was israel founded by czechoslovakia a history of czechs and jews examines this question and the resulting findings are complex czechoslovakia did provide critical secret military sponsorship to

israel around 1948 but this alliance was short lived and terminated with the prague trial of 1952 israel s czech guns were german as much as czech and the soviet union strongly encouraged czechoslovakia s help for israel most importantly however the czechoslovak israeli military cooperation was only part of a much larger picture since the mid 1800s czechs and jews have been systematically comparing themselves to each other in literature music politics diplomacy media and historiography a shared perception of similar fates of two small nations trapped between east and west in constant existential danger helped forge a czech jewish national friendship amid periods of estrangement yet this czech jewish national friendship an idea that can be traced from masaryk and kafka via weizman and ben gurion to havel and netanyahu was more myth than reality relations were often mixed and highly dependent on larger historical developments affecting central europe and the middle east as the czech republic emerges as israel s main eu ally this book provides a timely analysis of this old new alliance and is essential reading for students and scholars with an interest in history and jewish studies

return to their homes masalha questions the official israeli position that the only solution to the problem is resettlement of the refugees in arab states or elsewhere this book is a valuable resource for anyone interested in the subject that lies at the heart of the ongoing conflict in the middle east

broader region since the early 1970s and are now compounding its politico economic and geopolitical crisis this book addresses the efforts to institute a iewish rather than a secular state it shows how the postwar labor alignments were replaced by the hard right coalitions thanks to u s neoliberal economic policies assertive neoconservatism and jewish american donors it also explains the causes behind the rise of the messianic far right centrist parties and the failure of the left the corrosion of israeli society and politics was already reflected in and driven by an economy constrained by adverse erosion as reflected by the liabilities of its high tech cluster the talent brain drain the threatened welfare state and subsidized religious sector but now the already evident politico economic costs to israel of the gaza war have set the stage for extraordinary uncertainty in the foreseeable future

positions itself outside domestic and international law deconstructing agamben s eurocentric theoretical position lentin shows that it occludes colonialism settler colonialism and anti colonialism and fails to specifically foreground race instead she combines the work of wolfe who proposes race as a trace of settler colonialism and weheliye who argues that agamben s western centric understanding of exception fail to speak from explicitly racialized and gendered standpoints employing existing media activist and academic accounts of racialization this book deliberately breaks from white western theorizations of biopolitics exception and bare life and instead foregrounds race and gender in analysing settler colonial conditions in israel

the world responded with

horror to isis s campaign of destruction of cultural heritage across the middle east including with calls for an international response to prevent such damage at the same time newspapers and screens were filled with images o f human destruction devastated cities and thousands of refugees fleeing the conflict this juxtaposition caused a backlash against those voicing their concerns about the destruction of ancient ruins popularly framed as dispute about stone versus lives in the face of so much human suffering it can seem inappropriate to worry about anything but the urgent basic needs of people heritage and war addresses this issue within the context of a wider debate amidst a range of moral questions eleven original essays investigate a variety of philosophical and moral questions arising from the phenomenon of heritage destruction in war such how we ought to respond to heritage that is
