when it was originally published in 1984 michael crick s treatise on the militant tendency was widely acclaimed as a masterly work of investigative journalism and although the rise of jeremy corbyn can be attributed more to the phenomenon of corbynmania than to hard left entrisism to some within the party crick s ground breaking book must seem like a lesson from history updated and expanded crick explores the origins organisation and aims of militant the secret trotskyite organisation that operated clandestinely within the labour party edging out adversaries at grass roots level and recruiting people to its own ranks which at its peak in the mid 1980s swelled to around 8 000 members whilst eventually most of its leaders were expelled it caused damaging rifts within the party and closed the door to downing street for almost a generation

in this book mushirul hasan articulates a vision of islam or rather the many different kinds of islam instead of the frightening monolith of popular perception living in harmony with other faiths and of indian muslims inheritors of the great indian civilization living in a plural society engaging with the debates surrounding the society polity and history of india s muslims and using historical and literary

sources as well as the writings of modern muslim thinkers like aziz ahmad and mohammad mujeeb hasan traces the development of contemporary ideas about muslims from the mid nineteenth century onwards through british rule and the partition to the present day for hasan a truly secular reading of indian history reveals indian islam as one that exists in a pluralist milieu

in september 2019 amazon released the family man a fictional series for hindi speaking audiences about the indian government s responses to transnational terrorism in one episode men from the federal government s central reserve police force and the jammu and kashmir state police stand with rifles in front of armored trucks on the streets of srinagar the capital of indian administered kashmir with the shops shuttered at night there is no civilian activity the bright lights of security surveillance illuminate the surroundings

this book examines how contemporary militant democracies persist in the face of authoritarian abuses occurring during times of crisis focusing on founding members of the european union it explores how these democracies implemented anti democratic measures without compromising their political rights and civil liberty ratings by expanding the conceptual framework and theory of neo and

quasi militant democracies through case studies and comparative analysis the volume offers new insights into factors contributing to democratic endurance respective authors shift scholarly attention toward the epistemic construction of anti democratic restrictions arguing that epistemic fairness in defining anti democratic threats plays a crucial role in preventing the erosion of democracy and in doing so enriches our understanding of legal definitions of enemies of democracy and their impact on the stability of political regimes by investigating restrictions that target old and contemporary threats it enhances our understanding of how inner six democracies survive under attack from populists seeking to expand their ruling competencies after the 2008 economic crisis the 2015 european refugee crisis the covid 19 pandemic and the russo ukrainian war this book is of key interest to scholars and students of european and comparative politics democratic resilience and backsliding legitimacy democracy and dictatorship public comparative constitutional law human rights law philosophy of law political philosophy and theory

at the end of the cold war the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction replaced the soviet union as the new enemy of world peace the pariah wmd states became enemy no 1 the significance of militant islams growing disgust with

have become much more common in this region since 1947 and more people have died in south asia due to unconventional wars than conventional warfare the essays in this volume are organized in two sections while the first section deals with insurgencies counter insurgencies and terrorism the second section covers the religious aspects of the various intra state conflicts which mar the multi ethnic societies of south asia

in this book alaolmolki an expert on the transnational politics of central asia and the persian gulf provides a global view of militant islamist ideologies activities and connections unlike many extant books on this topic militant islamists does not examine only one particular factor or driving force in political violence such as suicide bombings rather this work studies transnational militant islam on several levels domestic e g the role of poverty and lack of democracy in arab and muslim nations regional e g the palestinian israeli conflict hizbullah in lebanon jemmah islamiyan in southeast asia hizb al tahrir in central asia global e g the role of the united states and western europe in inadvertently helping transnational islamists ultimately the author traces the effects of the u s led invasions of afghanistan and iraq on militant islamist terrorism concluding that militant islam is spreading not receding and that the united states would better rely on soft rather than hard military power to overcome it
