are complicated by the differences between our societies and the pressing need for reform in the gulf historic warm relations between the uk government and the leaders of saudi arabia and bahrain are not mirrored in public opinion in saudi arabia and the uk and the uk s reputation in bahrain has also suffered since 2011 the government must make its public profile and reputation a more central part of its work in the gulf consider how it can best support much needed economic and political reforms and how it can explain its policies and point to specific achievements when speaking to the public at home and in the gulf in saudi arabia the government must convert its promising steps so far in providing assistance on legal and judicial reform into solid and reportable programmes in bahrain it must work to secure access for ngos and the un special rapporteur on torture and press more strongly for swifter implementation of reforms saudi arabia s role as a key buyer for the uk defence industry is controversial but the report finds little to suggest that ending defence sales from the uk would have any positive effect the aggressive way in which the bahraini security forces handled events in 2011 has deeply damaged bahrain s reputation the recommendations of the bahrain independent commission of inquiry bici were sensible and the bahraini government s failure fully to implement them is inexplicable

bahrain has roots deep in the past going back some 5 000 years it was a vital link between civilisations such as the phoenicians the levant and mesopotamia the modern era of bahrain began in 1783 following the island s conquest by ahmed al fateh it has been ruled by the al khalifa family since 1961 bahrain was declared independent from the united kingdom in august 1971 and issued its first constitution in 1973

invasion of kuwait investigated and condemned israel s mistreatment of palestinians he directed efforts to curtail the chinese government s persecution of uyghur muslims to bring myanmar s officials to justice after the ethnic cleansing of rohingya muslims to halt russian war crimes in ukraine even to reign in the u s government roth s many innovations and strategies included the deployment of a concept as old as mankind the powerful tool of shaming and here he illustrates its surprising effectiveness against evildoers this is a story of wins losses and ongoing battles in the ceaseless fight to uphold our most basic values
