this study entitled state sovereignty versus individual human rights is a critical reflection of the relationship between sovereignty and individual human rights especially as it related to the rwandan genocide in which about a million people perished in only 100 days the fact that rwanda government conducted a genocide against its citizens and continued to enjoy the benefits of sovereign rights of independent states such as the protection from foreign interference well knowing that peoples rights were being violated moved me to question the legitimacy of state sovereignty of an abusive government the purpose of this study was to find out whether the people s sovereignty has been hijacked from the rwandans by the state and misused as a shield to mask violations of individual rights from international scrutiny and further determine whether state sovereignty was made an excuse for non intervention to stop the genocide therefore the study set out to

accomplish the following objectives to establish the attitudes of the citizens about their sovereignty and independence in light of the past and present governments to assess the role of sovereignty and international response to the 1994 genocide to examine the current level of human rights observance in the country and make recommendations i employed a qualitative ex post facto study design since i was looking at the conditions that had already occurred in such a case there is no manipulation of conditions i.e the genocide had already occurred so the design was deemed appropriate in as far as the descriptions of facts the study was conducted in Kigali which was the epicentre of the genocide using purposive and simple random sampling techniques a sample of 100 respondents was selected from a study population of 1000 people comprising civil servants government officials church leaders civil society leaders and locals using self administered questionnaires and interview guide data was collected and responses got were organized tabulated and the frequencies determined the discussion and analysis of data collected gave the following findings that sovereignty was not a common right in pre genocide Rwanda and that the 1962 independence was a Hutu independence rather than Rwandan it was found out that there was gross misuse of sovereignty by the state government which culminated in the successive and 1994 genocide the international community breached the 1948 Geneva Convention obligation there is considerable observance of human rights by the current government although there are still serious human rights concerns it was recommended that human rights education be incorporated in the education curriculum at all levels to combat cognitive dissonance among Rwandans secondly that those countries that were concerned in one way or another should account for the untold suffering that the people went through and thirdly that the international community should be restructured to have new standards for prompt humanitarian intervention and that state sovereignty should cease to be used as justification to shield human rights abuse and finally it is recommended that a regional crisis response force be established for prompt deployment to the crisis

area as an African initiative i believe these recommendations are relevant to the UN and the civilized nations in the quest to protect human rights of all peoples everywhere

examining the legality of foreign military intervention in internal conflicts with the consent of the government this book gives and analyses a to the point account of post cold war state practice with more than 45 incidents of such interventions on a scale neglected in current scholarship owing to this account it also manages to engage in peripheral aspects of the subject overlooked in the literature such as the impact of an ineffective arms embargo on a consensual intervention or the consequences of the invocation by an intervening state of both consent and its right to self defence the book also examines among others the issue of the legal legitimacy and recognition of governments the rules that can considerably constrain the scope of consensual interventions under certain circumstances and the challenging and under addressed implications of consensual interventions for the crime of aggression

in this report the authors create a framework that can be used to assess the trade offs involved in u s military intervention decisions following the outbreak of a war or crisis to inform future debates about whether and when to intervene

as president carter s ambassador to nicaragua from 1977 1979 mauricio solaún witnessed a critical moment in central american history in u s intervention and regime change in nicaragua solaún outlines the role of u s foreign policy during the carter administration and explains how this policy with respect to the nicaraguan revolution of 1979 not only failed but helped impede the institutionalization of democracy there late in the 1970s the united states took issue with the nicaraguan dictator anastasio somoza moral suasion economic sanctions and other peaceful instruments from washington led to violent revolution in nicaragua and bolstered a new dictatorial government a u s supported counterrevolution formed and solaún argues that the united states attempts to this day to determine who rules nicaragua solaún explores the mechanisms that kept somoza s poorly legitimized regime in power for decades making it the most enduring latin american authoritarian regime of the twentieth century solaún argues that continual shifts in u s international policy have been made in response to previous policies that failed to produce u s friendly international environments his historical survey of these policy shifts provides a window on the working of u s diplomacy and lessons for future policy making

this book aims to examine the conditions under which the decision to use force can be reckoned as legitimate in international relations drawing on communicative action theory it provides a provocative answer to the hotly contested question of how to understand the legitimacy of the use of force in international politics the use of force is one of the most critical and controversial aspects of international politics scholars and policy makers have long tried to develop meaningful standards capable of restricting the use of force to a legally narrow yet morally defensible set of circumstances however these standards have recently been

challenged by concerns over how the international community should react to gross human rights abuses or to terrorist threats this book argues that current legal and moral standards on the use of force are unable to effectively deal with these challenges the author argues that the concept of deliberative legitimacy understood as the non coerced commitment of an actor to abide by a decision reached through a process of communicative action offers the most appropriate framework for addressing this problem the theoretical originality and empirical value of the concept of deliberative legitimacy comes fully into force with the examination of two of the most severe international crises from the post cold war period the 1999 nato intervention in kosovo and the 2003 us military action against iraq this book will be of much interest to students of international security ethics international law discourse theory and ir corneliu bjola is sshrc postdoctoral fellow with the centre for ethics at the university of toronto and has a phd in international relations

in the first published account of the massive u s covert intervention in british guiana between 1953 and 1969 stephen g rabe uncovers a cold war story of imperialism gender bias and racism when the south american colony now known as guyana was due to gain independence from britain in the 1960s u s officials in the kennedy and johnson administrations feared it would become a communist nation under the leadership of cheddi jagan a marxist who was very popular

among the south asian mostly indian majority although to this day the cia refuses to confirm or deny involvement rabe presents evidence that cia funding through a program run by the afl cio helped foment the labor unrest race riots and general chaos that led to jagan s replacement in 1964 the political leader preferred by the united states forbes burnham went on to lead a twenty year dictatorship in which he persecuted the majority indian population considering race gender religion and ethnicity along with traditional approaches to diplomatic history rabe s analysis of this cold war tragedy serves as a needed corrective to interpretations that depict the cold war as an unsullied u s triumph

this book describes the relations between international relations theory and the realities of u s latin american relations it attempts a reappraisal of u s power in latin america a risky venture in times of indeterminate change and divergent thinking

in the years following world war i women activists in the united states and europe saw themselves as leaders of a globalizing movement to promote women s rights and international peace in hopes of advancing alliances u s internationalists such as jane addams carrie chapman catt and doris stevens reached across the border to their colleagues in mexico including educator margarita robles de mendoza and feminist hermila galindo they established new organizations sponsored conferences and rallied for peaceful relations between the two countries but diplomatic tensions and the ongoing mexican revolution complicated their efforts in pan american women megan threlkeld chronicles the clash of political ideologies between u s and mexican women during an era of war and revolution promoting a human internationalism in the words of addams u s women overestimated the universal acceptance of their ideas they considered nationalism

an ethos to be overcome while the revolutionary spirit of mexico inspired female citizens there to embrace ideas and reforms that focused on their homeland although u s women gradually became less imperialistic in their outlook and more sophisticated in their organizational efforts they could not overcome the deep divide between their own vision of international cooperation and mexican women s nationalist aspirations pan american women exposes the tensions of imperialism revolutionary nationalism and internationalism that challenged women s efforts to build an inter american movement for peace and equality in the process demonstrating the importance of viewing women s political history through a wider geographic lens

enforcement operations the un should turn to regional organizations such as the african union as first responders in situations of ongoing armed conflict

lyndon johnson invaded the dominican republic richard nixon sponsored a coup attempt in chile ronald reagan waged covert warfare in nicaragua nearly a dozen times during the cold war american presidents turned their attention from standoffs with the soviet union to intervene in latin american affairs in each instance it was declared that the security of the united states was at stake but as michael grow demonstrates these actions had more to do with flexing presidential muscle than responding to imminent danger from eisenhower s toppling of arbenz in guatemala in 1954 to bush s overthrow of noriega in panama in 1989 grow casts a close eye on eight major cases of u s intervention in the western hemisphere offering fresh interpretations of why they occurred and what they signified the case studies also include the bay of pigs fiasco reagan s invasion of grenada in 1983 and jfk s little known 1963 intervention against the government of cheddi jagan in british guiana grow argues that it was not threats to u s national security or endangered economic interests that were decisive in prompting presidents to launch these interventions rather each intervention was part of a symbolic

geopolitical chess match in which the white house sought to project an image of overpowering strength to audiences at home and abroad in order to preserve both national and presidential credibility as grow also reveals that impulse was routinely reinforced by local latin american elites such as chilean businessmen or opposition panamanian politicians who actively promoted intervention in their own self interest lbj s loud lament what can we do in vietnam if we can t clean up the dominican republic reflected just how preoccupied our presidents were with proving that the u s was no paper tiger and that they themselves were fearless and forceful leaders meticulously argued and provocative grow s bold reinterpretation of cold war history shows that this special preoccupation with credibility was at the very core of our presidents approach to foreign relations especially those involving our latin american neighbors

secrecy is a staple of world politics and a pervasive feature of political life leaders keep secrets as they conduct sensitive diplomatic missions convince reluctant publics to throw their support behind costly wars and collect sensitive intelligence about sworn enemies in the shadow of international law explores one of the most controversial forms of secret statecraft the use of covert action to change or overthrow foreign regimes drawing from a broad range of cases of us backed regime change during the cold war michael poznansky develops a legal theory of covert action to explain why leaders sometimes turn to covert action when conducting regime change rather than using force to accomplish the same objective he highlights the surprising role international law plays in these decisions and finds that once the nonintervention principle which proscribes unwanted violations of another state s sovereignty was codified in international law in the mid twentieth century states became more reluctant to pursue overt regime change without proper cause further absent a legal exemption to nonintervention such as a credible self defense claim or authorization from an international body states were more likely to pursue regime change covertly and concealing brazen violations of international law shining a light on the secret underpinnings of the

liberal international order the conduct of foreign imposed regime change and the impact of international law on state behavior poznansky speaks to the potential consequences of america abandoning its role as the steward of the postwar order as well as the promise and peril of promoting new rules and norms in cyberspace

are good and bad outcomes significantly affected by the decision making process itself indeed they are in that certain decision making techniques and practices limit the ability of policymakers to achieve their goals and advance the national interest the success of policy often turns on the quality of the decision making process mark schaffer and scott crichlow identify the factors that contribute to good and bad policymaking such as the personalities of political leaders the structure of decision making groups and the nature of the exchange between participating individuals analyzing thirty nine foreign policy cases across nine administrations and incorporating both statistical analyses and case studies including a detailed examination of the decision to invade iraq in 2003 the authors pinpoint the factors that are likely to lead to successful or failed decision making and they suggest ways to improve the process schaffer and crichlow show how the staffing of key offices and the structure of central decision making bodies determine the path of an administration even before topics are introduced additionally they link the psychological characteristics of leaders to the quality of their decision processing there is no greater work available on understanding and improving the dynamics of contemporary decision making

kohli first explains that there are two kinds of empires and analyzes the dynamics of both imperialism can refer to a formal colonial empire such as britain in the 19th century or an informal empire wielding significant influence but not territorial control such as the u s in the 20th century kohli contends that both have repeatedly undermined the prospects of steady economic progress in the global periphery though to different degrees time and again the pursuit of their own national economic prosperity led britain and the u s to expand into peripheral areas of the world limiting the sovereignty of other states and poor and weak states on the periphery in particular was the main method of imperialism for the british and american empires this tactic ensured that peripheral economies would stay open and accessible to anglo american economic interests loss of sovereignty however greatly hurt the life chances of people living in asia the middle east africa and latin america as kohli lays bare sovereignty is an economic asset it is a precondition for the emergence of states that can foster prosperous and inclusive industrial societies

a fresh account of the us presidential rhetoric embodied in cold war international travel crowds swarm when us presidents travel abroad though many never hear their voices the presidential body moving from one secured location to another communicates as much or more to these audiences than the texts of their speeches in the world is our stage allison m prasch considers how presidential appearances overseas broadcast american superiority during the cold war drawing on extensive archival research prasch examines five foundational moments in the development of what she calls the global rhetorical presidency truman at potsdam eisenhower s goodwill tours kennedy in west berlin nixon in the people s republic of china and reagan in normandy in each case prasch reveals how the president s physical presence defined the boundaries of the free world and elevated the united states as the central actor in cold war geopolitics
