cold war era strategic thinking was driven by the belief that individuals organizations and foreign states could be deterred from offensive action by the threat of reprisal that assurance was shaken with the terrorist attacks of september 11 2001 suddenly it seemed that no threat was powerful enough to deter individuals or organizations that valued political objectives over their own lives and the lives of their members more than a decade later new research and theory are bringing deterrence back into currency as a viable counterterrorism strategy alex s wilner updates deterrence theory for conflict in the twenty first century arguing for its value against challengers such as rogue states cyber warriors and transnational terrorist organizations deterring rational fanatics provides a full scale discussion of deterrence theory concepts and controversies assessing the utility of relying on the logic of deterrence and coercion to counter contemporary terrorism in particular targeted killings directed against the taliban of afghanistan provide a vivid illustration of the impact deterrence can have on militant behavior precision strikes that eliminate militant leaders represent a significant cost to planning and participating in political violence a cost that can coerce manipulate and alter behavior though deterrence theory is not a panacea for terrorism insurgency or militancy it can serve as a strategic guide for state responses as wilner shows terrorist violence can indeed be deterred

law s wars is the first comprehensive account of efforts to resist and correct rule of law violations in the us war on terror

the controversy surrounding targeted killings represents a crisis of conscience for policymakers lawyers and philosophers grappling with the moral and legal limits of the war on terror this text examines the legal and philosophical issues raised by government efforts to target suspected terrorists

weaponizing civilian protection exposes how coalition efforts to minimize and mitigate civilian casualties during the recent conflict in afghanistan also worked to rationalize the harm inflicted upon afghan civilians drawing on declassified documents and interviews with coalition officials it traces how civilian protection was reimagined as a martial tactic rather than a humanitarian imperative with coalition officials reframing civilian casualties as strategic setbacks that could imperil the entire mission this book examines the restrictions that coalition officials imposed on combat operations to minimize unnecessary harm to civilians whilst showing how these restrictions served to constitute civilian casualties as necessary in certain situations rendering their lives losable and their deaths ungrievable at the same time it examines the post incident mitigation measures coalition officials used to prevent civilian casualties becoming strategic setbacks including the condolence payments that were offered when civilians were harmed rather than seeking to make amends for the harm inflicted upon them it claims that these post incident mitigation measures are best characterized as a necropolitical device concerned with managing mortality more effectively crucially weaponizing civilian protection shows that co opting civilian protection into a martial logic that is more concerned with winning wars than protecting the civilian population works to devalue and dehumanize civilians leaving them more vulnerable to death and destruction in future conflicts

unmanned combat air vehicles or in common parlance drones have become a prominent instrument in us efforts to counter an objective and subjective cross border terrorist threat with lethal force as a result critical questions abound on the legitimacy of their use in a series of multidisciplinary essays by scholars with an extensive knowledge of international norms this book explores the question of legitimacy through the conceptual lenses of legality morality and efficacy it then closes with the consideration of a policy proposal aimed at incorporating all three indispensable elements the importance of this inquiry cannot be overstated non state actors fully understand that attacking the much more powerful state requires moving the conflict away from the traditional battlefield where they are at an enormous disadvantage those engaging in terrorism seek to goad the ruling government into an overreaction or abuse of

power to trigger a destabilization via an erosion of its legitimacy thus defending the target of legitimacy in this case insuring the use of deadly force is constrained by valid limiting principles represents an essential strategic interest this book seeks to come to grips with the new reality of drone warfare by exploring if it can be used to preserve rather than eat away at legitimacy after an extensive analysis of the three key parameters in twelve chapters the practical proposition of establishing a drone court is put forward and examined as a way of pursuing the goal of integrating these essential components to defend the citizenry and the legitimacy of the government at the same time

known to use them however these drones have also been responsible for killing and injuring thousands of civilians including women and children besides destroying homes and property the us and its allies have claimed that the drone strikes have been spectacularly successful in terms of both finding and killing targeted enemies drones have been projected as a military necessity and their market is growing fast especially for intelligence surveillance and reconnaissance the use of unmanned drones to target belligerents raises many complex issues it is of crucial importance that traditional ethical rules and practices are applied that rules of international law are observed even while engaging with terrorists there are a few who justify the use of drones but their argument is somewhat similar to the argument used for dropping atomic bombs over japan in wwii lethal drones are a weapon of rich nations who have used them to attack poor defenceless nations this book discusses the ethical legal and strategic issues relating to the use of drones in armed conflict
