the land between the mediterranean sea and the jordan valley has been one of the most disputed territories history since in the establishment of the state of israel in 1948 palestinians and israelis have each sought claim to the national identity of the land through various martial social and scientific tactics but no method has offered as much legitimacy and national controversy as that of the map the politics of maps delves beneath the battlefield to unearth the cartographic strife behind the israel palestine conflict blending science and technology studies sociology and geography with a host of archival material in depth interviews and ethnographies this book explores how the geographical sciences came to be entangled with the politics territorial claim making and nation state building of israel palestine chapters chart the

cartographic history of the region from the introduction of western scientific and legal paradigms that seemingly legitimized and depoliticized new land regimes to the rise of new mapping technologies and software that expanded access to cartography into the public sphere maps produced by various sectors like the peace camps or the jewish community enhanced national belonging while others like that of the green line served largely to divide the stories of israel s many boundaries reveal that there is no absolute technocratic solution to boundary making a s boundaries continue to be controversial and the israeli palestinian conflict remains intractable and unresolved the politics of maps uses nationally based cartographic discourses to provide insight into the complexity fissures and frictions within internal political debates illuminating the persistent power of the nation state as a framework for forging identities citizens and alliances

encompassing history politics and political culture bowker grapples with fundamental issues of palestinian identity in the context of the peace process

two prominent israeli liberals argue that for the conflict between israel and the palestinians to end with peace palestinians must come to terms with the fact that there will be no right of return in 1948 seven hundred thousand palestinians were forced out of their homes by the first arab israeli war more than seventy years later most of their houses are long gone but millions of their descendants are still registered as refugees with many living in refugee camps this group unlike countless others that were displaced in the aftermath of world war ii and other conflicts has remained unsettled demanding to settle in the state of israel their belief in a right of return is one of the largest obstacles to successful diplomacy and lasting peace in the region in the war of return adi schwartz and einat wilf both liberal israelis supportive of a two state solution reveal the origins of the idea of a right of return and explain how unrwa the very agency charged with finding a solution for the refugees gave in to palestinian arab international political pressure to create a permanent refugee problem they argue that this palestinian demand for a right of return has no legal or moral basis and make an impassioned plea for the us the un and the eu to recognize this fact for the good of israelis and palestinians alike a runaway bestseller in israel the first english translation of the war of return is certain to spark lively debate throughout america and abroad

sahbaa al barbari s story provides a unique perspective on palestinian experiences before and after the 1948 nakba born and educated in gaza al barbari was an activist in her community when israel occupied the gaza strip in 1967 al barbari and her husband mu in bseiso became refugees stripped of their residency rights and forced to live in exile for the next three decades while in exile moving from lebanon to syria libya kuwait egypt and finally tunisia al barbari held tight to her hope of one day returning to gaza her life speaks volumes about the struggle experienced by millions of disenfranchised palestinians separated from

family members and their homeland this is the second book in the women s voices from gaza series which honours women s unique and underrepresented perspectives on the social material and political realities of palestinian life

assisting them and political circumstances surrounding the israeli palestinian conflict these refugees are naturally associated with despite being foundational to both the experience of the palestinian refugees and the resolution of their plight international law is often side lined in political discussions concerning their fate this compelling new book building on the seminal contribution of the first edition 1998 offers a clear and comprehensive analysis of various areas of international law including refugee law human rights law humanitarian law the law relating to stateless persons principles related to internally displaced persons as well as notions of international criminal law and probes their relevance to the provision of international protection for palestinian refugees and their quest for durable solutions
