homs to damascus and other places all over syria the ba th party and bashar al asad are truly

the alawites are a key component to the current civil war in syria journalist robert d kaplan compared hafez al assad s coming to power to an untouchable becoming maharajah in india or a jew becoming tsar in russia an unprecedented development shocking to the sunni majority population which had monopolized power for so many centuries 31 in 1971 al assad declared himself president of syria a position the constitution at the time permitted only for sunni muslims the author shows how the political behavior of alawites has long been shaped by the group s insecurity and lack of true integration into society

in 2014 god called samara levy three times over 8 months to start collecting aid to send to syria samara was a stay at home mum with two young boys with no experience whatsoever it started with a vision to fill one lorry of aid but four years later she has just loaded her 101st container has sent 11 ambulances to syria set up a charity and distributed aid to more than 350 000 people in the middle east since starting this work samara has visited syria many times one of the most dangerous war zones of our generation which has the highest number of kidnappings and killings of humanitarian workers in the world and in 2016 2 3rds of the
