examines elite structure and political struggles within the palestinian national movement and their implications for regime stability

what ethical challenges are faced by researchers studying social and political movements should scholars integrate their personal politics and identities into their research what role should activists have in shaping the purposes or processes of social scientific research how do changing political contexts affect the ethical integrity of a research project over time these are some of the live issues of research ethics that face students and scholars whose research subjects are located in contentious political terrain the contributors to this volume expose their own ethical thinking as they have met such challenges head on each explores real dilemmas of ethical practice on the ground as they carry out research on social movements across the globe authors examining pro democracy activists in malaysia sanctions breakers in the gaza freedom flotilla environmental health organisations in north america and much else find that the narrow confines of research ethics committees and institutional review boards offer little guidance on the questions that really matter they offer instead a demonstration of continual reflexivity that is both personal and political in its approach this book opens up debate on research ethics delineating key challenges and offering hopeful and practical ways forward for real world ethical social science this bookw as published as a special issue of social movement studies

the israeli peace movement has been in decline since the 2000s in particular the liberal zionist groups who call for peace for the sake of the security and continuity of israel have become paralysed and almost voiceless since the second intifada however despite the stagnation around the israeli palestinian peace process this book argues that other important groups have emerged that present new ways to challenge the status quo these are radical groups that act in solidarity with the palestinians and human rights organisations and whose aim is to reveal the realities of the occupation and hold the government to account leonie fleishmann

argues that these groups have been and remain the agenda setters pushing the more moderate groups to mobilise more quickly and encouraging them to take up more confrontational ideas using social movements theory and based on 50 interviews and participant observation this book sheds light on contemporary israeli peace activism

this book analyzes social movements across a range of countries in the non western world bosnia brazil egypt india iran palestine russia syria turkey and ukraine in the period 2008 to 2016 the individual case studies investigate how political and social goals are framed nationally and globally and the types of mobilization strategies used to pursue them the studies also assess how in the age of transnationalism the idea of participatory democracy produces new collective action frames and mass mobilization strategies the book challenges the view that most social movements unequivocally seek to achieve higher levels of democratization instead the authors argue that protesters across different movements advocate more involved forms of citizen participation since passive representation through liberal democratic institutions fails to address mass grievances and demands for accountability in many countries

why do some national movements use violent protest and others nonviolent protest wendy pearlman shows that much of the answer lies inside movements themselves nonviolent protest requires coordination and restraint which only a cohesive movement can provide when by contrast a movement is fragmented factional competition generates new incentives for violence and authority structures are too weak to constrain escalation pearlman reveals these patterns across one hundred years in the palestinian national movement with comparisons to south africa and northern ireland to those who ask why there is no palestinian gandhi pearlman demonstrates that nonviolence is not simply a matter of leadership nor is violence attributable only to religion emotions or stark instrumentality instead a movement s organizational structure mediates the strategies that it employs by taking readers on a journey from civil disobedience to suicide bombings this book offers fresh insight into the dynamics of conflict and mobilization

negotiations between israel and the arab states have continued in one form or another for over a decade through three israeli administrations the death of a king of jordan and through countless riots and incidences of protest by palestinians and jews alike the agreements that have been reached and some situations established by defacto rule and force majure have created possibly irreversible economic and political structures this collection presents a debate among eminent scholars and public officials over the power these structures engender in the region

al zaytouna centre for studies and consultations in beirut has launched the english version of the book the islamic resistance movement hamas studies of thought and experience which was co written by a group of professors specializing in the palestinian issue and five senior hamas leaders the 704 page book is edited by dr mohsen saleh the book examines hamas s vision and experience in all its aspects the work sticks to two main commitments first adherence to academic research methods and the accuracy objectivity and extensive documentation necessary to them the second is the attempt to present hamas as it really is whether by the contributions of specialized researches who are well informed of hamas and its experience or by the contributions of hamas leaders who have addressed a number of issues and presented a more comprehensive picture of the movement particularly so when the available literature is insufficient to clarify all the issues being researched especially for western audiences interested in understanding the palestinian issue of which hamas has become a key component in the past decade the book falls in two parts the first is a collection of eleven studies on hamas and its experience in which chapter one presents an overview of the movement experience and history it discusses the background and inception and considers hamas a continuation of the work of the muslim brothers mb movement that began in the form of popular advocacy through a network of branches and offices beginning in 1945 interestingly this chapter examines events that reflect the extent of the mb movement's participation in armed resistance as well as preaching activities in addition to their links to the establishment of the fatah movement which was co founded by mb figures this chapter digs deeper in to the stages that hamas underwent especially between 1987 and 2005 the second chapter gives the reader the chance to examine hamas s political vision addressing the wellsprings of hamas s political ideology its approach to religion and state law and constitution and its views on nationalism secularism and democracy finally it addresses the rights of minorities in hamas s political thought the chapter contains a plethora of answers to questions usually raised by those interested to learn about hamas s ideas bearing in mind that it is difficult to find material that expresses hamas s intellectual frameworks in such a comprehensive manner except through some of the interviews which still are no match for the topics covered by the book in the third chapter we delve into hamas conceptualization of the other meaning hamas s view of israel judaism jews zionism and zionists which is the basis for understanding the background and future of the conflict the book in the fourth and fifth chapters continues to analyze the relationship between hamas and the palestine liberation organization plo and its factions and hamas s position on islamic palestinian movements including the sufis and salafis hizb ut tahrir and the islamic jihad movement in palestine pij explaining the convergences and divergences with these factions this is based on analyzing both hamas s theoretical framework and policies drawing from primary sources the sixth chapter highlights an important issue namely the peace process naturally readers will wonder how hamas s actions and visions approach the peace process in this chapter the author examines the stages of evolution of hamas s political position on the peace process whether through the movement s theoretical and intellectual

frameworks or its practices on the ground the seventh chapter tackles in detail hamas s vision for political and social reform in palestine based on the set of principles the group has committed itself to including its insistence on political freedom for all and the rights of the palestinian people hamas s political reform project is not confined to internal palestinian matters but also cover foreign relations especially with arab and muslim countries in addition hamas s social reform platform focuses on combatting poverty as the entry point for comprehensive development and reform the eighth and ninth chapters overview at length hamas s arab and islamic relations by analyzing the determinants objectives and dimensions of hamas s relations an explaining its position towards the arab spring they also examine hamas s relations with turkey and iran and their evolution the tenth chapter deals with hamas s experience in government following the 2006 legislative elections this chapter explores the defects within the palestinian political system in order to determine the environment and challenges that hamas faced finally it assesses hamas performance in governance in the period 2006 2012 the eleventh chapter concludes the first part of the book by reviewing western academic literature on hamas with a view to answer the following fundamental question to what extent have these studies succeeded in understanding the true nature of hamas the second part of the book includes contributions by five senior hamas leaders attempting to answer a miscellary of questions regarding different issues appertaining to the movement these include a study by khalid mish al head of hamas political bureau which is entitled hamas milestones in thought and experience a second study entitled hamas a reading in the vision and governance experience is contributed by isma il haniyyah the new hamas politburo chief and prime minister of hamas s caretaker government it also includes a contribution by musa abu marzuq senior hamas leader and former politburo chief titled hamas assessment of the experience and a contribution by usamah hamdan on hamas international relations the section also includes a paper prepared by sami khater hamas politburo member regarding hamas s vision for managing the conflict with the zionist enemy the book includes an appendix of major documents related to hamas and its experience since the issuance of its charter in 1987 until the memorandum of enforcement of the palestinian reconciliation agreement between fatah and hamas al shati agreement in 2014 besides key political documents issued in the intervening period

three to four dozen international and local organizations up to one hundred thousand individuals and millions of supporters are part of the phenomenon of global jihad the global jihad movement endeavors to name and differentiate these organizations and to explain their infrastructure operational capabilities and activities it also analyzes their mutual and multi lateral relations inside and outside the jihadi framework in essence this is a who s who in the global jihad the first section deals with ideology focusing on the emergence of the salafi and the salafi jihadi ideologies which are still the most important factors behind the operational performance of global jihadi elements the second section

addresses the affiliate groups of al qaeda such as al qaeda in the arabian peninsula al qaeda in the islamic maghreb and al qaeda in iraq this section focuses mainly on the groups that adopted al qaeda s global jihad strategy by incorporating western targets in their vicinity of operations in their targeting policies the next section discusses the different jihad arenas that have emerged over the last three decades absorbing jihadi fighters from islamic communities around the world finally the last section examines the long process of radicalization from regular and normative lifestyle patterns to the final jihadi stage which in many cases involves martyrdom as suicide bombers in the name of radical islam

this study shows the promise of israeli palestinian peace from the perspective of former combatants who transform themselves each other and those around them through moral conviction and action that reclaims the dignity of both peoples

challenging the boycott divestment and sanctions bds movement focuses on the efforts to oppose antisemitism the academic boycott and the bds movement the state of israel has faced many threats most of them military since it was established in 1948 but the threat posed by the ngo forum at the united nations world conference against racism in durban south africa in august 2001 was different the forum unleashed the new antisemitism which targeted the state of israel as well as a non violent civil society based campaign based on the south african anti apartheid

evolving nationalism examines how the idea of israel as a nation state has developed within zionist and israeli discourse over the past eight decades nadav g shelef focuses on the changing ways in which the main nationalist movements answered three distinct questions in their private and public ideological articulations between 1925 and 2005 where is the land of israel who ought to be israeli what should the zionist national mission be framed within broader debates about how and why changes in foundational definitions of the nation occur shelef s analysis centers on the mechanisms of ideological change and then subjects them to empirical scrutiny he thus moves beyond the common but problematic assumptions that such transformations must be either a rare rational adaptation to traumatic shock or a relatively

constant product of manipulation by power hungry elites he finds that nationalist movements including radical and religious fundamentalist ones can and do change cardinal components of their ideological beliefs in both moderating and radicalizing directions these changes have more to do with the unguided consequences of engagement in day to day politics than with strategic reaction to new realities the use of force or the changing incentives of leaders engaging with some of the most contentious debates about the nature of israeli nationalism and the geographic religious and ethnic definition of the state of israel shelef has made signal contributions to our understanding of middle east politics and of the ideological underpinnings of nationalism itself
