cmh pub 10 11 united states army in world war 2 concentrates on ordnance operations in the mediterranean european and southwest pacific theaters also covers the central pacific theater as abackground for the okinawa campaign

this is a unique book using for the first time the full unpublished letters of pilot officer geoffrey myers it offers a fresh and distinctive insight into world war 2 while geoffrey myers was a caught up in the major turning points of the early years of that war the battle for france dunkirk and the battle of britain his french wife and two half jewish children were trapped in nazi occupied france desperate to escape the enemy and be reunited with her husband in england these secret letters were never posted and never read by geoffrey s family until later in the war they were designed to be read if he was

killed they begin three months now and i have kept silent i have been hoping to write letters that would reach you i have been wanting to do something that would help you to escape from occupied france and to get us all out of this living grave contemporary personal accounts of the battle of britain of such frankness are extremely rare individual narratives on this scale encompassing two of the great turning points of the war the battle of britain and dunkirk and much else besides just do not exist so the letters from geoffrey myers to his family are unique offering an original insight from a witness to so much history more than that the letters tell a powerful love story between two people caught up in war and at real risk of never seeing each other again as a daily telegraph journalist before the war geoffrey myers writes with eloquence and insight and because his notebooks were not designed to be published the letters are an unvarnished sometimes brutal portrayal of war as his battle of britain squadron suffers terrible losses as an intelligence officer geoffrey was well placed to understand the chaos all around him but his letters are shot through with humanity and sometimes humour while geoffrey wrote his account of the war for his children to read if he survived his family were in mortal danger as a jew he understood only too well what would happen if the nazis discovered his children hiding in occupied france for months he had no idea if his family were dead or alive free or imprisoned his letters reflect his deep love for his wife margot and children and his acute anxiety for their safety as they try to escape the tightening net of the nazis and head south through france and spain unique interviews with his wife offer insight into her remarkable story during those precarious months this moving story of a couple whose love is caught in the crossfire of war is a powerful and rare portrait of not only the turbulent events of those times but also how a family survives with so much death and danger swirling around them both

first published in 1995 the military balance is updated each year to provide a timely quantitative assessment of the military forces and defence expenditures of over 160

many are the remarkable stories of the men who through good fortune or sheer determination survived the loss of their aircraft in the second world war depending on the circumstances these aircrew often became members of the caterpillar goldfish or late arrivals clubs as well as the famous guinea pig club where membership was reserved to aircrew who were operated on by the legendary plastic surgeon sir archibald meindoe such individuals include captain r I morrison who was injured when his curtiss p 40 tomahawk was shot down over north africa he was one of six aircraft brought down by the luftwaffe ace hans joachim marseille in just eleven minutes having survived his crash landing morrison was eventually picked up by a south african armoured car unit operating behind enemy lines he finally reached tobruk gaining membership of the late arrivals club in the process from where he was evacuated just two days before the port city was taken by rommel s afrika korps then there is the story of flight lieutenant charles parish who was the sole survivor of the crew of a wellington bomber which was shot down in the english channel in pitch darkness parish swam seven miles to reach the english coast supported only by his mae west life preserver for this remarkable achievement parish was admitted into the hallowed ranks of the goldfish club other airmen who became a member of the goldfish club include rear gunner sergeant frederick price who had been adrift at sea for six days before being rescued and navigator brian beecroft who survived not one but two ditchings at sea after parachuting to safety over france and in so doing gain membership of the caterpillar club flight engineer kenneth board evaded capture with the help of the resistance some however survived the horror of the downing of their aircraft only to land in the hands of the enemy sergeant john lord who became a member of the caterpillar club was one of these men he was killed in error while a prisoner of war sergeant cecil room meanwhile had been adrift for three days before he was rescued by the luftwaffe often these men received gallantry awards and all have fascinating experiences to relate but their tales have not been told until now this collection of more than twenty accounts covers several theatres of war and deals with a wide variety of escapes following the disastrous loss of an aircraft over land or sea in the second world war

russia and germany two totalitarian regimes fought a vicious relentless war for a full four years with tragic results for civilians pows and all combatants

in march 1945 the german wehrmacht undertook its final attempt to change the course of the war by launching a counteroffensive in the area of lake balaton hungary here the best panzer forces of the third reich and the elite of the panzerwaffe were assembled the panzer divisions as leibstandarte adolf hitler das reich totenkopf wiking and others staffed by ardent believers in nazism and armed with the most up to date combat equipment including up to 900 tanks and self propelled guns at the time this was considered a secondary axis for the red army and thus the troops of the 3rd ukrainian front had to stop the german counteroffensive with their own forces and could not count upon reinforcements from the stavka reserve which were needed for the decisive storming of berlin relying upon their combat skill and rich combat experience the soviet troops carried out this task with honor stopping the tidal wave of german armor and inflicting a decisive defeat and enormous irreplaceable losses upon the enemy the defeat of the sixth ss panzer army became a genuine catastrophe for germany and balaton became the tomb of the panzerwaffe in this book penned by two leading

russian military historians this major defeat suffered by the wehrmacht has been described and analyzed for the first time using data from both soviet and german archives it focuses not only on operation spring awakening but also describes the preceding konrad offensives conducted by the germans in the effort to come to the aid of the encircled and desperate german and fascist hungarian defenders of budapest this edition is lavishly illustrated with over a hundred rare photographs of destroyed or disabled german armor taken shortly after the battle by a soviet inspection team besides other photographs and specially commissioned color maps

the eastern front 1941 1945 is one of the biggest and most decisive theaters of operation in modern history and was the largest theater of war in world war two a total force of 9 million germans and russians battled on both sides with a combined strength of 590 divisions military losses approached 5 million german casualties and 17 million russian casualties altogether both sides had an active strength of 13 000 tanks 18 000 combat aircraft and 50 000 artillery pieces with the exception of the massive allied combined bombing campaign the allied effort of ninety three divisions in western europe against seventy german division pales in comparison another interesting point in the eastern front was initial nature of german operational maneuver followed by the evolution of russian operational maneuver by 1944 the russian army had become experts on operational maneuver and maximized the principals of war of mass objective offense and maneuver the german army against an army four times its size eventually culminated but not until after four years of intense fighting eighty percent of total german casualties were lost on the eastern front 4 7 million of 6 million casualties further both sides lost an estimated 65 000 tanks and 60 000 combat aircraft two thirds being russian the methodology of this analysis is chronological based on the successive operational campaigns from june 1941 through may 1945 each campaign lists the order of battle and then the combat power using lanchester equations frederich w lanchester of military combat in studying modern war the eastern front is a case study in a maneuver oriented army versus a large attrition based army with almost six hundred years worth of german divisional combat on the eastern front valuable lessons can be learned in studying this theater of war
