book examines how the babylonian exile became a second temple metaphor for political disenfranchisement social inequality and alienation from yhwh

a world threatened by its past fighting for its future planet jijo is forbidden to settlers its ecosystem protected by guardians of the five galaxies yet over centuries refugees of six intelligent races have come weaving a new society in the wilderness drawn together by their fear of judgment day when the five galaxies will discover their illegal colony then a strange starship lands on jijo does it bring the long dreaded judgment or worse criminals bent on destroying the six races of jijo in order to cover their own crimes can the exiles unite and find a way to save themselves and a galaxy beyond from the multiple award winning david brin comes the complete uplift storm saga containing brightness reef infinity s shore and heaven s reach

what happens to a community when it is destroyed by a foreign power how do survivors face the future is it all over for them in constructing exile john hill investigates how the people of ancient judah survived invasion and destruction at the hands of the babylonians although some of them were deported to babylon they created a new identity for themselves and then once they were back in judah they tried to recreate the past hill examines the way that later generations used the experience of the babylonian invasion to interpret the crises of their own times he shows how by the time of jesus exile had become an image judaism used to understand itself and its story

this book proposes a fundamental relationship between exile and mapping it seeks to understand the cartographic imperative inherent in the exilic condition the exilic impulses fundamental to mapping and the varied forms of description proper to both the vital intimacy of the relationship between exile and mapping compels a new spatial literacy that requires the cultivation of localized dynamic reading

the arden shakespeare dictionary on shakespeare and national identity makes a timely and valuable contribution to the discipline national identity in the early modern period is a central topic of scholarly investigation it is also a dominant topic in classroom instruction and discussion more than any other early modern playwright shakespeare especially his history plays is at the heart of recent critical investigations into a host of relevant topics borders history identity land memory nation place and space this dictionary works through shakespeare's plays and the cultural moment in which they were produced to provide a rich and informative account of such topics an ideal reference work for upper level students and scholars and an essential resource for any literary library

this book analyzes the exile ontology of spanish philosopher maría zambrano 1904 1991 karolina enquist källgren connects zambrano's lived exile and political engagement with the spanish civil war to her poetic reason and argues that zambrano developed a theory of expressive subjectivity that combined embodiment with the expressive creativity of the human mind the analysis of recurring literary figures and concepts such as new materialism the confession

image the ruin the heart and awakening show how a comprehensive argument runs as a thread through her works further this book situates zambrano's thought in a larger european philosophical context by showing how zambrano's poetic reason was directly related to her unconventional exile readings of martin heidegger aristotle immanuel kant and xavier zubiri among others

this lively and intellectually vigorous conspectus of studies approaches the subject of exile from a variety of disciplinary perspectives the contributions to this volume give due attention to the twentieth century migratory phenomena theorised by edward said julia kristeva and salman rushdie they also show that the discourse and experience of exile is not the stuff of modernity alone the volume illustrates that the waning of the middle ages reformation and restoration politics and the importation of egyptian mummies into a nineteenth century england hungry for imperial exotica reveal displacement dislocation otherness and the uncanniness of observing strangers on display to have long been part of european cultural currency the essays range across a variety of disciplines literary studies modern languages history of science philosophy and museum studies

the history of american universities is punctuated by shifts in the terms on which the mission of higher education is defined and debated a dramatic moment with lasting effects came with the introduction of german speaking exile intellectuals in the hitler era in germany the academic culture of the early twentieth century was torn by the struggle between wissenshaft and bildung two symbolic german terms whose lack of precise english equivalents is a sign of the different configuration in america the studies in this book examine the achievements of numerous influential [migr] intellectuals against the background of their mediation between the two cultural traditions in science and liberal studies in showing the richness of reciprocal influences the book challenges claims about the disruptive influence of exile culture on the

american mind

the first collection of academic essays focused entirely on the musical historical cultural and media impact of the rolling stones

this collection investigates dramatic and performative renderings of america as an exilic place particularly focusing on issues of language space and identity it looks at ways in which immigrants and outsiders are embodied in american theatre practice and explores ways in which america is staged and dramatized by immigrants and foreigners

exile as the source of linguistic crisis shaped by the utterance of that word banished

the presence of africans in the german democratic

republic is very rarely thought of in connection with the experience of exile instead africans in the gdr are predominantly viewed through the prism of educational and labor migration while such research has undoubtedly produced valuable insights it often fails to adequately account for the implicit eurocentrism methodological nationalism and anti communist bias inherent in western knowledge production this study offers a different approach through biographical portrayal it unfolds the life stories of african freedom fighters who lived in exile in the gdr and ultimately remained in reunified germany with the main case study being a malawian activist who was expelled from east to west berlin recounting his experiences along with those of some south african exiles chief among them a former medical worker for the anc s armed wing the study ethnographically reconstructs the multiple entanglements between the second and third worlds from the vantage point of the politically displaced within the concrete historical contexts of african decolonization the struggle against the malawian banda dictatorship and the struggle against south african apartheid

examines the influence of aristotle and kant on the nineteenth century social theory of marx durkheim and weber

in response to being exiled to the black sea by the roman emperor augustus in 8 ad ovid began to compose the tristia and epistulae ex ponto and to create for himself a place of intellectual refuge from there he was able to reflect out loud on how and why his own art had been legally banned and left for dead on the margins of the empire as the last of the augustan poets ovid was in a unique position to take stock of his own standing and of the place of poetry itself in a culture deeply restructured during the lengthy rule of rome s first emperor this study considers exile in the tristia and epistulae ex ponto as a place of genuine suffering and a metaphor for poetry s marginalization from the imperial city it

analyzes in particular ovid's representation of himself and the emperor augustus against the background of roman religion law and poetry

many books of the hebrew bible were either composed in some form or edited during the exilic and post exilic periods among a community that was to identify itself as returning from babylonian captivity at the same time a dearth of contemporary written evidence from judah yehud and its environs renders any particular understanding of the process within its social cultural and political context virtually impossible this has led some to label the period a dark age or black box as obscure as it is essential for understanding the history of judaism in recent years however archaeologists and historians have stepped up their effort to look for and study material remains from the period and integrate the local history of yehud the return from exile and the restoration of jerusalem's temple more firmly within the regional and indeed global developments of the time at the same time assyriologists have also been introducing a wide range of cuneiform material that illuminates the economy literary traditions practices of literacy and the ideologies of the babylonian host society factors that affected those taken into exile in variable changing and multiple ways this volume of essays seeks to exploit these various advances

leyb naydus 1890 1918 expanded the possibilities of yiddish poetry via his rich cosmopolitan works introducing a wealth of themes and forms seldom seen in that language including some of its first sonnets of literary merit a devotee of european symbolism naydus's poems shimmer with his love of nature especially that of his native lithuania his ground breaking poetry explores classicism exoticism eroticism orientalism and judaism with equal verve naydus's work adds to our understanding of the creation of a major literature in a minor language indeed this book shows how the poetics of minor language literatures innovate simultaneously from within and without and how those interactions can

offer even greater creative possibilities than the major language literatures with which they were in conversation naydus's unique body of work not only expanded the repertoire of yiddish poetry but also cemented yiddish's place on the world literary stage convincing young yiddish writers that this was a language that could fulfill their artistic aspirations literary critic naftoli vaynig's lengthy essay on naydus written in 1943 in the vilne ghetto makes a remarkable case for why the poems of this cosmopolitan aesthete who died so tragically young should serve as a fitting emblem for a culture threatened with extinction fink's exile as home published here with a translation of vaynig's essay naydus studies extends that argument

this book explores the cultural and political significance of ostracism in democratic athens in contrast to previous interpretations sara forsyde argues that ostracism was primarily a symbolic institution whose meaning for the athenians was determined both by past experiences of exile and by its role as a context for the ongoing negotiation of democratic values the first part of the book demonstrates the strong connection between exile and political power in archaic greece in athens and elsewhere elites seized power by expelling their rivals violent intra elite conflict of this sort was a highly unstable form of politics that was only temporarily checked by various attempts at elite self regulation a lasting solution to the problem of exile was found only in the late sixth century during a particularly intense series of violent expulsions at this time the athenian people rose up and seized simultaneously control over decisions of exile and political power the close connection between political power and the power of expulsion explains why ostracism was a central part of the democratic reforms forsyde shows how ostracism functioned both as a symbol of democratic power and as a key term in the ideological justification of democratic rule crucial to the author's interpretation is the recognition that ostracism was both a remarkably mild form of exile

and one that was infrequently used by analyzing the representation of exile in athenian imperial decrees in the works of herodotus thucydides plato aristotle and in tragedy and oratory forsydke shows how exile served as an important term in the debate about the best form of rule

the exile of george grosz examines the life and work of george grosz after he fled nazi germany in 1933 and sought to re establish his artistic career under changed circumstances in new york it situates grosz's american production specifically within the cultural politics of german exile in the united states during world war ii and the cold war basing her study on extensive archival research and using theories of exile migrancy and cosmopolitanism mccluskey explores how grosz's art illuminates the changing cultural politics of exile she also foregrounds the terms on which german exile helped to define both the limits and possibilities of american visions of a one world order under u s leadership that emerged during this period this book presents grosz's work in relation to that of other prominent figures of the german emigration including thomas mann and bertolt brecht as the exile community agonized over its measure of responsibility for the nazi atrocity german culture had become and debated what germany's postwar future should be important too at this time were grosz's interactions with the american art world his historical allegories self portraits and other works are analyzed as confrontational responses to the new york art world's consolidating consensus around surrealism and abstract expressionism during and after world war ii this nuanced study recounts the controversial repatriation of grosz's work and the exile culture of which it was a part to a german nation perilously divided between east and west in the cold war

italian writer and political activist ignazio silone spent fifteen years from 1929 to 1944 as a political exile in switzerland focusing on this period this book throws new light on silone s complex biography and shows how his literary production influenced and was

influenced by fellow antifascist german migrants and the swiss socialist intelligentsia using previously unknown archival materials letters and diaries and following a flexible chronological structure the book examines the developing role silone played in the intellectual life of zurich its analysis of silone s links with bauhaus circles disciples of c j jung and zurich s socialist city council offers an interdisciplinary and comparative perspective on silone s exile that both questions and celebrates his status as an un italian italian author holmes also considers wider topics such as the functions of the engaged writer in times of crisis the dynamics of cultural transfer through translation and the phenomenon of exile literature italian antifascist exile writing is an area of italian literature that has never been explored as an entity with its painstaking archival research and critical approach to the pioneering methods and results of german exilforschung ignazio silone in exile opens the way for further studies on this little known aspect of italian emigration culture

which explores alienation from a universal and existential perspective by showing how a group of authors leveraged modernist narrative to explore minoritarian experiences of cultural nonbelonging tying the biography of a particular author to a close reading of one of that author s major works gonzález considers in turn nella larsen s quicksand wallace thurman s the blacker the berry jean rhys s quartet and christopher isherwood s a single man each of these novels explores conditions of maladjustment within one of three burgeoning cultural movements that sought representation in the greater public sphere the new negro movement during the harlem renaissance the 1920s paris expatriate scene and the queer expatriate scene in los angeles before stonewall using a methodological approach that resists institutional taxonomies of knowledge gonzález shows that this double exile speaks profoundly through largely autobiographical narratives and that the novels protagonists challenge the compromises made by these minoritarian groups out of an urge to assimilate into dominant social norms and values original and innovative misfit modernism is a vital contribution to conversations about modernism in the contexts of sexual identity nationality and race moving beyond the debates over the intellectual legacies of intersectionality and queer theory gonzález shows us new ways to think about exclusion
