and ḥizz al ḍīn al sulamī d 660 1262 reinventing jihād  
demonstrates that the discourse on jihād was much  
broader than previously thought and that authors interwove  
a range of different understandings of jihād in their  
attempts to encourage jihād against the franks more  
importantly reinventing jihad demonstrates that whilst the  
practice of jihād did not begin in earnest until the middle of

the twelfth century the same cannot be said about jihad ideology interest in jihad ideology was reinvigorated almost from the moment of the arrival of the franks

the term jihad has come to be used as a byword for fanaticism and islam's allegedly implacable hostility towards the west but like other religious and political concepts jihad has multiple resonances and associations its meaning shifting over time and from place to place jihad has referred to movements of internal reform spiritual struggle and self defence as much as to holy war and among muslim intellectuals the meaning and significance of jihad remain subject to debate and controversy with this in mind twenty first century jihad examines the ways in which the concept of jihad has changed from its roots in the quran to its usage in current debate this book explores familiar modern political angles and touches on far less commonly analysed instances of jihad incorporating issues of law society literature and military action as this key concept is ever more important for international politics and security studies twenty first century jihad contains vital analysis for those researching the role of religion in the modern world

how could a person portrayed as a terrorist by the tajik state also be seen as a mujahid fighter in islam and be a cousin all at the same time is this just a matter of perspective and conceptualization to believe in the protection of concepts to safeguard groups and individuals from the uncertain character of the world is to deny the existence of chance and the contradictions in life this book uses approaches from existential anthropology to enquire into the question of how concepts and experiences relate the focus is on the way the notions jihad mujahid and terrorism were used during a military intervention in tajikistan in 2010 the book includes long term ethnographic material popular pamphlets on islam and an internet analysis of the conflict offering new insights into how concepts and experiences relate since the end of the soviet union the people from the republic tajikistan have struggled to find a place in the larger muslim world a painful process unfolding in relation to global events discourses and politics the primary readership for the book will come from academia and policy makers the book presents novel material on a fascinating and highly important topic the nature of ostensibly islamist political violence against the

this book contends that the discourses of jihadism in russia s north caucasus and their offshoots in other parts of the russian federation are not just reflections of jihadi ideologies that came from abroad rather that post soviet jihadism is a phenomenon best understood when placed in the broader cultural environment in which it emerged an environment which comprises the north caucasus the whole of russia and beyond it examines how post soviet jihadism is also part of global processes in this case global jihadism explores how post soviet jihadism bears the imprint of the preceding soviet context especially in terms of symbols discursive tools interpretational frameworks and dissemination strategies and discusses how ironically russian speaking jihadism is an expansionist idea for uniting all russian regions on a supra ethnic principle but an idea that was not born in moscow or st petersburg overall the

book demonstrates that russian speaking jihadism is a completely new ideology which nevertheless has its origins in the intellectual and cultural heritage of the soviet era and in the broader trends of post soviet society and culture

this book addresses the jihad movement that created the largest african state of the 19th century the sokoto caliphate existing for 99 years from 1804 until its military defeat by european colonial troops in 1903 the author carves out the entanglements of jihadist ideology and warfare with geographical concepts at africa s periphery of the islamic world geographical knowledge about the boundary between the land of islam and the land of war the pre colonial construction of the muslim and the unbeliever and the transfer of ideas between political elites and mobile actors traders pilgrims slaves soldiers whose reports helped shape new definitions of the african frontier of islam research for this book is based on the study of a very wide range of arabic and west african hausa fulfulde manuscripts their policies reveal the persistent reciprocity of jihadist warfare and territorial statehood of africa and the middle east stephanie zehnle is assistant professor jprof of

extra european history at kiel university christian albrechts universit t her work on african and trans continental history includes research on the history of islam human animal relations and comics in africa

this study revolves around the jihad ideas of abd all h azz m an iconic figure in the study of militant jihad in the 20th century history of afghan jihad against the soviet union al qaeda and current threat of terrorism this study has several objectives some of azz m s jihad ideas diverge from dominant ideas held by current jihadist groups like al qaeda and these could potentially be used to counter contemporary jihad ideas and practices of jihadists

are violent jihadis an enduring feature of modern international affairs or do they hold in their own doctrines the seeds of self destruction historical precedent suggests the latter jihadi ideologues have formulated an individualist centered islam to mobilise muslims far and wide youths above all to join a global jihad however the duty and right to an individually initiated jihad constitutes just one side of this do it yourself islam the other is the duty to protect the

purity of doctrinal beliefs against any perceived deviation by even their fellow jihadis this book explores the religious philosophy underlying jihadism as set against the background of the kharijites the first counter establishment movement in islam whose idealistic and individualistic practice of islam inevitably led them to deploy takfir against each other and thereby to self destruct by investigating the links between kharijism and jihadism lahoud argues that the same doctrinal beliefs that appear to unite today s jihadis will also be the cause of their downfall

as a scholar of terrorism john maszka has examined how politics the media and the war on terror play off one another his most startling claim is that the war on terror is a war for natural resources and that terrorism has little to do with it once the military became mechanized oil quickly became the most sought after commodity on the planet and the race for energy was eventually framed as a matter of national security ironically maszka argues the true threats to national security are the massive oil conglomerates themselves maszka delves into the repercussions of a government that capitalizes on an us versus them mentality

such as the demonizing of an entire religion sensationalizing radical violent attacks and loosely applying the word terrorism because the united states current approach to terrorism has led to the politicization and abuse of the term maszka suggests a need for a standardized definition of terrorism currently too many acts of violence can be labeled terrorism resulting in state and nonstate actors labeling their enemies as terrorists yet claiming their own acts of violence as legitimate and retributive maszka argues that much of the violence labeled as terrorism today is not terrorism at all in an ambitious attempt to connect seemingly unrelated events in politics and the media maszka offers an unflinching portrayal of the hypocrisy underlying our foreign policy

in the wake of radical islamist terrorist attacks described as jihad worldwide and in south asia it is imperative that there should be a book length study of this idea in this part of

the world the focus of the study is the idea of jihad with its changing interpretations mostly those available in exegetical literature of key figures in south asia the hermeneutic devices used to understand the meaning of the quranic verses and the prophetic traditions relating to jihad will be the focus of this study the main thrust of the study is to understand how interpretations of jihad vary it is seen as being both defensive and aggressive by traditionalists only defensive and mainly about moral improvement by progressive muslims and being insurrectionist aggressive eternal and justifying violence against civilians by radical islamists one purpose of the book is to understand how the radical interpretation came to south asia the book also explains how theories about jihad are influenced by the political and social circumstances of the period and how these insights feed into practice legitimizing militant movements called jihad for that period

the concept of jihad holds a prominent place in islamic thought and history beyond its spiritual meanings the term has historically been associated with the sweeping arab believers conquests of the 7 8th century bce but given advances in our understanding of the historicity and chronology of the qurān and early islamic texts is it correct to identify jihad and islam with violent conquest in this book marco demichelis explores the history of the concept of jihad in the early proto islamic centuries 7 8th deploying

an interdisciplinary approach which combines the hermeneutical study of the famous verses of the sword within the qurān itself with historical writing by islamic chroniclers as well as non islamic sources numismatics epigraphical and architectural evidence the book questions the relationship between the religious concept of jihad and the conquests the book argues that christian byzantine foederati forces who previously fought against the persians may have had a formative effect on the later emergence of more bellicose rhetoric in so doing it calls into question assumptions about warlike attitudes inherent within islamic doctrine and reveals a more nuanced and complicated history of religious violence in the pre proto and early islamic period

the events of 9 11 prompted questions as to the origins nature and purpose of international jihadist organisations in particular why had they chosen to target the us and the west in general turner s book provides a unique holistic insight into these debates taking into account historical perceptions and ideology as key factors

saudi arabia homeland of osama bin laden and many 9 11 hijackers is widely considered to be the heartland of radical islamism for decades the conservative and oil rich kingdom contributed recruits ideologues and money to jihadi groups worldwide yet islamism within saudi arabia itself remains poorly understood why has saudi arabia produced so many militants has the saudi government supported violent groups how strong is al qaida s foothold in the kingdom and does it threaten the regime why did bin laden not launch a campaign there until 2003 this 2010 book presents the first ever history of saudi jihadism based on extensive fieldwork in the kingdom and primary sources in arabic it offers a powerful explanation for the rise of islamist militancy in saudi arabia and sheds crucial new light on the history of the global jihadist movement

presidents bush and obama both named the global jihadi movement a movement with an intent to destroy the west violent extremism their tidy term was an attempt to maintain peace with the muslim community but when they failed to appropriately name the enemy they failed to fully understand islamic extremism this failure is why the u s has been in afghanistan for sixteen years with no end in sight but this war is eminently winnable if we remove our ideological blinders accurately name our enemy and draw up a strategy to defeat the ideas that inspire terrorism so says dr sebastian gorka one of the most experienced and sought after authorities on counterterrorism dr gorka has been one of the intelligence community s go to experts on counterterrorism since 9 11 he s been called to brief congress and the marine corps and was asked to analyze the patriot s day boston marathon bombing for the us government dr gorka s report for the trial of dzhokhar jahar tsarnaev was widely circulated in counterterrorism circles and the media because it accurately painted a picture not of a teenager on the cover of rolling stone but of a terrorist dr gorka is respected by peers because he understands our enemy is not terror or violent extremism our enemy is the

global jihadi movement a modern totalitarian ideology rooted in the doctrines and martial history of islam whose goals are to build an empire suppress false muslims and engage in guerilla warfare against infidels taking his cue from the formerly top secret analyses that shaped the u s response to the communist threat dr gorka has produced a compelling profile of the jihadi movement its mind and motivation and a plan to defeat it

three to four dozen international and local organizations up to one hundred thousand individuals and millions of supporters are part of the phenomenon of global jihad the global jihad movement endeavors to name and differentiate these organizations and to explain their infrastructure operational capabilities and activities it also analyzes their mutual and multi lateral relations inside and outside the jihadi framework in essence this is a who s who in the global jihad the first section deals with ideology focusing on the emergence of the salafi and the salafi jihadi ideologies which are still the most important factors behind the operational performance of global jihadi elements the second section addresses the affiliate groups of al qaeda

such as al qaeda in the arabian peninsula al qaeda in the islamic maghreb and al qaeda in iraq this section focuses mainly on the groups that adopted al qaeda s global jihad strategy by incorporating western targets in their vicinity of operations in their targeting policies the next section discusses the different jihad arenas that have emerged over the last three decades absorbing jihadi fighters from islamic communities around the world finally tthe last section examines the long process of radicalization from regular and normative lifestyle patterns to the final jihadi stage which in many cases involves martyrdom as suicide bombers in the name of radical islam

following the terrorist attacks on london and madrid radical islam is presumed to be an increasingly potent force in europe yet beneath the media hysteria very little is actually known about it what radical movements are there how do they operate what is driving them who are their recruits what is their relationship if any to al qaeda alison pargeter has spent three years interviewing radical islamists throughout europe to find answers to these questions she examines how radical ideology travels from east to west

and how the two contexts shape each other she finds that contrary to what some analysts have claimed the european muslim community has not become radicalised en masse what has happened is that in a globalised world middle eastern power struggles are now being played out in the mosques of birmingham paris and milan this is a must read book for anyone who wants to know the real story of the jihad which has apparently arrived in our back yard

crescent and dove looks at the relationship between contemporary islam and peacemaking by tackling the diverse interpretations concepts and problems in the field of islamic peacemaking it addresses both theory and practice by delving into the intellectual heritage of islam to discuss historical examples of addressing conflict in islam and exploring the practical challenges of contemporary peacemaking in arab countries turkey iran pakistan and indonesia

into jihadism with a focus on how jihadism and jihadists change

in popular and academic literature jihad is predominantly assumed to refer exclusively to armed combat and martyrdom in the Islamic context is understood to be invariably of the military kind this perspective derived mainly from legal texts has led to discussions of jihad and martyrdom as concepts with fixed universal meanings divorced from the socio-political circumstances in which they have been deployed through the centuries Asma Afsaruddin studies in a more holistic manner the range of significations that can be ascribed to the term jihad from the earliest period to the present and historically contextualizes the competing discourses that developed over time many assumptions about the military jihad and martyrdom in Islam are thereby challenged and deconstructed a comprehensive interrogation of varied sources reveals early and multiple competing definitions of a word that in combination with the phrase *fi sabil Allah* translates literally to striving in the path of God contemporary radical Islamists have appropriated this

language to exhort their cadres to armed political opposition which they legitimize under the rubric of jihad afsaruddin shows that the multivalent connotations of jihad and shahid recovered from the formative period lead us to question the assertions of those who maintain that belligerent and militant interpretations preserve the earliest and only authentic understanding of these two key terms retrieval of these multiple perspectives has important implications for our world today in which the concepts of jihad and martyrdom are still being fiercely debated

although the united states has prioritized its fight against militant groups for two decades the transnational jihadist movement has proved surprisingly resilient and adaptable many analysts and practitioners have underestimated these militant organizations viewing them as unsophisticated or unchanging despite the ongoing evolution of their tactics and strategies in enemies near and far two internationally recognized experts use newly available documents from al qaeda and isis to explain how jihadist groups think grow and adapt daveed gartenstein ross and thomas joscelyn recast militant groups as learning organizations detailing

their embrace of strategic tactical and technological innovation drawing on theories of organizational learning they provide a sweeping account of these groups experimentation over time gartenstein ross and joscelyn shed light on militant groups most effective strategic and tactical moves including attacks targeting aircraft and the use of the internet to inspire and direct lone attackers and they examine jihadists ability to shift their strategy based on political context while militant groups initial efforts to upgrade their capabilities often fail these attempts should generally be understood not as failures but as experiments in service of a learning process a process that continues until these groups achieve a breakthrough providing unprecedented historical and strategic perspective on how jihadist groups learn and evolve enemies near and far also explores how to anticipate future threats analyzing how militants are likely to deploy a range of emerging technologies

this book reveals how for well over a millennium and across three continents asia africa and europe non muslims who were vanquished by jihad wars became forced tributaries

called dhimmi in arabic in lieu of being slain under the dhimmi religious caste system non muslims were subjected to legal and financial oppression as well as social isolation extensive primary and secondary source materials many translated here for the first time into english are presented making clear that jihad conquests were brutal imperialist advances which spurred waves of muslims to expropriate a vast expanse of lands and subdue millions of indigenous peoples finally the book examines how jihad war as a permanent and uniquely islamic institution ultimately regulates the relations of muslims with non muslims to this day scholars educators and interested lay readers will find this collection an invaluable resource

the far right english defence league edl is a strange product of global and local dynamics most prominently the war on terror while the edl has become well known for its high profile islamophobic demonstrations within local communities the bulk of its day to day activity occurs online within its social networking sites between supporters referred to as keyboard warriors keyboard warriors activities are confined to the virtual realm and they are unlikely to

documents and interviews with jihadis it offers an unprecedented glimpse into historic and current conflicts between and within jihadi groups this thorough examination of the years 2014 2019 offers a more nuanced understanding of the current state of jihadism with important insights into its future evolution including islamic state s role in afghanistan
