a narrative chronicle of israeli democracy that defines historic phases and follows thematic challenges to democracy including competition between religion and the rule of law the statist society and chaotic minoritocracy modern illiberal populism and the israeli palestinian conflict comprehensive portrait exposes endemic flaws of democracy israel but also shows that israel considerable capacity responsibility to fulfill the promise of democracy

this book scrutinises how political actors in the israeli parliament the knesset have articulated the security democracy nexus in their discourses security crises expose leaders political tο a n uncomfortable dilemma guaranteeing the safety of citizens while at the same time preserving democratic principles basic rights and liberties in this respect israel represents an archetypical case defining itself as a democracy the state of israel has been in quasi constant conflict with neighbouring countries while facing terror attacks repeatedly this situation has resulted in upholding of the state of emergency since the establishment of state in 1948 and in the enactment of security measures that are often in conflict with democratic values the tension between security and democracy is not a new question it has been at the centre of political thought from rousseau and locke to lasswell and dahl and stood at the core of political debates after 9 11 and the 2005 terror attacks in london many studies have questioned how political actors manage this tension or how they could properly balance security and democracy yet in spite of the abundant literature on the issue the manner in which political actors conceptualise and frame this tension has been rarely explored even less has been said on effects o f this conceptualisation on the democratic regime drawing on discourse theory and on an innovative narrative analysis the book examines debates held in the knesset on security oriented laws enacted in two different contexts the period of relative calm preceding the first palestinian intifada 1987 and the period following the eruption of the second intifada 2000 more specifically three types of laws

and discussions are examined laws establishing a relation between freedom of expression and security laws linking the category of the enemy to democracy and finally those connecting the right family unification and residence of palestinians with terrorism through comparative analysis of political actors discourses in 1985 and between 2000 and 2011 the study demonstrates that two narratives have constantly competed the one hand а marginal narrative anchored in basic rights and on the other a defensive democracy narrative which become dominant the latter legitimised the restriction freedom of expression freedom to participate in elections freedom of movement o r the right citizenship the book shows how the increasing dominance o f defensive democracy narrative has had a fundamental impact reshaping the polity and identity of israel s democratic regime the analysis ultimately opens the possibility to rethink the conventional approach of the security democracy dilemma and to reflect on processes in states such as the united kingdom the united states different security crises this book will be o f much interest to students o f critical security studies israeli politics democracy studies political theory and ir in general

land annihilating people with eliminatory politics right up to genocides there can be no doubt west with the civilizational judeo christian idea and divine mission to subdue the world has destroyed civilizations countries trading systems and traditional ways of life and is responsible for the death of hundreds of millions of human beings in the course of colonizing the world from its empires o f trade through colonialism to settler colonialism and today s politics of regime change the book discusses settler colonial regime that israel has established in palestine while still claiming to be a democracy it discusses the failures of liberal democracy tο overcome structural and racist inequalities in post apartheid south africa and it presents hopeful outlooks on new ideas and forms of democracy in social movements in the mena region

for many years before and after the establishment of the state israel the belief that israel is a western state remained unchallenged this belief was founded on the predominantly western composition the pre statehood jewish community known as the yishuv the relatively homogenous membership of israeli jewish society as it then existed was soon altered with the arrival of hundreds of thousands of jewish immigrants from middle eastern countries during the early years of statehood seeking to retain the western character of the jewish state the israeli government initiated a massive acculturation project aimed at westernizing the newcomers more recently scholars and intellectuals began to question the validity and logic of that campaign with the emergence of new forms of identity or identities two central questions emerged to what
