warplane survivors this book written by members of the core faculty responsible for european courses on medical response to major incidents mirmi is a practical guide for all medical staff on how to respond to a wide range of disaster scenarios the entire spectrum of knowledge is covered from command and coordination through to the management of individual casualties central importance is attached to the key component of decision making by explaining what needs to be done for patients in particular situations and the required order and timing of treatment measures simplified methods receive due attention as it is often necessary for medical staff to administer primary treatment outside of their own specialty this

book will prove an invaluable aid to all who may be involved in the response to major accidents and disasters including medical and nursing students ambulance crew and military personnel as well as medical specialists

to the conflict understand that they need each other for their own benefits and look for reconciliation russia a supporter of the assad government in syria does not want to lose turkey as a friend turkey an energy partner of russia needs russia to balance the power relations in the region they are two neighboring countries with strong historical socio economic ties that need to be restored the reconciliation process is not easy and requires some third party role the pyd ypg centered us policy in syria affects turkey s strategies

skillfully lays out mr putin s approach to the middle east wall street journal detailed and fascinating diplomatic courier putin intervened in syria in september 2015 with international critics predicting that russia would overextend itself

and barack obama suggesting the country would find itself in a quagmire in syria contrary to this anna borshchevskaya argues that in fact putin achieved significant key domestic and foreign policy objectives without crippling costs and is well positioned to direct syria s future and become a leading power in the middle east this outcome has serious implications for western foreign policy interests both in the middle east and beyond this book places russian intervention in syria in this broader context exploring putin s overall approach to the middle east historically moscow has a special relationship with damascus and traces the political diplomatic military and domestic aspects of this intervention borshchevskaya delves into the russian military

campaign public opinion within russia as well as russian diplomatic tactics at the united nations crucially this book illustrates the impact of western absence in syria particularly us absence and what the role of the west is and could be in the middle east

a one of a kind reference book tennessee tragedies examines a wide variety of disasters that have occurred in the volunteer state over the past several centuries intended for both general readers and emergency management professionals it covers natural disasters such as floods tornadoes and earthquakes technological events such as explosions transportation wrecks and structure fires and societal incidents including labor strikes political violence lynchings and other hate crimes at the center of the book are descriptive

injured or of economic impact among the other features are a comprehensive glossary that defines various technical terms and concepts and tables illustrating earthquake drought disease and tornado intensity scales a work of great historical interest that brings together for the first time an impressive array of information tennessee tragedies will prove exceptionally useful for those who must respond to inevitable future disasters

airplane crash analyses but accident investigators cannot rely on the black boxes alone beginning with the 1931 fokker f 10a crash that killed legendary football coach knute rockne this fascinating book provides a behind the scenes look at plane wreck investigations professor george bibel shows how forensic experts scientists and engineers analyze factors like impact debris loading fire patterns metallurgy fracture crash testing and human tolerances to determine why planes fall from the sky and how the information gleaned from accident reconstruction is incorporated into aircraft design and operation to keep commercial aviation as safe as possible

during world war ii the air over the continental united states was a virtual third front the little known statistics are alarming the

army air forces lost more than 4 500 aircraft in combat against japanese army and naval air forces in the war during the same time the aaf lost more than 7 100 aircraft in the united states to accidents in training and transportation such accidents claimed the lives of more than 15 530 pilots crewmembers and ground personnel and the stories of their deaths are largely forgotten this work chronicles the 6 350 known fatal aaf aircraft accidents that occurred in the continental united states from january 1941 through december 1945 each crash summary based on official records provides details such as crash location and cause the people involved and the type and number of aircraft an aircraft serial number index a record of aaf aircraft still listed as missing crash statistics and a directory of aaf

stations in the united states are included

this report summarizes results of legal actions that claimants pursued to recover their losses in major aviation accidents in particular it attempts to determine why some cases settle early and others do not the authors describe the elements that distinguish air crash litigation they discuss the simple correlation between economic loss suffered and litigation process pursued the theory behind the empirical models and the operational definition of the empirical variables the analysis indicates that where large losses to survivors were involved claimants were more likely to sue to go to trial and to have longer time to closure indicating that the stakes are important in determining which cases make greater demands on the tort system

the ground has shifted from the days in which serious history and boring went hand in glove textbooks and lectures have their place but less traditional classrooms can be powerfully immersive and insightful take the 1929 marx brothers film the cocoanuts and what it teaches about both the great depression and early sound films the marx brothers are among the funniest comedy teams of all time four of their 13 films are on the american film institute s list of the 100 greatest american comedies ever made for many contemporary viewers though getting the jokes is not always easy because the humor can be subjective and timebound this work looks at the american past through the lens of the marx brothers films and other projects each of the chapters focuses on a specific film

contextualizing the world at the time and how the marx brothers lampooned those subjects along the way the book demonstrates what the marx brothers revealed about weighty topics like gambling gender relations immigration medical care prohibition race and war all leavened with offbeat humor

horsham township began as a farming and residential community today the willow grove naval air station is horsham s largest employer and its most recognized feature the predecessor of the air station was the pitcairn airfield here harold pitcairn built the mailwing airplane delivered airmail along the east coast formed eastern air lines developed the autogiro and entertained celebrities such as charles lindbergh and amelia earhart photographs in

horsham township show the quaker meetinghouse which is the oldest religious building in horsham and is still in continuous use the highways that served the township farmers such as limekiln pike york road and easton road and the trolley cars from doylestown to willow grove that connected the township to philadelphia

crash explores the fascinating revealing and surprising cultural impact of plane crashes across art literature music media and creative nonfiction plane crashes are covered extensively but they are not analyzed very deeply beyond rote media reports and forensic accident investigations this is despite the voluminous diverse and fascinating cultural materials poems and novels songs films art tv series and on and on that emerge in the wake

of aviation disasters randy malamud reanimates these tragic events and identifies how they persist and resonate through our culture more than we might have imagined and in intricately far reaching ways a unique and extraordinarily wide ranging cultural examination crash takes the reader on a journey that includes reflections on flight phobia themes of crash survival with asides on lord of the flies the little prince and ernest hemingway s two day two crash adventure the existentialism of pilots last words the day the music died deep dives into modernist plane wreck paintings kamikaze pilots and their zen death poems plane crashes before planes race crash and gender and the cultural aftermath of 9 11 ultimately malamud shows that crashes do not bring

about complete and total destruction we accomplish some degree of restoration by shoring fragments against the ruins the plane is dead long live the plane

on a warm and golden afternoon october 4 1960 a lockheed electra jet turboprop carrying 72 souls took off from logan airport seconds later the plane slammed into a flock of 10 000 starlings and abruptly plummeted into winthrop harbor the collision took 62 lives and gave rise to the largest rescue mobilization in boston s history which included civilians in addition to police firefighters skindivers and navy and coast guard air sea rescue teams largely because of the quick action and good seamanship of winthrop citizens many of them boys in small boats ten passengers survived what

the civil aeronautics board termed a non survivable crash using firsthand interviews with survivors of the crash rescuers divers aeronautics experts and ornithologists as well as a wide range of primary source material kalafatas foregrounds the story of the crash and its aftermath to anchor a broader inquiry into developments in the aeronautics industry the increase in the number of big birds in the skies of north america and the increasing danger of bird strikes along the way he looks into interesting historical sidelights such as the creation of logan airport the transformation of boston s industrial base to new technologies and the nature of journalistic investigations in the early 1960s the book is a rare instance when an author can simultaneously write about a fascinating

historical event and a clear and present danger today kalafatas calls for and itemizes solutions that protect both birds and the traveling public

the atomic age was described as one that might soon end in the destruction of human civilization but from the beginning utopian images were attached to it as well this book compares representations of nuclear power in popular media from around the world to trace divergences convergences and exchanges
