allon recounts the growth of the israeli army from its inception in the 1880 s when jewish communities in palestine formed their first small self defence groups through the haganah s clandestine period in the 1920 s and 30 s and the fighting after 1945 when army and state together achieved legality to the sinai campaign of 1956 and the six day war in june 1967 when the army reached maturity his precise economical narrative interspersed with brief passages of analysis is supplemented by extensive documentation which is especially interesting in the way it traces the development of attitudes and doctrine in the israeli forces the work is a valuable contribution it tells us a great deal about the organization in its various stages that fought the wars and helps explain why these assumed the forms that they did and why they succeeded a study that is more than a history of a military organization middle eastern studies allon has contributed an extended essay concerned with the israeli government s military philosophy policy and strategy rather

than an administrative and technical history half the book contains several important reports and policy statements not easily available in english describing military actions undertaken between 1941 and 1967 allon was an important contributor to the development of the israeli defense forces a rather breathtaking sweep in which hardly a word is wasted the american political science review allon seeks to explain in concise format the development of israel s military doctrines of defense the author was former palmach commander one of the architects of the idf and a commander of various military units and on several battlefronts during israel s war of independence middle east journal the development of israel s armed forces and military doctrine in the context of that country s unique strategic needs especially interesting are the criticisms of some of the israeli government s decisions taken just before and during the six day war foreign affairs a n account authoritative in content modest in tone of the growth and character of the israeli army by one of its principal creators and leaders international affairs allon gives a short historical and technical account of the evolution of an israeli fighting capability over the past 70 years the exploits of this army are significant and should be analyzed no less interesting are

it is virtually impossible to understand israel or the middle east without understanding israel s military history and its security needs there are many books that attempt to provide such a history but ze ev schiff's concise history of the israeli army is unquestionably the most successful he writes with great objectivity and probes issues that most israeli military writers prefer to dodge mr schiff s ability to come to grips with the fact that both israel and the arab states bordering it used tactics the other side regards as terrorism and continue to use them is matched by his skill in summarizing the causes course and outcome of the large scale arab israeli conflicts in 1956 1967 and 1973 and the war of attrition in 1969 70 mr schiff provides an excellent summary of the political and military forces that shaped israel s behavior in each war he neither justifies nor excuses israel s behavior and he does not justify or excuse israel s motives and goals he is content to explain them he also explains the factors that

shaped arab behavior and gives the causes of arab defeats without editorializing mr schiff avoids technical issues tactics and the details of battles he focuses on the main flow of events he provides a short history of the major events shaping israel s military forces and strategy before and during each war his descriptions of military events flow naturally out of his accounts of political motives and strategy his chapter on doctrine ties together the histories of the different conflicts and it should be read by anyone who feels israel somehow has caused most of its wars his chapter on the 1982 war in lebanon is the most incisive reporting yet done on that event a model of how good defense reporting can be when it looks beyond the day to day flow of events and searches out the underlying pattern of military conflict and its causes mr schiff presents the war as one in which mr sharon then israel s minister of defense snatched defeat from the jaws of victory mr schiff s treatment of mr sharon and the p l o s high command is devastating it adds up to one of the best arguments against violence as a solution to the problems of the middle east ever written in short mr schiff has written a history that any historian or political or military analyst must envy the new york times a story concisely and clearly told schiff s ability to deal with israeli military matters accurately and analytically is in evidence as usual this is a good introduction to the subject and well written middle east journal i f one does not have a basic book on the israeli army this is one of the best military affairs

shield of david tells the history of the jews armed forces from the palestine yishuv s first efforts at self defense in the early 1900s under the ottoman empire and the british mandate during israel s 1948 war of independence the 1956 suez campaign and until the 1967 six day war in recent years most particularly since the six day war of june 1967 people throughout the world have asked themselves how it happened that the israel defence forces won so resounding a victory over the arab armies what suddenly endowed the jewish people traditionally non martial with such impressive military skills what is the secret of the prowess of israeli soldiers airmen and sailors the answer of course is that nothing happens suddenly that the modern story of jewish self defence in the land of israel dates back some eighty years and is the result of the commitment and dedication to national survival of many men and women most of whom seeking no publicity received none this book is my attempt to tell part of that

little known story as simply briefly and clearly as possible yigal allon author s note 1970

surrounded on all borders but its western coastline by hostile and aggressive neighbors the state of israel resembles the walled city of the middle ages but its walls are not stone and mortar they are flesh and blood they are the soldiers both men and women the airmen the intelligence the tankscorpsmen and the paratroops these young people from the old ghettos of europe from the cities of north africa and asia native born sabras are the protecting wall that keeps israel free the walls of israel is jean lartéguy s fascinating 1968 study of the israeli armed forces talking with them living with them joining in their operations he was taken along on a nighttime ambush set up to catch syrian infiltrators lartéguy got to know the israeli soldier as few could from this book wide ranging and filled with lively anecdotes emerges a picture of an army tough and determined yet intelligent and realistic enough to foresee a long and dangerous road ahead before a peace is won

for over sixty years the state of israel has proved adept at practising clandestine diplomacy about which little is known as one might expect these hitherto undisclosed episodes in israel s diplomatic history are revealed for the first time by the contributors to this volume who explore how relations based upon patronage and personal friendships as well as ties born from kinship and realpolitik both informed the creation of the state and later defined israel s relations with a host of actors both state and non state the authors focus on the extent to which israel s clandestine diplomacies have indeed been regarded as purely functional and sub ordinate to a realist quest for security amid the perceived hostility of a predominantly muslim arab world or have in fact proved to be manifestations of a wider acceptance political social and cultural of a jewish sovereign state as an intrinsic part of the middle east they also discuss whether clandestine diplomacy has been more effective in securing israeli objectives than reliance upon more formal diplomatic ties constrained by inter national legal obligations and how this often complex and at times contradictory matrix of clandestine relationships continues to influence perceptions of israel s foreign policy

al zaytouna centre has published the second edition of the process of israeli decision making by karim el gendy the 272 page book is an attempt to understand the israeli decision making

includes a large number of figures and statistics on israeli violations on different levels during 2010 98 palestinians were killed in the west bank and gaza strip including jerusalem by israeli forces and settlers while 967 palestinians and international solidarity activists were wounded on the other hand israel s internal security service mentioned that during 2010 9 israelis were killed and 28 were wounded in operations carried out by the palestinians concerning settlement building the report shows that despite the 10 month israeli moratorium on settlement building israel established 1819 buildings apartments in 133 settlements all over the west bank including jerusalem in addition to 1433 mobile homes caravans psr 2010 11 also discusses the increased israeli attacks on the islamic and christian holy sites in jerusalem and historic palestine during 2010 it further shows that the developments during that year revealed that the judaization of jerusalem has become the primary battle for israel due to the obsession with the jewishness of the state dominating the israeli mind concerning demographic indicators psr 2010 11 mentions that at the end of 2010 the number of palestinians around the world was around 11 14 million people more than half of them i e 5 75 million 51 6 live in diaspora while the rest i e 5

the latter are distributed by 1 28 million people in the territories occupied in 1948 and 4 11 million in the 67 territories the report mentions that if the current growth rates of the palestinians and the jews persist the number of palestinians and jews will become on par by 2017 where each will reach around 6 53 million thus in 2020 around 49 2 of the population will be jews as their number will reach 6 87 million compared to 7 09 million palestinians regarding the economic indicators in the west bank and the gaza strip the report shows that events during 2010 has not affected the direct dependence of the palestinian economy on the israeli economy in addition the isolation of the palestinian economy from the outside world continued due to the israeli control of all international exits and palestinian border crossings besides the palestinian foreign trade psr 2010 11 also refers to the enormous difference between the palestinian economy in the west bank and the gaza strip on one hand and the israeli economy on the other thus it shows for example that in 2010 the palestinian gdp per capita was 1500 around 1925 in the west bank and 877 in the strip compared to 28 500 in israel in addition the gdp amounted to 5 73 billion for the palestinians compared to 217 13 billion for the israelis
