this book presents insightful perspectives on the invocation implementation and application of un approved financial sanctions and related issues with contributions from academics diplomats and panel experts offers yoshimura an

analysis of how the un financial sanctions have evolved the different roles o f various major international actors in agreeing and deploying them and their success in achieving desired outcomes it also sheds light on a vital role of japan in the formulation and deployment of financial sanctions as the third largest economy in the world with very limited armed forces and a pacifist constitution offering valuable consideration into one of the key implements of international law this is an essential guide for scholars and practitioners in diplomacy and international relations

the main theme of the book is that the new types of sanctions constitute a challenge to the international system first there are more of the targeted sanctions including financial travel aviation special commodity and arms sanctions furthermore there are considerable but varied practices implementation also there are now sanctions by new actors regional bodies international organizations these all put new strains on international bodies in carrying out sanctions or getting member states to work together in these efforts these challenges are analyzed in this volume with some examples but mostly from a generalist perspective a completely novel aspect is that this volume also includes studies of the difficulties that are met by targeting actors their way managing the situations and most interesting the human rights of such actors

protect r2p it then goes on to examine a wide set of military and auxiliary measures that governments defence and forces undertook in order to increasingly tilt balance against the gaddafi regime and to bring about an end to the conflict as well as to the intervention proper while striving to keep the number of nato and civilian casualties to a minimum this book will be of interest to students of strategic studies history and war studies and ir in general

or doctrinal claim it is intended to be more informative this is why it is not accompanied by doctrinal commentaries nor consequently by references to scientific references the book aspires to bе exhaustive so there was no need to limit or choose the texts that should appear here to make it a practical and easy to use tool the chronological classification by organ has been preferred to the thematic classification in the. united nations archiving system interventions before the main committees other than the first committee are not reproduced in full only a simple summary is offered these summaries are also contained in this work and are recognisable by the fact that the name of the ambassador is quoted at the beginning of the summary the same applies to interventions made before the economic and social council the work is divided into 4 parts the first focuses on statements made before the general assembly the second concern the statements before the economic and social council the third statements before the security council and the last part gathers the presidential statements made during the south african presidency of the council and the resolutions adopted by the council after south africa s sponsorship it is hoped that as a coffee table book this collection will help research enrich and discussion about african contributions to content of multilateralism at the united nations the photos inserted at the end of the work show a slice of life and activity of the ambassador during his stay in new york while they are also in the public domain they come from ambassador matjila s private collections unless otherwise stated in the caption of each photo

the united nations arms trade treaty became binding international law in late 2014 and although the text of the treaty is a relatively concise framework for assessing whether to authorize or

deny proposed conventional weapons transfers by states parties there exists controversy as to the meaning of certain key provisions furthermore the treaty requires a national regulatory body to authorize proposed transfers of conventional weapons covered by the treaty but does not detail how such a body should be established and how it should effectively function the arms trade treaty a commentary explains in detail each of the treaty provisions the parameters for prohibitions or the denial o f transfers international cooperation assistance and and implementation obligations and mechanisms as states ratify and implement the treaty over the next few years the commentary invaluable provides guidance to government officials commentators and scholars on the meaning of its contentious provisions this volume describes in detail which weapons are covered by the treaty and explains the different forms of transfer that the arms trade treaty regulates

libya represented an act of desperation by then president ronald reagan in order to salvage american credibility in the arab world the author asserts that such credibility had been severely undermined by reagan s earlier decision to enhance the strategic alliance between the u s and israel and that 1986 the bombing specifically targeted libyan leader muammar qaddafi as one of the foremost middle eastern threats to american security finally the author asserts that the libyan bombings served as a significant foreshadowing of the current iraq war as a powerful and illustration of the united states historical willingness to use military power in order to preserve american economic and strategic interests in the middle east

this book examines the application of un security council s mandatory sanctions since 1946 and in particular the regimes adopted for specific types of conflict it addresses four distinct threats to peace and security interstate conflicts

intrastate conflicts norm breaking states and terrorism
