a sourcebook on zionism aliya and the history of israel the book follows the movements and personalities involved in the return to zion the successes and failures of each step of the way and the institutions such as the kibbutz and the jewish defense force attention is also given to the yishuv s history under british rule the book follows the establishment of the state the wars the different stages of growth and the achievements and difficulties up to the present

from ukraine to afghanistan and beyond occupations and exit dilemmas permeate contemporary geopolitics however the existing literature on territorial conflict rarely scrutinizes a pivotal related question what makes a state withdraw from an occupied territory or entrench itself within it in understanding territorial withdrawal rob geist pinfold addresses this research gap he focuses primarily on israel a unique but important milieu that offers pertinent lessons for other states facing similar policy problems as pinfold demonstrates occupiers choose to either perpetuate or abandon an occupation because of three factors their relations with the occupied interactions with third parties and the occupier s domestic

politics he argues that each withdrawal is the culmination of a gradual process of policy re assessment critically it is a combination of local violence and international pressure that causes popular and elite opinion within the occupier to endorse an exit rather than perpetuate the status quo to affirm this pattern pinfeld constructs a generalizable framework for understanding territorial withdrawal he then applies this framework to multiple case studies which include israel s withdrawal from the sinai peninsula between 1974 1982 its unilateral withdrawal from southern lebanon in 2000 and its unilateral disengagement from the gaza strip in 2005 as well as israel s non withdrawals from the west bank and golan heights overall understanding territorial withdrawal delineates commonalities that manifested in each exit yet were absent in the cases of occupation without exit a powerful analysis of a central concern for the study of international security territorial conflict and the arab israel conflict alike this book provides a critical intervention that identifies why occupiers either retain or leave occupied territory

Analyses of a particular use of force by a state against another state generally begin with the language of the Charter of the United Nations. This approach is seriously flawed, argues Weisburd. States do not in fact behave as the Charter requires. If the legal rule regulating the use of force is the rule of the Charter, then law is nearly irrelevant to the interstate use of force. However, treaties like the Charter are not the only source of public international law. Customary law, too, is binding on states. If state behavior can be shown to conform generally to what amount to tacit rules on the use of force, and if states generally enforce such rules against other states, then the resulting pattern of practice strongly supports the argument that the use of force is affected by law at a very practical level. This work aims to demonstrate that such patterns exist

and to explain their content weisburd discusses over one hundred interstate conflicts that took place from 1945 through 1991 he focuses on the behavior of the states using force and on the reaction of third parties to the use of force he concentrates upon state practice rather than upon treaty law and does not assume a priori that any particular policy goal can be attributed to the international legal system proceeding instead on the assumption that the system s goals can be determined only by examining the workings of the system

imperialism and its consequences part iv the cold war in the third world part v the era of detente part vi human rights and non state actors part vii nuclear weapons technology and intelligence part viii psychological warfare propaganda and cold war culture part ix the end of the cold war this new handbook will be of great interest to all students of cold war history international history foreign policy security studies and ir in general

the term the cold war has had many meanings and interpretations since it was originally coined and has been used to analyse everything from comics to pro natalist policies and science fiction to gender politics this range has great value but also poses problems notably by diluting the focus on war of a certain type and by exacerbating a lack of precision in definition and analysis the cold war a military history is the first survey of the period to focus on the diplomatic and military confrontation and conflict jeremy black begins his overview in 1917 and covers the long cold war from the 7th november revolution to the ongoing repercussions and reverberations of the conflict today the

book is forward looking as well as retrospective not least in encouraging us to reflect on how much the character of the present world owes to the cold war the result is a detailed survey that will be invaluable to students and scholars of military and international history

this book examines the use of third party mediation as a conflict resolution method in an attempt to explain why some but not all conflicts are mediated this work argues that diverse conflict structures are inherently different in their susceptibility to mediation attempts by offering a systematic method for measuring the transformability of conflict structures this book contributes to our understanding of the sufficient and necessary conditions for mediation in addition the study offers an analytical framework for the examination of mediation as a trilateral rational bargaining process
