the shi is of iraq provides a comprehensive history of iraq s majority group and its turbulent relations with the ruling sunni minority yitzhak nakash challenges the widely held belief that shi i society and politics in iraq are a reflection of iranian shi ism pointing to the strong arab attributes of iraqi shi ism he contends that behind the power struggle in iraq between arab sunnis and shi is there exist two sectarian groups that are quite similar the tension fueling the sectarian problem between sunnis and shi is is political rather than ethnic or cultural and it reflects the competition of the two groups over the right to rule and to define the meaning of nationalism in iraq a new introduction brings this book into the new century and illuminates the role that shi is could play in postwar iraq

najaf the gate of wisdom is an introduction to one of the world s most sacred cities illustrated with over 120 photographs and written by authors with first hand experience of the city the resting place of imam ali ibn abi talib considered by shi i islam the rightful successor to the prophet muhammed najaf is endowed with a unique spiritual significance for millions of muslims this book traces the city s history to the present day by surveying its urban form and major religious monuments providing insight into shi i rituals pilgrimages and funerals in the cemetery of wadi al salam and offering vivid portraits of its people

from the book s context this is a battle study written purposely from the perspective of the marines soldiers and sailors who fought at an najaf in august 2004 some context is needed to fit these events within the evolution of the campaigning in iraq in 2004 the americans deployed to al anbar and an najaf provinces faced

a variety of threats as Iraq attempted to again govern itself threats were from disparate sources including Sunni fighters in Fallujah and Shi'a fighters in Najaf behind each was the possibility of al Qaeda in Iraq or criminal exploitation of any disruption of coalition efforts to establish responsible Iraqi government this complexity of threats did not lend itself to easy solutions in March 2004 Lieutenant General James T. Conway's I Marine Expeditionary Force was faced with an outbreak of Sunni insurgency in Fallujah at the same time a Shi'a uprising took place across Iraq including Baghdad Najaf An Nasiriyah Al Kut Al Amarah and Kirkuk the fighting spread to Karbala Hillah and Basrah with attacks on Iraqi and coalition outposts this fighting dropped off in June with establishment of Iraqi interim government of Prime Minister Ayad Allawi but the menace of further violence remained

War Trials tells the gripping and in depth true story of a British soldier's role in the drowning of an Iraqi teenager in May 2003 the devastating investigation and resulting court martial this narrative non-fiction tracks the soldier's life from tight knit broken family home in Merseyside through deadly urban conflict in the Middle East to a different battle fought against PTSD while he awaited a military tribunal back in the UK the military court case in 2006 marked the first of its kind relating to the Iraq War and a case that opened the flood gates of multiple investigations and inquiries into the conduct of soldiers overseas based upon rigorous new research this book's untold personal story explores the horrors of battle and the chaos of a post war city and a young soldier's struggle against depression suicide attempts and deep sense of being let down by the army he sought to serve this soldier would eventually endure numerous investigations and face the threat of the international criminal court for war crimes but these are the shocking events that started it all it is the compelling story of a contentious military campaign with little preparation for the disastrous fall out the soldiers pushed to the limit who maintained a wall of a silence after doing the unthinkable and a floating body of dead child who came to symbolize a generation lost to war

includes 3 maps and 35 illustrations the city of an najaf iraq is a provincial and market center located on the western branch of the euphrates river approximately 100 miles south of baghdad this is a battle study written purposely from the perspective of the marines soldiers and sailors who fought at an najaf in aug 2004 the americans deployed to al anbar and an najaf provinces faced a variety of threats as iraq attempted to again govern itself threats were from disparate sources including sunni fighters in fallujah and shi a fighters in najaf this complexity of threats did not lend itself to easy solutions in march 2004 lieutenant general james t conway s i marine expeditionary force was faced with an outbreak of sunni insurgency in fallujah at the same time a shi a uprising took place across iraq including baghdad najaf an nasiriyah al kut al amarah and kirkuk the fighting spread to karbala hillah and basrah with attacks on iraqi and coalition outposts this fighting dropped off in june with the establishment of the iraqi interim government of prime minister ayad allawi but the menace of further violence remained the multi national force iraq under general george w casey jr usa felt that before the iraqis could be responsible for security in each province the centers of violence had to be dealt with by a clear hold build approach baghdad fallujah and najaf were thus targeted when muqtada al sadr fomented another uprising in aug the recently arrived 11th marine expeditionary unit found itself assigned to quell the uprising in najaf it would be reinforced for this effort by two u s army and four iraqi army battalions the narrative that follows documents this effort from the small unit level the importance of the close relationship between political and military force is emphasized the intent is to provide a view of combat for the education and training of marines who might face similar circumstances

this volume of exiles accounts uses the stories as springboards to discussing iraqi history politicization and diasporic experiences in depth international journal of middle east studies with the u s invasion of iraq iraqis

abroad hoping to return one day to a better Iraq became uncertain exiles return to ruin tells the human story of this exile in the context of decades of U.S. imperial interests in Iraq from the U.S. backing of the 1963 Ba'ath coup and support of Saddam Hussein's regime in the 1980s to the 1991 Gulf War and 2003 invasion and occupation Zainab Saleh shares the experiences of Iraqis she met over fourteen years of fieldwork in Iraq London offering stories from an aging communist nostalgic for the streets she marched since childhood a devout Shi'i dreaming of holy cities and family graves and newly uprooted immigrants with fresh memories of loss as well as her own focusing on debates among Iraqi exiles about what it means to be an Iraqi after years of displacement Saleh weaves a narrative that draws attention to a once dominant vibrant Iraqi cultural landscape and social and political shifts among the diaspora after decades of authoritarianism war and occupation in Iraq through it all this book illuminates how Iraqis continue to fashion a sense of belonging and imagine a future built on the shards of these shattered memories
