economic and or political liberalisation became a symbol of arab authoritarian regimes since the initial phase of the third wave of democratisation in the early 1990s arab rulers found out that liberalisation could help strengthening their authoritarian rule it diminishes both internal and external pressure and increases their legitimacy while the regimes soon figured out that the west finally preferred stability and the containment of islamic militancy to uncertainty caused by democratic experiments 9 11 proved the failure of this unwritten agreement based on the experience that democracies do not wage wars against each other the u s government came to the conclusion that only a sincere advancement of human rights and democracy in the islamic world would in the long run avoid a repetition of 9 11 like events the book analyses in detail how selected arab regimes from morocco in the west via egypt in the centre to syria and palestine in the east reacted to this new unprecedented challenge most of them promised a substantial intensification of the liberalisation process therefore the book had to answer the question whether the current reforms are still rhetorical and cosmetic or real and radical i e whether they once again rather foster the authoritarian regimes or lean towards the promotion of democratisation this time although a certain surplus of freedom for the ruled could be measured the book resumed that the liberalisation process is still opposed to democratisation insofar as the authoritarian elite continues to use it as a tool to avoid democracy nevertheless the authors did not stop here they stated that under the complex circumstances of the modern world even rational actors such as arab regimes cannot assess all the long term consequences of their actions therefore they cannot definitely be sure whether a specific measure contributes to the strengthening or to the weakening of their rule unintended the reforms may result in long term developments which are detrimental to the interests of the authoritarian elite in other words if certain liberalisation policies increase the legitimacy of the authoritarian rule in the short run it still cannot be excluded that they may destabilise the system in the long run i e democracy may come by accident

this book is a study of overlooked themes in iran s contemporary political and intellectual history it investigates the way iranian muslim intellectuals have discussed politics and democracy as a history of iranian islamism and its transformation to post islamism this work demonstrates that muslim intellectuals have enriched the iranian society epistemologically aesthetically ethically and politically this book examines the internal conflicts of the islamist ideology as the intellectual underpinnings of the 1979 revolution its contribution to the formation of the post revolutionary state and the post islamist response to the democratic deficits of the post revolutionary state seeking to overcome the shortcomings of historiographical approaches this book demonstrates the intellectual and political agency of muslim intellectuals from the 1960s to the present

southern social movements have played an important role in shaping world history and politics nevertheless scholarly literature on movements of the global south remains limited and restricted to testing the social movement theory which was developed in the north this northern centric approach largely fails to provide a meaningful understanding of southern movements because it is not directly applicable to the differing historical backgrounds culture and socio economic structures found in the south much of the uniqueness and complexity of southern social movements has therefore been overlooked this collection analyses recent events and developments in southern social movements introducing well researched case studies from fifteen countries of the global south arranged in two parts the volume examines firstly movements which focus on rights and quality of life issues and secondly the post 2011 wave of uprisings which started with tunisian and egyptian movements contributing to ongoing discussions about the northern centric nature of social movement theory and the social sciences more generally the authors enter into dialogue with the debate on local and national levels as well as globalizing processes through an interdisciplinary approach this book broadens the theoretical and empirical perspectives for the study of social movements and will appeal to sociologists political scientists scholars and students of social movements and social activists

in this book alaolmolki an expert on the transnational politics of central asia and the persian gulf provides a global view of militant islamist ideologies activities and connections unlike many extant books on this topic militant islamists does not examine only one particular factor or driving force in political violence such as suicide bombings rather this work studies transnational militant islam on several levels domestic e g the role of poverty and lack of democracy in arab and muslim nations regional e g the palestinian israeli conflict hizbullah in lebanon jemmah islamiyan in southeast asia hizb al tahrir in central asia global e g the role of the united states and western europe in inadvertently helping transnational islamists

ultimately the author traces the effects of the u s led invasions of afghanistan and iraq on militant islamist terrorism concluding that militant islam is spreading not receding and that the united states would better rely on soft rather than hard military power to overcome it

islamophobia is a term that has been widely applied to anti muslim ideas and actions especially since 9 11 the contributors to this provocative volume explore and critique the usefulness of the concept for understanding contexts ranging from the middle ages to the modern day moving beyond familiar explanations such as good muslim bad muslim stereotypes or the clash of civilizations they describe islamophobia s counterpart islamophilia which deploys similar oppositions in the interest of fostering public acceptance of islam contributors address topics such as conflicts over islam outside and within muslim communities in north america europe the middle east and south asia the cultural politics of literature humor and urban renewal and religious conversion to islam

since 2013 the middle east has experienced a double trend of chaos and civil war on the one hand and the return of authoritarianism on the other that convergence has eclipsed the political transitions that occurred in the countries whose regimes were toppled in 2011 as if they were merely footnotes to a narrative that naturally led from an arab spring to an arab winter this volume aims at rehabilitating those transitions by considering them as expressions of a revolutionary moment whose outcome was never pre determined but depended on the choices of a large range of actors it brings together leading scholars of arab politics to adopt a comparative approach to a few crucial aspects of those transitions constitutional debates the question of transitional justice the evolution of civil military relations and the role of specific actors both domestic and international

islam in historical perspective provides readers with an introduction to islam islamic history and societies with carefully selected historical and scriptural evidence that enables them to form a comprehensive and balanced vision of islam s rise and evolution across the centuries and up to the present day combining historical and chronological approaches the book examines intellectual dialogues and socio political struggles within the extraordinary rich islamic tradition treating islam as a social and political force the book also addresses muslim devotional practices artistic creativity and the structures of everyday existence islam in historical perspective is designed to help readers to develop personal empathy for the subject by relating it to their own experiences and burning issues of today it contains a wealth of historical anecdotes and quotations from original sources that are intended to emphasize its principal points in a memorable way this new edition features a thoroughly revised and updated text new illustrations expanded study questions and chapter summaries

treat islamic fundamentalism as a rising threat to the western values of secularism and democracy in the last decade scholars began proclaiming an existent or emerging clash between east and west islam and christianity or in the case of benjamin r barber jihad and mcworld more recently some western scholars have offered another interpretation focusing on the work of contemporary muslim intellectuals these scholars have begun to argue that what we are witnessing in islamic contexts is tantamount to a reformation an islamic reformation attempts to evaluate this claim through the work of emerging and top scholars in the fields of political science philosophy anthropology religion history and middle eastern studies the overall goal of this volume is to question the impact of various reformist trends throughout the middle east are we witnessing a growth in fundamentalism or the emergence of an islamic reformation what does religious practice in this region reflect what is the usefulness of approaching these questions through christian islamic and west east dichotomies unique in its focus and scope an islamic reformation represents an emerging vanguard in the discussion of islamic religious heritage and practice and its effect on world politics
