ten years after the 9/11 attacks this book reassesses the effectiveness of the war on terror considers how al Qaeda and other jihadist movements are faring explores the impact of wider developments in the Islamic world such as the Arab Spring and discusses whether all this suggests that a new approach to containing international especially jihadist terrorism is needed among the book's many richly argued conclusions are that the war on terror and the invasions of Afghanistan and Iraq have brutalised the United States that the jihadist threat is not one but rather a wide range of separate unconnected struggles and that al Qaeda's ideology contains the seeds of its own destruction in that although many Muslims are content to see the United States worsted they do not approve of al Qaeda's violence and are not taken in by the jihadists empty promises of utopia

covering a century of Middle Eastern international relations this book develops an original approach to understanding regional conflict and cooperation

on 20th November 1979 the Salafi group led by a charismatic figure named Juhaiman al-Utaibi seized control of the Sacred Mosque in Mecca the holiest site in the Muslim world the Salafi group was not trying to establish an Islamic state instead its members believed they were players in a prophetic script about the end of time after a two week siege the Saudi government recaptured the mosque threw the survivors into prison and had them publicly executed the Mecca uprising offers an insider's account of the religious subculture that incubated the Mecca uprising written by a former member of the Salafi group Nasir al-Huzaimi Huzaimi did not participate in the uprising but he was arrested in a government sweep of Salafi group members and spent six years in prison in 2011 he published his memoir *Days with Juhaiman* offering the most detailed picture we have of the Salafi group and

Juhaiman the Mecca uprising had profound effects on Saudi Arabia and the Muslim world. The Saudi government headed off opposition from religious activists and made efforts to buttress the ruling family's legitimacy as the guardians of Islam. Huzaimi's memoir sheds light on the background of this religious and political landscape and is the most detailed account we have of the Salafi group and Juhaiman. The English edition is complete with an introduction and annotations prepared by expert David Commins to help readers understand the relevance of the Meccan uprising and how it fits into the history of the Islamic world. Yemen has experienced wrenching changes that have transformed the country in yet unknown ways. The country exploded in a popular revolution against the long time rule of Ali Abdallah Saleh while the country appeared to slip toward civil war. Yemeni political elite rallied with international backers to put together a transitional government with a plan to revise the country's constitution. The transitional government began with a cautious sense of optimism and the prospect of substantial change for the better but ended in collapse because of a failure to govern. The politics of the street overran an ineffective transitional government that could not address the urgent concerns of Yemeni citizens for security and jobs. Instead, populist leaders exploited people's dissatisfactions and threw the country into civil war. The Houthi organization covertly allied with its former enemy Ali Abdallah Saleh to overthrow the transitional government and declare war on the rest of the country. Saleh seems unable to conceive of life outside of the presidential palace and his Houthi allies appear to believe they are destined to rule. Unfortunately, those opposed to Saleh and the Houthi also seem unable to provide effective rule in spite of massive backing from the Gulf states. The incompetence, infighting, and incoherence of the Hadi government bode equally ill for the future of the country. The one hope may be that a new generation of Yemeni leaders emerges to displace the dismal failures of this one. This third edition of *Historical Dictionary of Yemen* contains a chronology, an introduction, appendixes, and an extensive bibliography. The dictionary section has over 1000 cross-referenced entries on important personalities, politics, economy, foreign relations, religion, and culture. This book is an excellent resource for students, researchers, and anyone wanting to know more about Yemen.

The protests that swept across the Middle East and North Africa in late 2010 and 2011 confounded long-time observers of the region in both the media and academia. amongst academics that emerging powers from the global south must have a stabilising role within their own regions previous analyses have focused primarily on the impact that emerging powers have had in their own regions conflict resolution initiatives this volume instead aims to go beyond these analyses and provide new insights regarding the effect that this stabilising role has on the continental and global positioning of emerging powers in other words this book explores the relation between a country's involvement in conflict resolution initiatives and its positioning in the international system the volume will contribute to this approach using the perspective of academics and practitioners from countries of the global south particularly from states that have strengthened or sometimes weakened their position in the international hierarchy of power through a leading role in regional conflict resolution initiatives
